NOTABLE OFFSEASON TRANSACTIONS: 10/30, declined the mutual option on OF Ryan Braun.....11/4, named Ed Sedar advisor to the Major League coaching staff; named Quintin Berry first base coach......11/19, promoted Matt Arnold to senior vice president and general manager......12/2, acquired a player to be named (LHP Leo Crawford) from Los Angeles-NL for RHP Corey Knebel......1/21, signed INF/OF Daniel Robertson to a 1-year contract......2/5, signed 2B Kolten Wong to a 2-year contract with a club option for 2023......2/22, re-signed LHP Brett Anderson to a 1-year contract......2/23, signed 3B Travis Shaw to a Minor League contract with an invitation to Major League camp.....3/8, signed OF Jackie Bradley Jr. to a 2-year contract with a player opt-out clause after 2021 and mutual option for 2023.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (436-415) and sixth full season.....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TODAY'S STARTER: #53 - RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (1gs, 0-0, 6.75)

WODDRUFF AT A GLANCE: Brandon Woodruff, 28, will make his second start of the season.....Woodruff started on Opening Day vs. Minnesota and received no decision in the Brewers' 6-5, 10-inning win (4ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 5k, 1wp, 78 pitches).....it was his second career Opening Day start and second in a row.....Woodruff was selected in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.

ENCORE!: Brandon Woodruff is the first Brewers pitcher to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons since **Yovani Gallardo** started a franchise-record five in a row from 2010-14.....Woodruff made his first Opening Day start last 7/24 at Chicago-NL and took a 3-0 loss (5ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr).....he allowed a 2-run homer to Ian Happ.

LAST SEASON: Woodruff went 3-5 with a 3.05 ERA in 13 starts last season.....he tied three others for the Major League lead in starts.....he ranked among the NL leaders in innings pitched (4th, 73.2), opponent batting average (4th, .204), H/9IP (4th, 6.72), WHIP (5th, 0.99), K/BB (5th, 5.06), strikeouts (7th, 91), K/9IP (7th, 11.12) and ERA (9th, 3.05).....the team went 6-7 in his starts.....he made a team-leading 6 quality starts.

CAREER: Is 19-11 with a 3.70 ERA in 63 games / 48 starts [284.2ip, 117er].....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers [2017-21].....was a 2019 All-Star.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 11-5 with a 3.88 ERA in 34 games / 27 starts [157.2ip, 68er].....went 1-2 with a 3.34 ERA in 6 starts last season [35ip, 13er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 8-6 with a 3.47 ERA in 29 games / 21 starts (127ip, 49er).....went 2-3 with a 2.79 ERA in 7 starts last season (38.2ip, 12er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 0-1 with a 4.65 ERA in 8 games / 6 starts (31ip, 16er), including 0-1 with a 2.76 ERA in 3 starts last season (16.1ip, 5er).....is 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA in 4 games / 2 starts at Wrigley Field (11.1ip, 6er).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .250 (16-for-64) hitter with 1 HR (7/13/18 at Pittsburgh - solo off Nick Kingham)....has 5 sacrifice bunts....is 0-for-1 this season.....Woodruff also homered in Game 1 of the 2018 NLCS vs. Los Angeles (solo off Clayton Kershaw).....it marked the first postseason home run by a pitcher in franchise history.
