THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

AUG. 27

2023 - The Astros tie a franchise record by tallying 25 hits in a 17-4 thrashing of the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park. Jeremy Peña leads the way with a career-high 5 hits. Overall, the Astros compiled 4 doubles, a triple and 4 HR.

2006 - In a 13-1 shelling at PNC Park in Pittsburgh, Willy Taveras hits safely in his 30th straight game, which is a club record that still stands today. Taveras wasted no time in extending his record streak, singling to lead off the game.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros and Yankees will play their final regular season game tonight at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Hayden Wesneski** (3-1) will start for the Astros vs. Yankees RHP Gerrit Cole (7-6)...**First-Timer:** Wesneski, who was drafted by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2019 Draft, will be facing his former organization for the 1st time tonight...it is also his 1st career app. at Yankee Stadium.

ASTROS-YANKEES: The Astros are 2-3 vs. NYY this season, with the Yankees taking 2 of 3 at Daikin Park, April 24-26...in their last visit to the Bronx, the Astros took 2 of 3 from the Yankees, Aug. 8-10 of 2025...**All-Time:** In the regular season, the Astros are 38-55 vs. NYY...**Postseason:** The Astros have won all 4 postseason series that they have played vs. the Yankees (2015, '17, '19, '22) and have a combined record of 13-5 (.722) in those games.

NY STATE OF MIND: Tonight is the 3rd game of a 6-game road trip for the Astros, with all 6 games being scheduled in the Big Apple...after this 3-games series vs. the Yankees in the Bronx (Tues.-Thur.), the Astros will take on the Mets for a 3-game series at Citi Field in Queens over the weekend (Fri.-Sun)...**Last Time It Happened:** The Astros had a similar road trip in NYC, June 23-29 of 2022, during which they played 4 games at Yankee Stadium (2-2) and 2 games at Citi Field (2-0), respectively.

BIG WES: Tonight will be **RHP Hayden Wesneski** 6th start of the season for the Astros...he re-joined the Astros rotation on July 29 at LAA after missing 14 months while recovering from Tommy John surgery...in his most recent start on Aug. 21 vs. ATH, he had his best outing of the season, allowing just 1 hit over 5.0 scoreless innings, earning the win in a 4-0 Astros victory...Wesneski has pitched through 5th inning in 4 of his 5 starts and through the 6th inning in 2 of them...**Local Product:** A Houston native, Wesneski attended Cy Fair High School as well as Sam Houston St....he was acquired from the Cubs along with **Isaac Paredes** and **Cam Smith** in exchange for **Kyle Tucker**, Dec. 13, 2024.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros dropped the 2nd game of this series in the Bronx last night, 9-3...the score was tied at 3-3 going into the bottom of the 7th inning until the Yanks rallied for 4 runs in that 7th and 2 more in the 8th...**RHP Peter Lambert** had ND, but was solid (5.2 IP, 2 ER)...**Daulton Varsho** had a good night, going 2x4 with a HR and double.

UP TO THE CHALLENGE: Astros hitters are tied with the Yankees and Reds for the most successful ABS challenges in the Majors, all with 84...the Astros 55% success rate is T-1st in the AL and T-3rd in the Majors...among players, **Jose Altuve's** 20 successful challenges are T-1st in the AL.

MEASURING UP: The Astros are 24-14 (.632) vs. teams currently at .500 or above...some clubs that they have winning records against include BOS (5-1), CHC (3-0), CWS (2-1), CLE (4-2), MIA (3-0), and TB (2-1)...HOU is 9-4 vs. TEX, who are in 2nd place in the AL West.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Among AL teams, the Astros rank T-1st in SLG (.412), 3rd in HR (177) and runs scored (608) and 4th in OPS (.730).

