THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 27

1969 - In the Dome, **Doug Rader's** walkoff grand slam in the bottom of the 9th lifts the Astros to a 6-2 win over the Phillies. **RHP Don Wilson** punches out 13 batters en route to the complete-game victory.

2008 - **Hunter Pence** tallies a career-high 5 hits, helping to lead the Astros to an 8-2 win over the Cardinals at Busch Stadium. Pence ends up going 5-for-5 with 2 RBI in the win. He would add one more 5-hit game to his career resume on July 25, 2013 while with SF.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Tonight, the Astros and Rangers will play the 3rd game of a 4-game series at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX...**RHP Mike Burrows** (2-6) will make his club-leading 11th start of the season as he takes on Rangers **RHP Jacob deGrom** (3-4)...**Rematch:** Burrows faced off against deGrom in his only other career start/app. vs. TEX on June 20, 2025 at PNC Park (6-2 L, 4.2 IP, 4 ER).

THE LAST TIME: In their matchup vs. **RHP Jacob deGrom** on May 16 at Daikin Park, the Astros tallied 4 solo HR off the Rangers ace en route to a 4-1 win... **Jose Altuve, Yordan Alvarez, Christian Walker** and **Zach Cole** all went deep...the 4 HR matched the most that deGrom has given up in a ML outing... the other time was July 7, 2017 vs. STL.

ABOUT BURROWS: **RHP Mike Burrows** is making his club-leading 11th start of the season tonight... this will be his 1st career app. at Globe Life Field and his 2nd career app. vs. the Rangers overall...his other was on June 20, 2025 at PNC Park while with the Pirates, also vs. **RHP Jacob deGrom** (6-2 L, 4.2 IP, 4 ER)...Burrows took the loss in his last start on May 20 at MIN (6 IP, 4 ER)...Burrows was acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a 3-team, 6-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor league **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe, OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Rangers erupted for 8 runs in the 1st inning en route to a 10-7 win over the Astros last night...**RHP Jason Alexander** (1-1) took the loss, but recovered from an 8-run 1st inning to hold the Rangers to just 1 run in his final 5.0 innings...despite the loss, HOU tallied 4 HR in the game, led by **Yordan Alvarez' 2-HR night...Cam Smith** and **Jeremy Peña** also homered.

AIR YORDAN: Last night was the 23rd multi-HR game in **Yordan Alvarez's** career...he has 3 HR in his last 2 games and is 2nd in the AL in HR overall with 18 (**Murakami**-19)...Alvarez enters tonight's game leading the AL in OPS (1.046), SLG (.631) and TB (125).

TALE OF TWO OUTINGS: Last night, **RHP Jason Alexander** became the 1st pitcher to cover 6.0+ IP after allowing 8+ runs in the 1st inn. since **COL LHP Mark Redman** on 4/26/08 at LAD (10 R in 1st, completed 6.0 IP)...Alexander retired 16 of the last 17 batters faced, including the last 12 consecutive.

ABOUT THE NO-NO: Below is information regarding Monday night's 9-0, no-hitter:
***In franchise history, it was the 17th regular season no-hitter and the 18th overall. The last was thrown by RHP Ronel Blanco on April 1, 2024 vs. TOR.**
***It was the 5th combined no-hitter in Astros history and the 1st since Nov. 2, 2022 at PHI, which was Game 4 of the World Series.**
***Per Elias, RHP Alimber Santa became the 1st pitcher since 1900 to pitch in a no-hitter in his ML debut...according to their records, it happened one other time, which was on Oct. 15 of 1892, when RHP Bumpus Jones of CIN hurled a 9.0 inn., CG no-hitter in his ML debut.**
***Last night's no-hitter was the Astros' 7th since 2019, which is the most in the Majors in that span...additionally, the Astros 18 no-hitters overall are the most in the Majors since the franchise was born in 1962.**
***The Astros are the 3rd team ever to have 2 rookies as part of a combined no-hitter...the other teams were the Cubs, 9/4/24 vs. PIT (Porter Hodge, Shota Imanaga) and Mariners, 6/8/12 vs. LA (Lucas Luetge, Stephen Pryor)...source: Elias.**

ROSTER MOVE: Following last night's game, the Astros optioned **RHP Jason Alexander** to Triple A Sugar Land...to take his place on the active roster, the Astros recalled **RHP Logan VanWey** from Triple A Sugar Land today.

