RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue their final road trip of 2025 today at Rogers Centre, a
six-game trek through Baltimore (1-2) and Toronto (0-1, two to play)are a season-high-
tying six games under .500 (2x, also: 61-67 entering play Aug. 22)are 2-5 in their last seven,
4'8 in their last 12 and 6-14 in their last 20 games on the heels of a season-high seven-game
winning streak (Aug. 29-Sept. 4)are winless in their last six series (0-5-1), their longest
such streak since Sept. 8-28, 2017 (0_4-2)have gone 7-17-1 over their last 25 series since

Jonathan Aranda homered in his first at-bat in his return from the injured list and Junior Caminero tallied his 45th long ball, but the Rays were blanked from the 3rd inning on in last night's 4-2 defeat...it was their seventh loss in their last nine road games, with five of those setbacks coming by two runs or fewer.

The loss was also the Rays 83rd of the season, their most since finishing 68-94 in 2016...this marks just the third time the club has lost 83 games or more since becoming the Rays in 2008, also joining 2017 (77-85).

Since yielding 0 ER in back-to-back games vs. the Blue Jays from Sept. 17-18, the Rays have pitched to a 4.80 ERA (60.0IP, 32ER) across their last seven games...their 38 total runs allowed in that span (Sept. 19-pres.) are tied for second most in the AL behind Toronto (41R).

With a major league-leading 191 SB, the Rays need to steal three more bases this series to tie the 2009 team's franchise-record 194 SB...they have recorded a steal in three straight and five of their last six games.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—The Rays need to win today to avoid:
Falling seven games under .500 for the first time since entering play April 20, 2018 (6-13).
Dropping to 0-6-1 over their last seven series, their second time concluding a season with seven (or more) consecutive winless sets, joining 2006 (0-6-2)...it would mark their most consecutive winless series at any point in a single season since that same stretch (Sept. 4-Oct. 1, 2006).
Their first series loss to the Blue Jays since Sept. 22-24, 2023 at Tropicana Field, snapping a 6-0-2 unbeaten run.
Their first series loss at Rogers Centre since April 14-16, 2023 snapping a franchise-record-tying four-series winning streak in this venue.

LA MÁXIMA—With two games to play, 22-year-old Junior Caminero (45HR) needs 1 HR to tle Carlos Peña's franchise-record 46-HR campaign in 2007...last night, he became the fifth player in MLB history to record 45 HR in a season before turning 23, joining TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (48HR, 2021), CIN Johnny Bench (45HR) in 1970, the Milwaukee Braves Eddie Mathews (47HR) in 1953 and NYY Joe DiMaggio (46HR) in 1970, according to MLB Network... the 45 HR are second most in an age 21-or-younger season (age as of June 30) in MLB history, trailing Mathews aforementioned 1953 campaign...among AL hitters, only SEA Cal Raleigh (60HR) and NYY Aaron Judge (52HR) have more home runs than Caminero.

His 73 XBH are tied for sixth most in a season in Rays history (see table to the right). Caminero is the first third baseman with 45 HR and 110 RBI in a campaign before his age-30 season since NYY Alex Rodriguez in 2005 (48HR/130RBI, age-29 season). Caminero (28 2B/44HR) needs two more doubles to become the first player in franchise history with a 30-double, 40-homer season.

CHASING .300—Jake Mangum (.299, 398AB) and Chandler Simpson (.296, 409AB) are attempting to become the second and third Rays rookies to hit .300 or better with at least 400 AB, joining Joey Wendle (.300, 487AB) in 2018...only four pairs of rookie teammates since 1901 have accomplished the feat, most recently PIT Kevin Newman (.308)/Bryan Reynolds (.314) in 2019...other instances involved BOS Fred Lynn/Jim Rice in 1975, DET Dale Alexander/Roy Johnson in 1929 and STL George Barclay/Homer Smoot in 1902.

Between Mangum, Simpson and Yandy Diaz (.299), the Rays could have three players hit .300 or better (min. 400AB) for the first time in team history...under the same parameter, the last team in MLB to accomplish the feat was the 2019 Red Sox (Bogaerts/Devers/Martinez)...since 2012, the only Rays to do so in any given season are Diaz (2023), Wendle and Harold Ramírez (2023, 2022).