TRIPLE THREAT: **Yordan Alvarez**, who is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award, currently leads the AL in several categories, including all three **Triple Crown** categories...he enters tonight leading the AL in batting avg. (.322) and HR (36) and T-1st in RBI (91)...additionally, Alvarez also leads the Majors in OPS (1.051), SLG (.614), OBP (.437) and TB (290)...**Rare Feat:** Since **Carl Yastrzemski** won the AL Triple Crown in 1967, there has been just one Triple Crown winner in the Majors, **Miguel Cabrera** in 2012 (AL).

SLOW AND STEADY RECOVERY: Since starting the season with a 20-31 record after 51 games, the Astros are 46-36 (.561) in their last 82 games (since May 22)...that is the 2nd-best record in the AL in that span, behind only the Red Sox (51-33).

ROAD WARRIORS: Since posting a 1-9 record on the 1st road trip of the 2026 season, the Astros have been one of the best road teams in the Majors...they are 32-23 (.582) on the road since April 14, which is 3rd-best in the AL in that span...more recently, they are 16-11 (.592) on their last 5 road trips combined (includes current trip)...overall for the season, HOU is 33-32 on the road.

THE HIT MAN: **Jose Altuve** enters tonight's game needing just 10 hits to reach 2,500 for his career...among active players, his 1,490 hits rank 2nd to Freddie Freeman's 2,578...**IN GOOD COMPANY:** In MLB history, Altuve is one of just 3 players with a .300 career batting avg. to reach both 250 HR and 300 SB...the other 2 are HOFers **Willie Mays** and **Derek Jeter**.

WALK OF FAME: **Yordan Alvarez'** ML-high 28 intentional walks this season are a franchise record...**Jeff Bagwell** had held the club record with 27 IBB in 1997....Alvarez was intentionally walked 3 times on Sunday vs. ATH (has drawn no walks vs. the Yankees in 5 games thus far this season).

ROOKIE LEVEL AWARDS/ALL-STARs: Today, Minor League Baseball announced their Rookie Level League Awards and All-Star Teams...19-year-old Astros **RHP Adrian Ardines** was named both **FCL Pitcher of the Year** and as an All-Star after posting a 5-1 record with a 3.42 ERA in 12 G (8 GS) with a 1.08 WHIP and 56 K's in 52.2 IP...he also had a CG shutout...Astros **C/1B Luis DeLeon** was also named to the FCL All-Star team after his stellar season in which he hit .390 (46X118) with a 1.041 OPS (482 OBP/559 SLG)...DeLeon is also 19 years old.

LAST START, AUG. 21 vs. ATH: Earned the win on Friday vs. the A's after tossing 5.0 shutout innings, working around just 1 hit allowed and 3 walks...struck out 4 hitters on a season high 91 pitches (59 strikes)...the Astros won that game 4-0.

RETURN OF THE WEZ: In his return from Tommy John surgery, he's recorded a 3-1 record and a 4.23 ERA (13ER/27.2IP), a 1.23 WHIP and a .240 (24x100) opponent batting average through his first 5 Major League starts of the year...the Astros are 4-1 in his starts...has already matched his single-season career high in wins (3), which he's now accomplished 4 times in his 5 MLB seasons.

HUGE WELCOME BACK: Has been a huge factor since his debut on July 29...since that date, Wesneski leads the club in innings (27.2IP), while racking up 3 wins...is the only other Astros starter with multiple wins since his return date.

ON THE CHASE: Has induced a 37.6-percent chase rate, which would mark a career high...his previous high was a 30.2-percent rate through 28 games (7 starts) with the Cubs in 2024...gets a lot of chase on his sweeper, which he throws 30.8% of the time, his highest usage of any pitch.

VS. NYY: Is facing his former organization tonight for the first time in his Major League career...the Yankees will be his 28th different MLB opponent, and after tonight, will be missing only the Rangers and Cubs as MLB opponents...was originally drafted by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2019 draft...was in the Yankees organization for parts of 4 seasons (2019-22), topping out at the Triple A level...traded to the Cubs at the 2022 trade deadline in exchange for **RHP Scott Effross**.

