THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY	
On this date in 2000, the Orioles turned a triple play as <b>SS Melvin Mora</b> purposely let a short fly ball drop in left field with runners at first and second...The runner at second ( <b>Travis Fryman</b> ) was tagged out, the runner at first ( <b>Wil Cordero</b> ) was forced out at second, and the batter ( <b>Sandy Alomar</b> ), thinking the infield fly rule would be enforced, did not run to first and was called automatically out for returning to the dugout.	

**NEW YORK, NEW YORK:** The Orioles return home tonight to begin a six-day, six-game homestand against the New York Mets (two games) and the New York Yankees (four games)...Following this homestand, the Orioles depart for New York to play the Mets (two games) and Yankees (four games)...Each of the O's next 12 games will come against teams from New York City.

**.400 HITTER:** INF **José Iglesias** went 2-for-5 on Monday at Buffalo's Sahlen Field and is now hitting .405 (30-for-74) through his first 20 games with the Orioles...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Iglesias is just the fourth player in Orioles history (since 1954) to hit at least .400 through their first 20 games with the team (min. 50 at-bats)...He joined **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (30-for-74, .405), **David Newhan** in 2004 (30-for-74, .405), and **Tim Beckham** in 2017 (36-for-85, .424)...Among players with at least 50 at-bats, Iglesias' .405 average leads the majors, while New York-AL's **DJ LeMahieu** ranks second with a .398 average.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** In yesterday's game, the Orioles used a duplicate batting order for the first time this season (1. Alberto, 2. Santander, 3. Iglesias, 4. Núñez, 5. Severino, 6. Sisco, 7. Mountcastle, 8. Ruiz, 9. Mullins), as it matched the same batting order as Saturday's...There are three teams in the majors that have yet to use the same batting order twice this season, including tonight's opponent the Mets (the other two are Tampa Bay and Seattle).

🦅 Last season, the Orioles used 150 different batting orders in their 162 games.

**TRADE WINDS:** On Sunday, the Orioles made two trades prior to the afternoon game against the Blue Jays...The Orioles acquired two players to be named later from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for **LHP Tommy Milone**...The Orioles also acquired **INF Tyler Nevin**, **INF Terrin Vavra**, and a player to be named later from the Colorado Rockies in exchange for **RHP Mychal Givens**...On Monday, the Orioles acquired **LHP Kevin Smith** and a player to be named later or cash considerations from the New York Mets in exchange for **RHP Miguel Castro**.

**THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW:** INF **Hanser Alberto** went 1-for-4 on Monday...Since the start of the 2019 season, Alberto leads the majors with 100 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .405 (100-for-247) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks third in the AL and 10<sup>th</sup> in the majors with a .321 (45-for-140) average against all pitchers...He is tied for second in the AL and is tied for third in the majors with 12 doubles...His 14 multi-hit games rank second in the AL and are tied for third-most in the majors.

**SMALL BALL FOR ALL:** The Orioles lead the majors with 11 bunt hits this season...OF **Cedric Mullins** leads the majors with six bunt hits, while **INF Hanser Alberto** ranks second in the majors with three bunt hits and **INF/OF Andrew Velazquez** is tied for third in the majors with two bunt hits.

**I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU:** OF **Anthony Santander** went 2-for-5 on Monday with two doubles, but has hit safely in 21 of his last 24 games...His recent hitting streak of 18 games marked a career high...Santander hit .329 (25-for-76) with eight home runs, eight doubles, a triple, and 20 RBI from August 5 [2]-23...It was the longest stretch by an Oriole since **Nick Markakis'** 18-game mark from April 21-May 11, 2014.

🦅 Santander's 10 home runs on the season lead the O's, are tied for seventh in the AL, and are tied for 11<sup>th</sup> in the majors...He is tied for third in the AL and is tied for fifth in the majors with 29 RBI this season...24 of his 38 hits have been for extra-bases (13 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs), leads the AL and leads the majors with 24 extra-base hits.

**CATCH THIS:** The O's catching corps of **Pedro Severino**, **Chance Sisco**, and **Bryan Holaday** ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...Severino ranks seventh in the AL with a .309 (30-for-97) overall batting average...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

**IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST:** The O's have been very successful swinging at the first pitch...They rank first in the majors in batting average (.424), rank second in OPS (1.153) and extra-base hits (24), lead the AL and are tied for first in the majors in doubles (15), and lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors in hits (56) as a team on the first pitch.