Paired with 2023 (.330), Diaz is attempting to join Carl Crawford (5x) as the only players in team history with multiple qualified seasons hitting .300 or better...he would join José Abreu (4) and HOU Yordan Alvarez (2) as the only active Cubanborn players with multiple such campaigns.

MAN OF STEAL—Chandler Simpson's 44 SB are second in MLB to NYY José Caballero (48SB) and tied for eighth most in a season in team history and are the most in the majors since his April 19 major league debut...he is 1 SB shy of joining Carl Crawford (7x, last: 47SB in 2010) as the only Rays to reach 45 SB...with a .296 average, he has a chance to become the ninth MLB rookie since 1901 to hit .300 or better with 40 SB or more and the first since LAA Mike Trout (.326/49SB) in 2012...the only Ray to meet those marks, regardless of rookie status, is Carl Crawford (5x, last: 2010 - .307/47SB)...the only two players in the majors to do so since 2022 are LAD Shohei Ohtani (.310/59SB) in 2024 and ATL Ronald Acuna Jr. (.337/73SB) in 2023...the last AL hitter was KC Whit Merrifield (.304/45SB) in 2018.

**Simpson has tallied a hit in 10 of his last 13 games, going 20-for-53 (.377) with 3 2B, 3 RBI, 2 BB, 9 R and 5 SB in those contests.

THE GREAT YANDINO—Reigning AL Player of the Week Yandy Díaz has hit safely in 20 of his last 27 games since Aug. 25. batting. 402/491/598 (39-for-97) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 10 RBI, 13-13 and 13 la second in on-base pct., tied for third in hits and fifth in OPS....he has drawn a walk in nine of his last 11 games after doing so in three of his previous 21 games (Aug. 13-Sept. 9) He is one double away from joining Ben Zöbrist (2011-14) as the only players in Rays history with four straight 30-double seasons.

Diaz's 53 multi-hit games, which are tied with SEA Julio Rodríguez for the MLB lead, match his career high from 2023...he could become the first player in Rays history to pace the majors in multi-hit efforts...the last Tampa Bay batter with more multi-hit games was Carl Crawford (54G) in 2009.

He has already posted career highs in hits (174), home runs (25), RBI (83) and games played (149)...his 55 XBH are two shy of his career high from 2023 (57XBH).

RAYS AND JAYS—The Rays and Blue Jays conclude a 13-game season series this weekend in Toronto...this marks the clubs' second meeting in a two-week span after splitting a fourgame set from Sept. 15-18 at Steinbrenner Field...Tampa Bay has won seven of the first 11 meetings, securing its eighth straight season series win, 10th in 11 seasons under Kevin Cash (2015-pres.) and 16th in 18 seasons since becoming the Rays in 2008...the eight-season streak is tied for the longest over a single opponent in franchise history, matching another eight-year run over the Angels (2016-24)...Tampa Bay has gone 6-0-2 over its last eight individual series vs. Toronto since its last loss from Sept. 22-24, 2023 at Tropicana Field, its longest streak of unbeaten series vs. the Blue Jays since a 9-0-1 stretch from Aug. 22, 2017-July 28, 2019...this includes wins in each of their last four series at Rogers Centre, tied for their longest streak at this venue in franchise history (also: June 29, 2009-June 2, 2010). The Rays have won six of nine and 11 of their last 15 meetings with Toronto...they are 16-8 vs. the Jays since the start of last season.

**Junior Caminero has hit safely in all seven of his career games at Rogers Centre, going 10-for-31 (.286) with 2 2B, 3 HR and 10 RBI...it marks the longest career-opening hitting streak by a Ray in this ballpark since Tommy Pham's club-record 14-game streak from Sept. 3, 2018-Sept. 29, 2019...Caminero recorded his first career home run (Oct. 1, 2023) and first grand slam (May 13, 2025) in this venue.

**Brandon Lowe is slashing .379/.410/.810 (22-for-58) with 4 2B, 7 HR and 19 RBI over his last 14 games vs. the Blue Jays dating back to July 25, 2024.

