 Entering play today, the O's are 32-22 (.593) in series openers since 2024, tied with Cleveland and New York-AL (both 32-22) for the best mark in the AL during that stretch. The Orioles have not recorded a save through the first seven games of the season for

 - the first time since 2003 (8 G).

 Baltimore is batting .292 (14-for-48) with runners in scoring position, the third-highest mark in the AL behind New York-AL (.318, 14-for-44) and Minnesota (.295, 13-for-44).

 Adley Rutschman has reached base safely in each of his first seven games, the longest
 - season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

MORE ON HENDERSON: He produced 256 hard hit balls (95+ mph) last season, the most by a Baltimore hitter in the Statcast era (since 2015), surpassing Manny Machado (249) in 2017... The 256 hard hit balls ranked fifth in MLB behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (288), TOR's Vladimir rero Jr. (287), NYY's Juan Soto (262), and KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (260).

MULLINS MASHING: Cedric Mullins registered his 17th career leadoff home run yesterday, second most in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Brady Anderson** (44).

HEART OF AMERICA: The Orioles and Royals open a three-game set tonight as Kaufman Stadium...The clubs will meet for a three-game set in Baltimore from May 2-4...The O's won the 2024 season series, 4-2, and have taken each of the last four series sets since 2021, going 17-9 (.654) during that stretch.

In 12 career starts against AL Central foes, is 2-7 with a 5.93 ERA (38 ER/57.2 IP) on 68 hits (8 HR), 43 total runs, 19 walks, and three hit batters with 45 strikeouts... During that stretch, he limited left-handed batters to a .205/.283/.313 (17-for-83) line with 23 strikeouts.

FOUR IS NOT MORE: Last season, Kremer posted a 2.75 ERA (22 ER/72.0 IP) on 52 hits (6 HR), 29 total runs. 25 walks, and two hit batters with 65 strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP from innings one through three...In the fourth inning, however, he owned an 8.87 ERA (23 ER/23.1 IP) on 31 hits (6 HR), 26 total runs, nine walks, and one hit batter with 24 strikeouts and a 1.71 WHIP.