ROADIES: Tonight is the 9th game (5-3 thus far) of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for HOU...HOU went 1-2 at MIN on the 1st stop of the trip, 3-0 over the weekend vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field and are 1-1 vs. TEX thus far with 2 games left to play.

THE SILVER BOOT SERIES: The Astros are 3-2 vs. the Rangers thus far in the 2026 Silver Boot Series...they took 2 out of 3 from Rangers, May 15-17 at Daikin Park in the 1st series... dating back to last season, HOU has won 6 of their last 8 games vs. TEX...**Even Series:** The two clubs have played each other 297 times in the regular season in their franchise histories, with the Astros holding a slight advantage, 149-148...recently, the Astros have had the upper hand, winning or splitting nine straight season series, going 96-53 against the Rangers since the start of the 2017 season.

200 CLUB: The Astros next win will be #200 for manager **Joe Espada**...Espada's very first managerial win came via a no-hitter by **RHP Ronel Blanco** on April 1, 2024.

RECENT STROS: The Astros have won 4 of 5, 5 of 7 and 7 of their last 11 games.

FOR STARTERS: Astros starters have a combined ERA of 3.43 (24ER/63IP) over the last 11 games (since May 15) with a 1.06 WHIP...in that span, they have allowed just 36 hits in 63.0 for an AL-best .167 opp. avg...in that span, HOU ranks 1st in the AL in opp. avg., 4th in WHIP and 7th in ERA...additionally, Astros starters have allowed no runs 5 times in the last 11 games.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: 1B Christian Walker is on a sizzling run as of late with 4 HR and 9 RBI in hits last 4 games...for the season, he has been one of the top hitters in the AL and is currently 2nd in the league lead in RBI with 40...Walker also ranks 6th in HR (15) and TB (108), 7th in SLG (.529) and 12th in OPS (.863)...Walker also has not committed an error in his 56 games played.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Since making his season debut on April 15, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has been one of the top starters in the Majors...with Friday's win at CHC, he is now 6-1 in just 7 starts with a 1.32 ERA (6ER/41IP) and a minuscule .169 batting avg. (24 H allowed in 41.0 IP)...since April 15, Arrighetti's 6 wins are tops in the AL in that span...**Model of Consistency:** Arrighetti has allowed 1 ER or less in 6 of his 7 starts and 2 ER or less in all 7 starts... in May, Arrighetti is 3-1 in 4 starts with an 0.78 ERA (2ER/23IP).

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 36...they are 36-for-61 (59%) in their challenges...individually, **Jose Altuve** is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 9 successful challenges (9-for-13, 69%).

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros have been one of the AL's top hitting teams on the road in 2026... entering today's game, HOU leads the AL in road runs scored (141) and batting avg. (.264) and ranks 2nd in OBP (.335), SLG (.423) and OPS (.759).

LAST START 5/20 AT MIN: Allowed 4 runs on 6 hits and 3 walks with 2 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 3 of his last 4 starts.

ABOUT BURROWS: The 2nd-year starter is making his 11th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...leads the Astros in innings pitched (56.1), in starts (10) and in strikeouts with 48...is the only member of the Astros Opening Day rotation to avoid the Injured List; **RHP Hunter Brown** (right shoulder strain), **RHP Cristian Javier** (Grade 2 right shoulder strain), **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (right arm fatigue) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right shoulder inflammation).

VS. THE RANGERS: Is set to make his 2nd career start against the Texas Rangers in his Major League career...his only start came on June 20, 2025 as a member of the Pirates...in that start, he allowed 4 runs on 7 hits and 1 walk with 4 strikeouts in 4.2 innings...he suffered the loss that night as the Pirates fell to the Rangers, 2-6 at PNC Park.

THE JOURNEY: A native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

THE TRADE: After spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Native of Connecticut, Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from the Constitution State...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

2025 RECAP: Pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

LAST APPEARANCE (5/24 at CHC): Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk in 1.0 scoreless inning Sunday at CHC to record his 4th hold of the season.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-2 through 8 consecutive scoreless appearances (7.2 IP), dating back to May 3, also posting a .167 opponent average (4x24) and 1.17 WHIP over that span...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season...his 8-appearance scoreless streak is the longest active streak (in terms of games) among Astros pitchers...is also tied for the 5th-longest active such streak in the AL.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (336) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).