TODAY'S START—Joe Boyle will make his ninth start as a Ray and his 13th appearance of the campaign...marks the second time in his career he has faced the Blue Jays...is in his third stint with the Rays, joining April 13-14 and July 6-Aug. 22...acquired from the Athletics along with INF Will Simpson, RHP Jacob Watters and a Competitive Balance Round A selection for LHP Jeffrey Springs and LHP Jacob Lopez, Dec. 14, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT—Boyle went 4.1 innings on Sept. 21 vs. BOS in a nodecision in his final home start of the year...he allowed one run on four hits with a career-high nine strikeouts...tied a career-high seven strikeouts swinging (also: Aug. 24, 2024 vs. MIL)...he worked out of a bases loaded jam in the 1st inning before striking out his next four batters faced and five of his next six...allowed a walk-double-double sequence to begin the 4th inning that plated his lone run allowed.

Has five strikeouts or more in each of his last three starts...marks his second streak of three such starts or more in his career (also: 3G, Aug. 13-24, 2024).

PARTY IN CANADA—Boyle is making his second career start opposite the Blue Jays tonight...his lone start prior came on Sept. 15 at Steinbrenner Field and he spun 6.0 scoreless frames with four hits allowed and five strikeouts...across five appearances (3GS) in 2025 against the AL East, he is 0-1 with a 3.20 ERA (19.2IP, 7ER) and a .208 (15-for-72) opp. average...he has allowed two runs or fewer in four of those five outings and has gone 4.0 innings or more in three of five.

BREAKING OUT THE PASSPORT—In five appearances (3GS) away from Steinbrenner Field this season, he is 0-2 with a 8.15 ERA (17.2IP, 16ER) and a .239 (17-for-71) opp. average...14 of his 16 earned runs allowed have come in his three starts, falling short of completing 4.0 innings in each... throughout his career, he is 2-4 with a 7.05 ERA (44.2IP, 35ER) and a .222 (37-for-167) opp. average...his last winning decision on the road came on April 7, 2024 at DET (w/ OAK).

* The right-hander has made eight career starts on the road...in his

The right-hander has made eight career starts on the road...in his first two starts (Sept. 30, 2023 at LAA & April 7, 2024 at DET), he was 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0IP, 3ER) and limited opponents to 2 1B, 1 2B and 1 HR in those contests...since then, he is 0-4 with a 11.22 ERA (21.2IP, 27ER) and four runs or more allowed in five of six.

THE ARSENAL—In addition to limiting opponents to a .213 (16-for-75) clip on his fastball, opposing hitters are 22-for-102 (.216) in at-bats ending with Boyle's slider (18-for-71) and split-finger (4-for-31)...he has generated a combined 31.1 pct. whiff rate on his secondary offerings and recorded 40 of his 53 strikeouts on those pitches...107 of his 124 career strikeouts have come on his four-seamer or his slider, with the others coming on a splitter (11), sweeper (5) and a sinker (1).

With two strikes, opponents are 5-for-47 (.106) with 29 SO and a 35.6 pct. whiff rate against his slider.

ALRIGHT, **ALRIGHT**—Boyle has held righties to a .191 batting average (38-for-199) in his career...he has allowed just 12 extra-base hits, walked 28 batters and struck out 64 right-handed batters...meanwhile, lefties have hit at a .237 clip (50-for-211) against him with 20 extra-base hits, 42 walks and 60 strikeouts.

MINOR MATTERS—In his 18 games (17GS) with Triple-A Durham this season, Boyle has gone 8-4 and pitched to a 1.88 ERA (86.0IP, 18ER), posted a 1.01 WHIP and limited opponents to a .154 (46-for-299) batting average... in his most recent stint with the Bulls, he went 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0IP, 3ER) and 18 SO across three starts.

Min. 250 AB, his .154 opp. average is the lowest among Triple-A pitchers this season...min. 85.0 IP, his 1.88 ERA is second-lowest.
 He was named International League Pitcher of the Week three

He was named International League Pitcher of the Week three times and named IL Pitcher of the Month for June...he went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (30.0IP, 6ER), a 0.97 WHIP and a .167 (18-for-108) opp. average in six outings (5GS) during the month...was also named Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month by the club's baseball operations department.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS—Boyle's first start for the Rays came in a spot start on April 13 vs. ATL...he earned his first and only win of 2025 after tossing 5.0 hitless innings (2R, OER) with 2 BB, 1 HBP and 7 SO...the right-hander retired 13 straight batters to open the game before allowing his first baserunner to reach via walk in the 5th inning...put out the next two batters before yielding a hit-by-pitch and a walk to end his outing.
