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**BIRDLAND BITES:** Tonight, Baltimore continues a 10-game, 11-day road trip through Texas (1-2), Minnesota (0-1, 2 to play), and Tampa Bay (4 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, dropping two of three to the Phillies before taking two of three from the Angels...The Orioles begin play today 3.0 games back of the final AL Wild Card spot.

🦅 **Coby Mayo** matched a season high with three RBI (7x, last: 7/27 at DET)...The seven such performances are the most by an Oriole this season, outpacing Adley Rutschman (5) and **Pete Alonso**, **Samuel Basallo**, and **Jeremiah Jackson** (all 4)...Mayo has seven extra-base hits (2 2B, 3 3B, 2 HR) over his last 15 games after having seven extra-base hits in his previous 24 games from June 11-July 21.

🦅 **Leody Taveras** is 5-for-16 (.313) with two doubles and a triple over his last four games after going 6-for-47 (.128) with two homers and seven RBI over his previous 17 games from July 17-August 6.

🦅 The Birds are batting .348 (8-for-23) with runners in scoring position over their last two games after going 3-for-25 (.120) in such situations from August 1-8.

🦅 Last night, Oriole pitching allowed the Twins' 1-4 hole hitters to go a combined 10-for-18 (.556) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, and two walks against two strikeouts.

**ACTION JACKSON:** In 22 games following the All-Star break, **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .324/.405/.426 (22-for-68) with four doubles, one home run, 11 runs, six RBI, 10 walks, and two steals.

🦅 During the 22-game stretch, Holliday is slashing .438/.538/.625 (14-for-32) with three doubles and one home run off fastballs (4-seam, sinker, cutter)...Prior to the All-Star break, he slashed .206/.351/.381 (13-for-63) with two doubles and three home runs off such offerings.

🦅 Over his last nine road games since July 22 (G1), he is 17-for-34 (.500) with three doubles, one home run, and four RBI.

🦅 His 1.045 OPS with two outs is fourth highest in the AL and seventh highest in the majors (min. 60 PA).

**TYLER THE CREATOR:** Over his last 22 games since July 8, **Tyler O'Neill** is slashing .298/.355/.702 (17-for-57) with two doubles, seven home runs, 11 runs, and 13 RBI.

🦅 Among all MLB hitters with at least 50 at-bats since July 8, his .702 slugging percentage is the highest in the majors, outpacing teammate **Coby Mayo** (.700) and WSH's CJ Abrams (.651).

🦅 During the 22-game stretch, he is 14-for-34 (.412) with two doubles, seven home runs, and 11 RBI off left-handed pitching.

**SEESAW SERIES:** The O's and Twins have alternated wins and losses to begin the 2026 season series...Baltimore was swept by Minnesota in the 2025 season series (0-6) after the O's won 10 straight against the Twins from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024.

🦅 Baltimore has dropped four straight road games to Minnesota for the first time since a franchise-record 12-game losing skid from July 5, 2018-July 2, 2022.

🦅 The Birds hit one long ball and scored five combined runs in three games at Target Field last season after hitting seven long balls and plating 22 runs in 2024.

**BREAKING POINT:** Oriole hitters have been thrown breaking pitches 31.5 percent of the time, the fifth-highest mark in the majors behind the Phillies (32.9%), Cubs (32.8%), Astros (32.2%), and Reds (31.6%)...The Birds are hitting .199 on such offerings, the second-lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Reds (.190), while their .341 slugging percentage is fifth lowest in MLB.

🦅 **Coby Mayo** has been thrown breaking balls 41.1 percent of the time, the highest mark in MLB (min. 500 breaking pitches thrown), ahead of PHI's Kyle Schwarber (40.5%) and CHC's Dansby Swanson (40.4%).

**WALKING IT OUT:** Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 110 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Tigers (44 G).

🦅 Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 10-game stretch is the second-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954) trailing a 112-game run in 1995.

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 460 walks.

**MAKING THEIR PITCH:** The O's have posted a 3.72 ERA in 68 games since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in MLB during that time behind the Tigers (3.11), Yankees (3.30), Red Sox (3.33), and Brewers (3.62)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

🦅 The rotation has posted a 3.74 ERA since May 24, the fifth-best starter ERA in the AL...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

**NIP AND TUCK:** The Orioles have played in 76 games decided by three or fewer runs, tied for sixth most in the majors...Their 36-40 (.474) winning percentage in such affairs ranks 20<sup>th</sup> in MLB.

