# Everyday People

Willy Adames and William Contreras have both started each of the team's first 56 games.....this is the longest streak to start a season by Brewers teammates since Rvan Braun and Prince Fielder in 2011 (56 games)... the last Brewers teammates to start more than each of the team's first 56 games were Carlos Lee and Brady Clark in 2005 (59 games).

Reliever Enoli Paredes has retired all 12 batters (6k) he has faced in his first 3 appearanaces with the Brewers..... he signed with the team as a free agent on Nov. 17 (non-roster invitee).

FIFTH: 0.....the team is currently in first place, leading the secondplace Cardinals by 5.0 games and third-place Cubs by 5.5 games.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 15-10 at home, going 5-2-1 in series play.....the team has gone 10-3 in its last 13 home games after a 5-7 start.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 18-13 on the road, going 5-4-1 in series play.....the team took 2 of 3 games at Boston on its last trip to snap a streak of four straight road series losses.....the Brewers went 4-0-1 in their first five road series this season.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bulloen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 12 replay challenges this season, going 7-5....their last challenge came on 5/28 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at second base involving Willy Adames stood.

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS (6g, 5gs, 1-2, 4.43)

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers, 25, will be making his seventh appearance and sixth start of the season.....Myers last pitched last Sunday at Boston in a start and had no decision in the Brewers' 2-1 loss [4.1ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 4k, 1wp, 64 pitches)....he is in his third stint with the team (4/17, 4/22-5/9 and 5/21-current).....the team is 1-4 in his starts.....he does not have a quality start.....opponents are batting .256 [22-for-86, 6hr].....he made his Major League debut in a start on 4/23 at Pittsburgh and took a 2-1 loss [5ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1wp, 83 pitches).....Myers was 1-1 with a 1.45 ERA in 5 games/3 starts at Triple-A Nashville [18.2ip, 13h, 3r, 3er, 7bb, 24k, 2hr).....he held International League opponents to a .191 batting average [13-for-68].....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: In his first season in the organization, Myers went 10-5 with a 4.93 ERA in 29 games/26 starts between Double-A Biloxi [27g, 26gs] and Triple-A Nashville [2g].....he led all Brewers Minor League pitchers in wins (10), strikeouts (175) and innings pitched (140.2)....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2) and tied for second in wins (10)....also surrendered a league-leading 30 HR.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Has gone 43-37 with a 4.24 ERA in 141 games/123 starts (620.1ip, 601h, 331r, 292er, 213bb, 636k, 83hr).....has pitched for six organizations: Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022), Chicago-AL (2022) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....did not play in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....Myers committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-0 with a 5.00 ERA in 2 starts (9ip, 5er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 1-2 with a 4.05 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (13.1ip, 6er).
