RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a three-game series with the middle game against the Houston Astros at Daikin Park. St. Louis has matched their season high with a three-game win streak, last winning four June 17-21, 2025. With every National League Central team winning yesterday, the Cardinals remain a half game back of Cincinnati and Pittsburgh for first place in the division. The entire N.L. Central is separated by 1.5 games in the standings with all five teams posting a winning record.

WORKING FOR THE WEEKEND: The Cardinals and Astros are playing a weekend series in Houston for the first time since they were division rivals in the National League Central, with the last time, May 4-6, 2012. Since the Astros joined the American League in 2013, St. Louis leads the series 11-10 with the Cardinals posting a 5-3 mark at Daikin Park.

WE'RE GOING TO PLAY: This road trip is comprised of two opponents who have retractable roofs where weather cannot complicate the game being played. In Cardinals franchise history, they have a 458-470 record when playing in retractable roof or domed stadiums. The last time the Cardinals posted a winning record on a road trip of two cities or more with guaranteed playing conditions was May 4-9, 2012; playing at Houston (1-2) and then then at Arizona (3-0). In 2015, St. Louis was 14-2 in stadiums with domes/roofs.

CREATING OPPORTUNITIES: The Cardinals were 4-for-14 with runners in scoring position last night, marking their most at-bats with runners in scoring position in a nine-inning game this season; creating 16 at WSH (4/7) in 10 innings and 14 vs. NYM (4/1) in 11 innings. The four hits with runners in scoring position matched their most in a game this season.

HIT FIRST, HIT HARD: When the Cardinals score first, they are a perfect 7-0, the only unblemished mark in the league (four teams with one loss). **THIS STAT ISNT DONE YET...** St. Louis is tied for the MLB lead in walk-off wins (3) with San Diego and ranks tied for 2nd in come-from-behind wins (8) trailing Arizona (9).

STORMIN' NOLAN GORMAN: Nolan Gorman blasted his 10th career three-run home run last night, most among active Cardinals. He ranks T-26th in franchise history in three-run home runs. Gorman leads all active Cardinals with 77 career home runs. His 12 RBI through 18 games this season are his most since he posted 18 RBI through his first 18 games in 2023.

0.00'BRIEN: Cardinals relief pitcher Riley O'Brien is off torrid start in 2026 without allowing an earned run in his first nine appearances (10.1 IP) and would all be scoreless if Major League Baseball did not allow free baserunners in extra inning games. O'Brien has closed down all five save opportunities and is tied with three other pitchers, including teammate JoJo Romero, as the only National League qualifying relievers with a 0.00 ERA. O'Brien has not allowed a hit since April 1 and has compiled an 0.39 WHIP ranking 2nd only to Padres' Mason Miller 0.21 for the league lead.

HIT MAN: Jordan Walker extended his hitting streak to 12 games with an RBI single in the 1st inning last night, which was also his first game-winning RBI of the season. The streak currently ranks T-2nd in MLB for actives behind Arizona's Ildemaro Vargas for the 2026 season (Vargas extends to 16 back to 9/26/25). Walker's double-digit hit streak marks the 4th of his career and first since 2023 when he posted three different streaks of 10 games or more as a rookie and was the only player in MLB to have three different double-digit marks that season. Walker's longest streak is 17 games (June 6-29, 2023).

WALKER'S WORLD: Jordan Walker leads the National League and is tied with the Yankees' Aaron Judge and the Astros' Yordan Alvarez or the Major League lead with eight home runs. The last season the Cardinals had the Major League home run leader was Albert Pujols with 47 in 2009.

REHAB UPDATE: Cardinals RHP Hunter Dobbins (right knee surgery) will be making his 4th rehab start and first on five days rest when Memphis (AAA) hosts Gwinnett Sunday. Dobbins is 3-0 with a 2.93 ERA through his first three starts, pitching 5.0 innings in each start and has compiled an 0.98 WHIP. Relief pitcher RHP Matt Pushard (right patellar tendonitis) will be making his second rehab appearance for Memphis tonight. He threw a scoreless inning with one hit in his last appearance on Wednesday.

- Making his fourth start of the 2026 season tonight as he completes the starting rotation's fourth time thru; it's his 65th career start (173rd career appearance).
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (64), wins (25), innings pitched (475.0) and strikeouts (328).**
- Is seeking his 1st win on the road since 5/16/25 at Kansas City.
- Is 5-13 with 4.42 ERA in his 31 career starts on the road with the Cardinals going 11-20 in those contests
- Has walked multiple batters in each of his last 11 road starts while failing to earn a winning decision.
- Has recorded a win in each of his past two road starts when he did not allow a walk (5/16/25 at KC & 5/10/25 at WSH).

BETTER BABIP: Has a .269 Batted Ball In Play average to the begin the season, down from his .296 mark in 2025.

2025 NOTES:

N.L. Rankings: Groundball Pct. (59.5%, 1st), Ground balls (316, 2nd), Groundball/Flyball Ratio (2.75, 5th), GIDP/9 IP (0.66, 10th), Wild Pitches (12, T-1st).

CAREER HIGHS: Established new single-season career highs in starts (31), quality starts (9), strikeouts (111), and innings pitched (162.2).

BREAKING BAD: Limited opposing batters to a combined .206 batting average (49-238) on his 1,162 combined off-speed pitches (778 Sliders and 381 Knuckle Curves).

AT A LOSS: Suffered 15 losses, most by Cardinal since Kip Wells went 7-17 in 2007. Ended the season on an eight-game losing streak (Aug. 3-present), T-2nd longest active in MLB, and the longest by a Cardinal since Adam Wainwright dropped 10 straight decisions (June 24-Sept. 7, 2023). The Cardinals were 12-19 overall in his starts, including a 3-13 mark in his final 16.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (63.2%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.
- As a starting pitcher (343.1 IP), Pallante's 59.8 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 340.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. HOUSTON:

- Making his 2rd career start (3rd app.) vs. the Astros and his 1st since 2024 season.
- He dropped an 8-5 decision as a starter on 6/4/24 at Daikin Park, allowing 6 runs on 6 hit in 3.0 IP.
- Is winless in four career appearances (2 starts) vs. AL West clubs, facing both the Astros and Rangers twice.
