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LOS ANGELES ANGELS (54-88) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (70-73)

September 6, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 1:35 EDT - Game #144/Home #72

RHP Walbert Ureña (9-9, 2.85 ERA) vs. RHP Paul Skenes (9-11, 3.97 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have gone 3-2 through the first five games of their penultimate homestand of the 2026 season vs. San Francisco (2-1, September 1-3) and Los Angeles-AL (1-1, Friday-Sunday), including a 6-1 loss on Saturday vs. the Angels...Will have the day off on Monday before starting a six-game road trip to Chicago-AL (Tuesday-Thursday) and Chicago-NL (September 11-13)...Have hit 164 home runs (they hit 117 home runs in 2025)...Have 1242 hits, tied with Chicago (NL) and Tampa Bay for the second-most in Major League Baseball, behind only Milwaukee (1246)...Have scored the fifth-most runs (693) in Major League Baseball, behind only Chicago-NL (765), Washington (743), Milwaukee (718) & Los Angeles-NL (698).

A WINDY WEEK: Pittsburgh will play six straight games in "The Windy City" when it takes on Chicago-AL (Tuesday-Thursday) and Chicago-NL (September 11-13) during its next road trip...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, it is the seventh time in the Expansion Era (since 1961) where the Pirates play six straight road games in the same metro area, along with August 14-17, 1986 (at Philadelphia), May 22-27, 2009 (at Chicago-AL/Chicago-NL), August 31-September 5, 2021 (at Chicago-AL/Chicago-NL), September 15-21, 2022 (at New York-NL/New York-AL), April 26-May 1, 2024 (at San Francisco/Oakland) and April 22-27, 2025 (at Los Angeles-AL/Los Angeles-NL)...The Pirates swept the White Sox in their last head-to-head road series (July 12-14, 2024).

AMERICAN SPIRIT: The Pirates will play 10 of their final 19 games vs. American League teams...They will play vs. Los Angeles (Sunday), at Chicago (Tuesday-Thursday), vs. Kansas City (September 18-20) and at Detroit (September 25-27)...The Bucs would win their 10th straight home interleague series (since July 21-23, 2025 vs. Detroit) with a win today.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: Pittsburgh has won three straight series (August 24-26 at San Diego, August 28-30 at St. Louis and September 1-3 vs. San Francisco) and is looking to win four straight series for the first time since July 9-24, 2024...The Bucs have also won three straight series here at PNC Park (also August 14-16 vs. Boston and August 17-19 vs. Detroit) and are looking to win four straight home series for the first time since May 24-June 19, 2024.

PAUL GETS THE CALL: Paul Skenes, who will make his first career start vs. his boyhood team in today's series/homestand finale vs. Los Angeles (AL), has gone 17-11 with a 2.71 ERA (245.1ip/74er) and 290 strikeouts in 42 career starts at PNC Park...His 290 strikeouts are the sixth-most in PNC Park history (since 2001), behind only Mitch Keller (457), Paul Maholm (383), Francisco Liriano (371), Gerrit Cole (356) and A.J. Burnett (294).

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has posted a 3.25 ERA (52.2ip/19er) in its last 11 games, dating back to the 3-2 victory on August 24 at San Diego...That is the seventh-lowest mark among Major League rotations in that time, behind Washington (2.28), Los Angeles-AL (2.37), Philadelphia (2.70), Houston (2.78), Toronto (2.86) and New York-AL (3.02).

SIMON SAYS: The Pirates recalled outfielder Ronny Simon from Triple-A Indianapolis prior to today's game vs. Los Angeles (AL)...Simon, who hit .290 (9-for-31) in nine games during his first stint with Pittsburgh this year (August 5-16), led the International League in batting average (.334) and hits (141) and ranked second in OBP (.426) at the time of today's promotion.

A PIRATE'S LIFE FOR ME: Oneil Cruz stole the 100th base of his Major League career in the eighth inning on Saturday vs. Los Angeles (AL)...His 100 stolen bases are tied with Paul Waner for the 28th-most in team history (since 1887)...Pittsburgh's 83.7 stolen base percentage (118-for-141) is fourth in MLB, behind only Philadelphia (84.3), Chicago-NL (84.3) and Toronto (83.7).