ON THE WAY BACK: Underwent Tommy John surgery on May 23, 2025...returned to the mound to begin his rehab appearances on June 30, 2026, with the FCL Astros (3IP)...advanced to Double A Corpus Christi for 1 start, then made 3 starts for Triple A Sugar Land...combined to post a 2.25 ERA (5ER/20IP) in his 5 rehab appearances...struck out 21 in his 20.0 innings, allowed a .211 opponent average, and posted a 1.00 WHIP...walked just 4 hitters across his 5 rehab starts.

WESNESKI IN 2025: Began last season in the Astros starting rotation and went on to make 6 starts, going 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA (16ER/32IP) prior to his injury...had a couple strong starts, tossing a career-high-tying 7.0 innings on April 7 at SEA, and fanning a career-high 10 hitters on April 13 vs. LAA.

THE WESNESKI TRADE: Acquired by the Astros from the Cubs on Dec. 13, 2024 as part of the return for All-Star **OF Kyle Tucker**...the Astros received Wesneski, **3B Isaac Paredes** and **RF Cam Smith** in that trade.

HOUSTON'S OWN: Wesneski was born in Houston, TX, and raised in Cypress, TX, which is about a 25-mile drive northwest of downtown Houston...grew up an Astros fan with **RHP Roy Oswalt** as his favorite player...he graduated from Cy Fair HS, then went on to nearby Sam Houston State, where he pitched for 3 seasons...was selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2019 MLB draft...was traded twice after his selection, first by the Yankees to the Cubs, then by the Cubs to the Astros.

WHAT'S A BEARKAT ANYWAY?: Is one of the most-accomplished pitchers in Sam Houston State history...went 25-9 with a 3.56 ERA and 224 strikeouts (288.0 IP) in 3 years with the Bearkats (2017-19)...his 224 career strikeouts rank 4th all-time in program history...other notable Bearkats include Astros radio broadcaster **Steve Sparks** and Astros 2024 first-round pick **C Walker Janek**.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/25 vs. NYY): Allowed 1 run on 3 hits in 1.0 inning on Tuesday at NYY to earn his 5th win of the season...set his single season career-high in wins (5), previous season-high was 4 wins in 2022.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 5-1-6 with a 2.23 ERA (10ER/40.1IP)...also has 47 strikeouts, a 1.14 WHIP and a .182 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...his .182 opponent average since May 3 ranks 11th among AL relievers (min. 35 IP).

VS. NYY: Including the postseason, he's made 19 career apps. vs. NYY, his most against any non-AL West opponent...has posted a 6.38 ERA (13ER/18.1IP) with 23 strikeouts...in his career at Yankee Stadium, he's recorded a 1.80 ERA (2ER/10IP) with 14 strikeouts.

ROAD WARRIOR: Has posted a 2.86 ERA (7ER/22IP) through his 25 road apps. this season compared to a 5.20 ERA (16ER/27.2IP) at home.

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 96th percentile in whiff percentage (33.9%) and 89th percentile in strikeout rate (29.0%) among MLB players, per Baseball Savant.

SCORELESS STREAK: Recorded a 12-game scoreless streak that spanned 12.0 innings from July 18-Aug. 12...recorded 17 strikeouts, 4 walks, a 0.58 WHIP and a .077 opponent average throughout the streak...was tied for the 4th-longest streak (by apps.) in his career.

A CUT ABOVE: Began throwing a cutter this season in his outing on June 2 vs. PIT and has tossed the pitch at a 9.5 percent rate on the season...has held opponents to a .133 batting average (2x15) vs. his cutter this year.

SCORELESS STREAK: Has made 6 straight scoreless apps (8IP) dating back to Aug. 11...is the 2nd-longest streak by apps. and innings in his career, behind an 8-game, 19.0-inning streak from Aug. 31-Sept. 27, 2025.
