THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, going 1-2 at Colorado over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games in Los Angeles against the Dodgers the last two nights...today, they will play the series/roadtrip finale at Dodger Stadium...after today's game, they will travel home to enjoy an off day tomorrow, then begin a six-game homestand with three against the Nationals this weekend, then three against the Red Sox from Monday-Wednesday.

Twins have gone 3-6 in rubber games this season...they lost their last chance on July 3 at Miami...their last win in a rubber match was April 16 vs. New York-NL.

TWINS PUT UP 10 SPOT IN LA: The Twins beat the Dodgers last night in Los Angeles by a score of 10-7, evening the series at 1-1....10 runs marked the most the Twins have ever scored against the Dodgers...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on two hits in 3.0 innings pitched, tying a season-high by walking five batters...Twins used six relievers in relief of SWR, their most since using seven on May 31 at Seattle...the offense recorded nine hits as Carlos Correa (2 hits, 2 walks) and Ty France (2 hits, 2 walks) each reached four times...Royce Lewis drove in three runs without the benefit of getting a hit...Christian Vázquez went 2-for-4 with three RBI and a double.

#Jhoan Duran allowed a home run to Shohei Ohtani in the ninth inning last night, snapping his major league best homerless streak at 77.1 innings, his first allowed since June 21, 2024 at Oakland (Shea Langeliers).

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher David Festa on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder inflammation... Festa has gone 3-4, 5.40 ERA (53.1 IP, 32 ER), with 19 walks, 53 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 11 appearances (10 starts) for the Twins this season, including 2-2, 4.03 ERA (22.1 IP, 10 ER) in his last four starts...he most recently took the loss on Monday at Dodger Stadium, allowing four runs on four hits (3 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.1 innings...to replace Festa on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from Triple-A St. Paul...this is Adams' third stint with the Twins this season, including making his major league debut on July 5 vs. Tampa Bay; has gone 1-0, 6.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 6 ER), with one walk and six strikeouts in three relief appearances across his two prior stints.

TWINS-DODGERS: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 28th time in their history today...the Twins are 9-18 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 3-10 all-time at Dodger Stadium (3-13 counting the 0-3 record during the 1965 World Series), 3-8 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome.

₱ 10 runs scored last night marked the most ever for the Twins against the Dodgers...they entered last night having scored 10 runs in their last four games combined vs. LA.

₱ The Twins .333 winning percentage against LA is their second-lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961), trailing Atlanta (.286 — 8-20).

₱ Byron Buxton has hit safely in nine-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, three walks and a 1.022 OPS...he has hit safely in all six career games at Dodger Stadium, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with two doubles, three home runs and a 1.256 OPS.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 15-20 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20) and 1-1 at Los Angeles-NL.

◆ Twins have four NL teams still to play (after the Dodgers): Nationals (July 25-27), Padres (August 29-31), D-Backs (September 12-14) and Phillies (September 26-28).

TWINS TRY MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD) THE DODGERS: With a win today, the Twins will win their 15th series of the season... Minnesota is 14-16-2 in series play, going 9-5-2 at home and 5-11-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 4-10-1 since May 26.

Twins are 2-7-0 all-time in series play against the Dodgers...their two series wins were a three-game sweep from June 26-28, 2006 at the Metrodome and their other was taking two of three from June 27-29, 2011 at Target Field.

GASSING UP THE FERRARI: In five games on this roadtrip, Carlos Correa has reached safely 12 times (5 hits, 7 walks) in 23 plate appearances, for an on-base percentage of .522...over his last 26 games, Correa is hitting .330 (31-for-94) with six doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .457 slugging percentage and an .857 OPS.

◆ Over his last 11 road games, he is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with eight walks, a .426 on-base percentage and an .861 OPS.

- 2025 marks his ninth professional season and fourth with the Twins...is seeking his first unabridged major league season since his rookie year in 2019.
  Finished 2024 season on 15-day IL with a right shoulder strain, retroactive July 20.
  Pitched a career-high 8.0 inning game on May 19, 2024 at Cleveland...previous high of 7.2 innings, May 6, 2019 and July 17, 2019 with San Diego.
  Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
  In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
  Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through the 2025 season.
  In 2021, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
  In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
