HISPANIC HERITAGE WEEKEND: This weekend's Hispanic Heritage Weekend presented by Estrella Jalisco will celebrate Puerto Rican Heritage today and Dominican Republic Heritage tomorrow as well as offer specialty food items at Taste of Chase at Section 130: Venezuelan Arepas Pelúa and Mexican Picadillo Empanadas...today's Special Event Ticket Pack features a Puerto Rican-inspired D-backs jersey while the stadium festivities include a recognition of Puerto Rican-owned businesses Phoenix Coqui and Batey Puerto Rican Gastronomy and performances by Miguel “Mambo” De Leon and Orgullo Boricua AZ...tomorrow's Special Event Ticket Pack features a Dominican Republic-inspired hat while the stadium festivities will include a ceremonial first pitch by D-backs' Vice President of Latin Operations Junior Noboa, dance lessons in La Terraza and a performance by Stilo Dance Company, a pregame recognition of Dominican community leaders Caroline Torres and Vanessa Garcia as well as a celebration of the award-winning Mambo's Dominican Kitchen.

- HERE’S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 games vs. Reds and 10-6 in their last 16 games (since 2024).
- Vs. Reds, the D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 home games and 11-6 in their last 17 home games (since 2021).
 - Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 10 straight games, batting .353 (12-for-34)/1.265 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 3 RBI, 8 walks (4 K) and 2 stolen bases.
 - Gabriel Moreno** has a career-best 14-game hitting streak, MLB's longest active streak, batting .373 (22-for-59)/1.057 OPS with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 14 RBI and 4 walks.
 - Michael Soroka**, in his last 2 starts (vs. COL, @ ATL), is 0-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER in 10.0 IP), 1 extra-base hit allowed (2B), 4 walks and 9 strikeouts.
 - In his last 3 starts vs. Reds, is 0-1 with a 1.84 ERA (3 ER in 14.2 IP), opponent .106 AVG and 16 strikeouts.

- LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 9-0 vs. Reds for their eighth shutout, and first shutout vs. Reds since June 8, 2022 on the road (7-0).
- The D-backs had 4 stolen bases within the first 2.0 innings (**Corbin Carroll**, **Tim Tawa**, **Jose Fernandez** and **Gabriel Moreno**) for the fourth time in franchise history and were the first team to do so this season.
 - Jordan Lawlar** (3-for-5, HR, 3 RBI) had a career-best 3 hits and 3 RBI.
 - Eduardo Rodriguez** earned his 13th win, tying his career-second-best season win total (also: 2018, '21, '23) after tossing 5.2 scoreless innings with 4 hits and 2 walks allowed and 4 strikeouts.
 - Relievers **Dennis Santana** (1.1 IP), **Justin Martinez** (1.0 IP) and **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) combined for 3.1 no-hit frames.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 1.0 game behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 3.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

WINS SINCE JULY 9: The D-backs' 23 wins (23-14) since July 9 are tied for second in the Majors with the Yankees and Padres, behind the Red Sox (27).

MORENO'S HOME STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno's** career-best 30-game home on-base streak is the third longest single-season home streak in club history, behind Steve Finley’s 31 in 2000 and Stephen Drew’s 38 in 2009.

BULLPEN SCORELESS: D-backs' relievers have gone scoreless over their last 2 games (7.2 innings) with just 2 hits allowed and 6 strikeouts (29 BF).

GETTING RISP-Y: Over their last 6 games with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .333 (19-for-57)/1.051 OPS with 4 doubles, 5 homers, 30 RBI and 5 walks.

MORENO'S HITTING STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno's** 14-game hitting streak is the second longest by a D-backs catcher (primary position as catcher w/ plate appearances as designated hitter and pinch hitter):

LINEUP 5-9 PRODUCTION: Since the All-Star break, D-backs' 5-9 batters' have combined for an MLB-best 172 hits and 278 total bases...also rank in AVG (2nd, .279), OPS (2nd, .799), homers (T-2nd, 22) and RBI (T-2nd, 93).

VS. STARTING PITCHERS: The D-backs offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among NL teams since Aug. 10 in OPS (1st, .856), AVG (2nd, .286), SLG (2nd, .508), fewest strikeouts (2nd, 39), OBP (3rd, .348), XBH (3rd, 24), runs (T-3rd, 32) and TB (4th, 94).

- WAR LEADERS:** Since June 1, **Gabriel Moreno's** 3.3 fWAR ranks second in the Majors, behind only Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (6.5)...**Moreno's** 4.0 season fWAR ranks ninth in the NL.
- Corbin Carroll's** 4.3 season fWAR ranks third among NL players, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (8.4) and Otto Lopez/MIA (4.4).
 - Geraldo Perdomo's** 1.6 season defensive bWAR ranks eighth in the NL.
 - Eduardo Rodriguez's** 4.8 season bWAR for pitchers ranks fourth in the NL.
