AROUND THE HORN

MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME: Yesterday, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame (Salon de Fama del Beisbol Mexicano) announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category.

Durazo, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016.

Lopez pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as general manager of Mexico's 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classic teams.

HERE'S THE STORY: D-backs starters have allowed 1 or fewer runs in 6 of their last 8 games and own the fourth-best ERA (2.58) in the Majors, behind the Pirates (7 G, 1.80), Braves (6 G, 2.10) and Mets (6 G, 2.54).

- In the span, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 6), innings (1st, 52.1), innings/GM (1st, 6.2), strikeouts (T-2nd, 44), AVG (5th, .181) and WHIP (6th, 0.97).
- D-backs pitchers have starts of 6.0+ innings in 7 of their last 8 games.
- Ketel Marte** last night, played his 1,093rd game as a D-back to pass Paul Goldschmidt (1,092) for second-most games in club history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,194).
- The D-backs are 15-4 (.789) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 6-3 (.667) on the road.
- The D-backs look to win their fourth consecutive series vs. Rangers since Sept. 10, 2024 (6-2)...have won or split 5 of their last 6 series vs. Rangers (9-5) since 2023.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-4 @ Rangers last night.

- Ildemaro Vargas** hit his team-leading seventh homer to tie the game 1-1 in the second inning...went 2-for-4 with 1 homer and 2 RBI.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** and **Gabriel Moreno** had 1 RBI apiece in the ninth inning.
- Brandon Pfaadt** tossed 3.0 scoreless innings in long relief with 2 hits, 0 walks and 5 strikeouts.

STARTERS DEALING: D-backs starters, for the fifth time all-time, recorded a franchise-high-tying 4 consecutive starts of 6.0+ innings, 1 or fewer runs and 4 or fewer hits from May 8-11 (last: July 5-12, 2019).

- The Dodgers (April 13-17) are the only other club in MLB this season with a 4-game streak.

ROLLIN' NOLAN: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 starts, hitting .351 (20-for-57)/1.017 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 10 walks, including 8 games reaching base 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 60 PA] in OPS (2nd, 1.001), OBP (2nd, .449), AVG (3rd, .345), SLG (3rd, .552), runs (4th, 13), times on base (4th, 31) and hits (T-5th, 20).

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: In their last 11 games since May 1, the D-backs lead MLB in ERA (1.20, 5 R-4 ER in 30.0 IP), opponent AVG (.149; 15-for-101), OPS (.439), OBP (.221), SLG (.218), runs (5) and WHIP (0.77), are tied for the fewest home runs (0) and have the second fewest walks (8).

CLOSE IT OUT: **Paul Sewald** (9 SV) is 1 of 3 closers in MLB with 8+ saves who are perfect in save opportunities (also: Mason Miller/SD 12 SV and Aroldis Chapman/BOS 8 SV).

- Sewald's 9 straight saves are the most by a D-backs reliever to start a season since his 11 straight from May 9-June 29, 2024 (opened season on injured list)...other notable save streaks since 2011: Brad Boxberger's 11 from March 30-May 6, 2018; Brad Ziegler's 15 from April 12-June 20, 2016 and J.J. Putz from April 1-May 2, 2011.

B.G. HAS BEEN GREAT: **Brandyn Garcia** has allowed only 1 single and 0 walks with 6 strikeouts in 5 games (5.2 IP) since being recalled from Triple-A Reno on May 1.

- Since May 1, owns the lowest OBP (.059) and WHIP (0.18) among MLB relievers [min. 5.0 IP] and the second-lowest OPS (.118).
- Has held opponents scoreless in 11 of his last 13 games, since Sept. 12, 2025, with a 2.08 ERA (4 R-3 ER), opponent .178 AVG (8-for-45)/.391 OPS, 2 walks and 15 strikeouts.

¡BRAVO MORILLO! **Juan Morillo** has allowed 1 run over his last 10 games, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .111 AVG, 0.47 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

- Has not allowed a hit or walk to a righty in his last 8 games (0-for-12, 14 BF) with 3 strikeouts.

THOMPSON ON THE ROAD: **Ryan Thompson** has been one of baseball's best relievers on the road over the last year since May 23, 2025, holding opponents scoreless in 22 of 24 games (0.48 ERA, 2 R-1 ER, opponent .200 AVG (13-for-65)/.455 OPS, 2 BB, 15 K) while stranding 17 of 20 inherited runners.

VS. RANGERS: The D-backs are 10-6 in their last 16 matchups and have won 3 straight series, including their last on the road from Aug. 11-13, 2025 (2-1).

- The D-backs are 9-7 in their last 16 road games @ Rangers.

ON DECK @ ROCKIES: The D-backs face the Rockies for the Rocky Mountain Showdown as part of MLB's second annual "Rivalry Weekend" presented by Booking.com.

- The D-backs have won 10 of their last 12 series vs. Rockies since 2023, going 27-12.
- The D-backs taken 4 of their last 6 road series @ Rockies since 2023, going 10-9.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (2-3, 7.62)

- Had a quality start with a season-high 7.0 frames in his last start on May 9 vs. Mets (W, 1 R, 3 H, 3 BB, 6 K).
- In his last 13 bids (11 quality) vs. Rockies, is 8-0 with a 1.92 ERA (18 ER in 84.1 IP), 21 walks and 86 strikeouts.
- In his last 6 road bids (6 quality) @ Rockies, is 4-0 with a 2.19 ERA (9 ER in 37.0 IP) and 35 strikeouts.
