First Trip Post-Break

The Braves tonight begin their first road trip following the All-Star break, after opening their second-half slate with a 5-2 homestand.

Atlanta will visit Baltimore and New York-NL as part of the six-game trip.

The Braves are 28-22 (.560) away from home this season, the seventh-best road record in baseball. However, Atlanta was 23-9 (.719) over its first 32 road games of the year through May 30, but has gone just 5-13 (.278) in 18 games away from Truist Park since.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Orioles tonight open a three-game weekend series with what are the only scheduled games between the two teams this year... The two are meeting for the sixth time in the last seven seasons, and for the fourth consecutive year.

 Baltimore swept all three games against Atlanta last season at Truist Park, and the Braves are just 1-5 versus the Orioles since the 2024 season...That is Atlanta's worst record versus any American League club in that span.

 Atlanta dropped two-of-three in its last visit here to Oriole Park at Camden Yards in 2024, and its 13-11 (.542) in 24 total games played in this park... The Braves have, however, dropped four of their last five series here dating to 2009, with a three-game sweep in 2021 standing as the only series win.

 Atlanta and Baltimore have played 57 total games since the advent of interleague play in 1997 and have nearly split them evenly down the middle, with the Orioles holding one-game advantage, 29-28.

 LH Trevor Rogers is set tonight to make the 11th start of his career against Atlanta, and enters play 1-7 with a 4.81 ERA (26 ER/48.2 IP) all-time versus the club...He did, however, toss 6.2 scoreless innings against the Braves last July to earn his lone career win versus the franchise...The Orioles have won each of his last five starts dating to June 20, during which the 6-foot-5, 217-pound New Mexico native is 3-0 with a 0.88 ERA (3 ER/30.2 IP).

GRANT HOLMES: Makes the second start of his career against Baltimore tonight, and his first since facing off against LH Trevor Rogers on July 6 of last season...The 6-foot-0, 226-pound South Carolinian took the loss that afternoon, despite allowing just four hits and two runs over 6.0 innings.

 On his first time through a batting order, Holmes is limiting opponents to a .196/.284/.273 line against him with a .557 OPS...When seeing opponents a second time, they are batting .301/.374/.610 with a .984 OPS...Twelve of the 15 total homers he has allowed this year have been in the second time through the order.

 As such, Holmes has completed 6.0 innings just once in his last 10 games, doing so June 3 vs. Toronto...His 92.1 total innings rank 71st out of 74 total pitchers to make at least 18 starts this year.

 His slider has generated a whiff percentage of 39.8 percentage, ranking 13th in the majors on the pitch...Fifty-four of his 78 total strikeouts this season have come on the slider.

FRIDAYS: Atlanta enters play tonight 14-3 (.824) on Friday nights this season, easily the best such record in baseball on the day.

 The Braves are a perfect 9-0 on Fridays at home, and 5-3 in such games on the road.

SIXTY WINS: Atlanta's win over San Diego yesterday afternoon was its 60th of the season, and the Braves became the third team in baseball to reach the threshold after the Dodgers (65-38) and Brewers (64-38)...The Braves reached the mark in their 102nd game.

 Since moving to Atlanta in 1966, this marks the 17th season in which the club won at least 60 of its first 102 games and the first such season since 2023.

 Of those first 16 such seasons, the Braves have advanced to the postseason 15 times...Only the 1983 club, which started 63-39, failed to make the playoffs.

 Atlanta is 6-2 in its last eight games dating to the final contest before the All-Star break, tied with Arizona for the best record in the National League.

HOMERS: Four different Braves hit home runs yesterday afternoon, and Atlanta's 15 total homers since the All-Star break are tied with Cincinnati for second most in the majors...Only San Diego, with 16, has more.

 Ozzie Albies, Drake Baldwin, Michael Harris II and Dominic Smith all homered for Atlanta yesterday afternoon, and Baldwin's four total home runs since the break are tied for second most in the majors.

 Albies and Smith both homered in yesterday's fourth inning, the third multi-homer inning for the Braves since July 4th...Atlanta did not have a single such inning from May 12-July 3.

 All six runs for Atlanta yesterday came courtesy of a home run...However, just 40.7% of the Braves' total runs this season have come via homer, a percentage that sits 18th in the majors...From 2018-2025, Atlanta's 45.8% of runs via homer led the NL and trailed just New York (49.7) in all of baseball.

 Yesterday's win was the 50th this season for Atlanta when hitting at least one home run, and the club is 50-20 (.714) when doing so...That .714 winning percentage trails just the Dodgers (55-19, .743) and Rays (44-17, .721) in the majors...When they do not homer, the Braves are just 10-22 (.313).

AUSTIN RILEY: Singled in yesterday's sixth inning on a 109.5 mph liner into left field, and is batting .333/.379/.667 with a 1.046 OPS in seven games since the All-Star Break...He has raised his OPS for the season by 31 points in that span.

 Ten of Riley's last 13 balls in play have left the bat over 100 miles per hour, and 11 of the 13 have qualified as "hard hit"...His hard-hit percentage of 76.5% since the break ranks second among all qualified batters in baseball, behind just Pittsburgh's Esmerlyn Valdez (85.7).

 Riley has batted .500/.538/1.000 against fastballs since the break, going 6-for-12 with two homers, five RBI and just one strikeout against that pitch group in that span...Before the break, he batted .227/.332/.355 in 172 at-bats that ended on the pitch.