Starter Mitch Keller picked up his fifth win of the season after allowing just five hits across his 6.0 scoreless innings of work.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the first round (No. 1) of the 2023 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Skenes had a no-decision after allowing five runs (eight hits/three walks) over 4.2 innings in Pittsburgh’s 13-12, walkoff win on Sept. 1 vs. San Francisco.

SEPTEMBER TO REMEMBER: Skenes has a 1.82 ERA (49.1ip/10er) and 67 strikeouts across his 10 career September starts...He has posted the fourth-best September ERA in all of Major League Baseball since the start of 2024 (minimum 45.0 innings pitched).

K COLLECTOR: Skenes enters today’s start vs. Los Angeles (AL) with 565 career strikeouts, the 29th-most in franchise history (since 1887)...Ian Snell ranks 27th on the list with 576 strikeouts, while Larry McWilliams is 28th on the list with 574 strikeouts.

AND THE WHIFF: Skenes struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters (also May 17, 2024 at Chicago-NL and July 11, 2024 at Milwaukee) in 5.1 innings on July 25 vs. Chicago (NL)...His three career outings with at least 10 strikeouts and fewer than 6.0 innings are the most by a Pirate in the Modern Era (since 1901)...He also did it on July 6, 2025 at Seattle (5.0 innings, 10 K) and this season on May 28 vs. Chicago-NL (5.1 innings, 10 K).

PAUL-STAR GAME: Skenes was named to his third straight National League All-Star team on July 4...Per Sarah Langs, he was one of eight Major Leaguers to make the All-Star Game in at least each of his first three career seasons, joining Rod Carew (18 straight, 1967-84), Ichiro Suzuki (10 straight, 2001-10), Joe DiMaggio (seven straight, 1936-42), Tom Seaver (seven straight, 1967-73), Dwight Gooden (three straight, 1984-86), Evan Longoria (three straight, 2008-10) and Yu Darvish (three straight, 2012-14)... He became only the third Pittsburgh pitcher to be named to three consecutive All-Star teams, joining Rip Sewell (1943-44, 1946) and Elroy Face (1959-61) on that short list.

THE 500 CLUB: Skenes’ fourth-inning strikeout of Elly De La Cruz during his start on June 26 vs. Cincinnati was the 500th of his Major League career (it came in his 72nd start)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the fastest Pirates pitcher (by starts) since at least 1893 to reach the mark, surpassing Bob Veale (77 starts, 1962-65).

DON'T WALK HERE: Skenes pitched 39.0 consecutive innings without issuing a walk (the streak began in the fourth inning on April 13 vs. Washington) before allowing a walk to Adolis García in the fifth inning on May 17 vs. Philadelphia...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, that was the second-longest streak without a walk by a Pirates pitcher during the Expansion Era (since 1961), behind only Bob Friend (46.1ip, May 28-June 22, 1963).

CRAZY EIGHTS: Skenes pitched 8.0 scoreless innings while allowing two or fewer hits and issuing zero walks in back-to-back starts on May 6 at Arizona and May 12 vs. Colorado...He joined Bob Veale (Sept. 16-22, 1963) and Steve Blass (Sept. 15-20, 1968) as the only Pirates during the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch 8.0 scoreless innings and allow two or fewer hits in back-to-back starts...He also became just the fourth Major League pitcher since 1901 to pitch 8.0 scoreless innings while giving up two or fewer hits and issuing zero walks in back-to-back starts, along with Boston (AL)’s Cy Young (1905), Chicago (AL)’s Billy Pierce (1958) and San Diego’s Mat Latos (2010).

WHAT’S UP, DOC: Skenes won the National League Cy Young Award in 2025, one year after being named the National League Rookie of the Year...He became the second pitcher in Major League history to win the Rookie of the Year Award and the Cy Young Award in consecutive seasons, along with the Mets’ Dwight Gooden (1984-85)...Skenes joined Vernon Law (1960) & Doug Drabek (1990) as the only Pirates to win the award.