🦅 OF **Anthony Santander** leads the Orioles with nine hits on the first pitch...He is tied for seventh-most in the majors and is tied for second in the AL...**Renato Núñez** is tied for eighth in the AL with seven first-pitch hits, while **Hanser Alberto** is tied for 17<sup>th</sup> in the AL with six hits on the first pitch of an at-bat.

🦅 Santander and Núñez are tied for fourth in the majors with five extra-base hits each on the first pitch, while **C Pedro Severino** is tied for ninth in the majors with four extra-base hits on the first pitch.

**INTERLEAGUE INFO:** The O's will play a total of 20 games against National League opponents this season, including contests with the Miami Marlins (0-4), Washington Nationals (4-2), Philadelphia Phillies (3-0), New York Mets (four games), and Atlanta Braves (three games)...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the O's are 204-232...The O's went 7-13 in Interleague Play last season...Baltimore's 14 Interleague victories in 2016 were the most in club history.

**INJURED LIST:** Six players are on the Injured List...**RHP Shawn Armstrong** (left SI joint inflammation; retroactive to 8/26), **INF Chris Davis** (left knee patellar tendinitis), and **OF Austin Hays** (non-displaced rib fracture), are on the 10-day Injured List...**LHP Wade LeBlanc** (left elbow stress reaction), **INF/OF Trey Mancini** (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and **INF Richie Martin** (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

**LAST START:** Made his sixth start of the season on 8/26 at TB and took a no-decision after allowing three runs (earned) on four hits, one home run, and a season-high three walks with three strikeouts over 4.0 innings of work...Threw 83 pitches (49 strikes).

**AGAINST NEW YORK-NL:** Has made just one outing against the Mets in his career...That appearance came back on 9/10/17 at Citi Field (while with Cincinnati), where he allowed three runs on three hits, including a solo home run to Dominic Smith over 0.2 innings of relief...Will be his first career start against the Mets.

**FACING THE NL EAST:** In 12 career appearances (five starts) against NL East opponents, Wojciechowski owns a 1-3 record and a 4.91 ERA (20 ER/36.2 IP) with eight walks and 35 strikeouts...His 4.91 ERA is his lowest against any of the six divisions...NL East opponents are batting .257 against Wojciechowski in his career, which is the second-best mark among the divisions...Has faced NL East opponents three times already this season, combining to go 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA (5 ER/13.2 IP) with four walks and 10 strikeouts in these games.

**HOME WOES:** Making his fifth home start of the season...Has pitched in 13 career games (12 starts) at Oriole Park, and owns a 2-7 record with a 5.43 ERA (35 ER/58.0 IP) through these games...In his career at Oriole Park, opponents have hit .262 (60-for-229) against Wojciechowski, with 25 extra-base hits (eight doubles, 17 home runs).

**GETTING OUT OF TROUBLE:** Opponents are batting just .211 (4-for-19) with two walks and six strikeouts with runners in scoring position against Wojciechowski this season...With RISP and two outs, opponents have been held to a .125 clip (1-for-9)...In 2019, opponents batted .275 (19-for-69) against him with RISP.

**A LOT OF PUNCHOUTS:** Wojciechowski struck out 54 batters in his first nine starts last season (7/2/19-8/17/19)...According to STATS LLC., his 54 strikeouts ranked as the fifth-most in Orioles history (since 1954) among a pitcher's first nine starts of the season...Gene Brabender - 55 (7/4/66-8/30/67), Kevin Brown - 57 (4/29/95-6/12/95), Jack Harshman - 58 (4/22/58-6/7/58), and Hoyt Wilhelm - 60 (8/31/58-5/9/59) all rank ahead of him.

**OUT OF THE BULLPEN:** Has made 20 career appearances in relief, and owns a 2-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (12 ER/32.0 IP) and an opponent average of .200 (23-for-115) with 13 walks and 33 strikeouts...In nine relief outings at home, he has surrendered just one run in 20.2 innings pitched (0.44 ERA) while surrendering seven hits and six walks with 23 strikeouts in 75 batters faced.