🦅 Baltimore is 10-18 (.357) in one-run games, the third-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Giants (10-20, .333) and Mets (11-20, .355).

**PINCH ME:** The Orioles lead MLB with 29 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (25)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least five pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (7).

🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962)

🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Christian Encarnacion-Strand**, **Tyler O'Neill**, and **Leody Taveras** are all tied for second with three pinch-hit RBI each.

🦅 The team's 29 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1991 (30)...The team record is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

**QUICK HITS:** Young is set to make his 20<sup>th</sup> start of the season and the 32<sup>nd</sup> of his career tonight at Minnesota...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his third loss of the season on August 6 vs. Los Angeles-AL after allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts across 4.1 innings pitched...Threw 98 pitches, 60 strikes.  
⚡ Failed to complete at least 5.0 innings for the third time this season (last: 5/17 at WSH, 3.2 IP).  
⚡ Snapped a career-high seven-start streak with at least five strikeouts.

**FASTBALL FOCUS:** Opponents are slashing .191/.293/.322 (29-for-152) off his four-seam fastball with five doubles, five home runs, 21 walks, and 28 strikeouts...His .191 opponent average on the pitch is the fifth-lowest mark in MLB (min. 150 AB ending in pitch) behind CLE's Parker Messick (.161), MIL's Jacob Misorowski (.172), CWS' Sean Burke (.176), and NYY's Cam Schlitler (.181).  
⚡ His average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is tied for the fifth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this year, trailing CHC's Ryan Zeferjahn (+2.2 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+2.0 mph), CWS' Sean Newcomb, and NYM's Kodai Senga (both +1.8 mph).  
⚡ However, opponents are slashing .343/.410/.514 (24-for-70) on his sinker with three doubles, three home runs, eight walks, and 10 strikeouts.

**NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?:** Young is scheduled to make his first career start opposite Minnesota, marking the 21<sup>st</sup> MLB team he's faced since debuting in 2025...Over five career starts vs. the AL Central, he is 1-2 with a 2.93 ERA (9 ER/27.2 IP) and two quality starts...The Orioles are 3-0 in his starts against the division this season.

**SWEET VICTORY:** Baltimore is 15-4 (.789) in games started by Young this season after going 3-9 (.250) in 2025...That included a seven-game winning streak from May 6-June 10, over which he went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.  
⚡ Young is 8-3 (.727) in 19 starts this season...The .727 winning percentage is third in the AL (min. 15 GS) behind BOS' Sonny Gray (.824, 14-3) and TB's Nick Martinez (.786, 11-3).  
⚡ Tallied a career-high-tying three-decision winning streak (also 5/6-6/10/26) from 6/21-7/19, over which he held a 3.41 ERA (11 ER/29.0 IP) with 30 strikeouts to nine walks.

**WHIFFIN':** Young holds a 8.93 K/9.0 IP over his last eight starts, which included a career-high seven-start stretch from June 21-July 31 in which he recorded at least five strikeouts...Previously held a 6.35 K/9.0 IP over his first 11 starts of the season with five or more strikeouts in five of those games.  
⚡ On June 27 at Washington, recorded a career-high 23 swings and misses...The 23 whiffs were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Kyle Gibson (also 23) on July 9, 2023 at Minnesota.  
⚡ He has tallied 31 of his 89 strikeouts (34.8%) this season on his slider, which opponents are whiffing at 40.7 percent of the time... The 40.7 percent whiff rate is the second-best mark among AL starters (min. 200 sliders thrown) behind TOR's Dylan Cease (43.9%).

**THEM CHANGES:** Young is averaging 83.4 mph and 1,383 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last 13 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .242 (16-for-66) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, and 13 strikeouts to two walks... Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles and two strikeouts to two walks.  
⚡ Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 20.0 percent this season, marking a 2.2 percent increase in usage.

**TRENDING UP:** Young's 33.8 percent chase rate is a 6.0 percent increase from 2025 (27.8%) and ranks in the 82<sup>nd</sup> percentile of MLB... Additionally, his 66.0 percent first-pitch strike rate is a 3.9 percent increase from last season (62.1%).

**CATCHING FIRE:** In 11 starts from May 24 (G1)-July 25, Young went 5-1 with a 2.65 ERA (20 ER/68.0 IP)...Among all major league pitchers who threw at least 65.0 innings during that period, his 2.65 ERA was the third-lowest mark in the AL and sixth lowest in all of MLB.  
⚡ However, over his last two starts since July 31, he is 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER/10.0 IP).
