WE'RE TALKING BAAAASEBALL: Following yesterday's loss, the Giants will try to win this series and secure a winning homestand with a victory in today's finale

- On their longest homestand of the year the Giants have gone 2-2 vs. Arizona, 2-1 vs. the Mets and 1-1 so far against the Pirates.
- Through the nine games on this homestand, SF's offense is slashing .240/.307/.373 while scoring 34 runs ( 3.8 runs/ game)... on the other side of the diamond, Giants pitching has logged a 4.06 ERA (37er, 82.0ip) but 16 of those 37 earned runs came in the loss to Arizona last Friday.
- Breaking down the ERA a bit further, Giants starters have a 2.08 ERA on this homestand (11er, 47.2ip) while the bullpen has a 6.82 ERA (26er, 34.1ip)

PIRATES BOOTY: The Giants have won 11 of their last 15 games vs. the Pirates dating to July 25, 2021

- However, the Giants have lost three of their last four series to the Pirates here in SF dating to the 2019...the lone series win was a three-game sweep of the Pirates here in 2022.

COUPLE OF NEWBS: No one on either side of the diamond today has faced the scheduled starters in today's contest...for SF' starter RHP Keaton Winn today's start will be his 11th in the Majors (and 15th appearance overall)...for Pittsburgh's Jared Jones, today's outing is the sixth of his young career after debuting earlier this year.

WHERE SHOULD WE START: Giants starters have logged an 0.84 ERA (3er, 32.Oip) over their last six games...they've struck out 28, walked six and allowed one homer in those 32.0 innings.

- Over their last 21 games dating to April 5, Giants starters have logged a 3.19 ERA (41er, 115.2ip), sixth-best in the Majors...in the National League specifically, it's the thirdbest starter's ERA in that span behind the Phillies (1.83) and Pirates (2.88)
- LHP Blake Snell, who signed late and didn't really have the benefit of a traditional spring training, has made three starts in this 21 -game span with an 11.57 ERA (15er, 11.2 ip )...the Giants starters in the other 18 games have a combined ERA of 2.25 (26er, 104.0ip)

WINN DAY: RHP Keaton Winn looks to continue his recent winning ways in this afternoon's series finale...Winn has won his last two starts after dropping each of his first three to start the year despite a solid performance.

- In his last three starts, Winn has allowed four runs in 17.0 innings (2.12 ERA) with 16 strikeouts and five walks.
- The 26-year-old enters today's outing with a $59.5 \%$ groundball rate, fourth-best in the Majors among qualified starters...he's part of the Giants trio that rank in the top-5 in groundball percentage with RHP Logan Webb third at 59.7\% and yesterday's starter RHP Jordan Hicks fifth at 58.9\%.
- Winn's most used pitch is his splitter, which he's thrown $43.0 \%$ of the time and had success as opposing batters are 8 -for-41 (.195) off the pitch with a . 341 SLG
- Over his last three starts he's really mixed the four-seamer in well as hitters have gone 0 -for-17 off the pitch with seven strikeouts...on the year, hitters are 3 -for- 25 off it (.120) with a . 240 SLG


PAT ON THE BACK: C Patrick Bailey carries a .309/.372/.515 slash line into today's game..Bailey's . 887 OPS is seventhbest among MLB catchers entering today (min. 70 PA ).

- On the other side of the diamond, Bailey's +4 defensive runs saved in the early going are second-most among MLB catchers...only SEA's Cal Raleigh (+8) has more.
- Bailey's 60.4 sweet spot \% (a batted ball with a launch angle between 8 and 32 degrees) leads the Majors... for comparison, his sweet spot \% last season was $36.2 \%$ (SIS).

UP ALL NIGHT...: The Giants have scored 49 runs from the 7th inning on thus far in 2024, tied for fifth-most in the Majors behind the Braves (59), Orioles (53), Mets (51) and Twins (50).

- 12 of the Giants 25 (48\%) homers this season have come in the 7th inning or later.

BUT MAYBE WE SHOULD GET UP EARLIER?: On the flip side, the Giants 64 runs in innings 1-6 are seventh-fewest in the Majors.

- The Giants 13 homers in innings 1-6 are the second-fewest of any MLB team...only the Tigers have hit less (12)
LET'S TALK ABOUT POWER: DH/OF Jorge Soler hit his first homer with a runner on base last night in the 10th inning...last season, Soler had 15 of his 36 (41.7\%) homers come with at least one man on.
- As a team this year, 10 of the Giants 25 homers have come with men on base...the only Giants with multiple HRs with men on thus far are IF Matt Chapman (two), IF Thairo Estrada (two) and IF Patrick Bailey (two)
- The Giants 10 homers with men on are tied for 19 th of 30 MLB teams.
- Entering play today, SF's 25 homers overall rank 21 st in MLB.

GET SOME REST: Following today's game, the Giants will fly to Boston where they will enjoy an off day on Monday before opening up their longest road trip of the season Tuesday night at Fenway Park

- SF's upcoming 10-game, 11-day road trip takes them through Boston (three games), Philadelphia (four games) and Colorado (three games).
- The Giants have not been to Fenway Park since 2019 when they took two-of-three from the Red Sox.
- Tomorrow's off day is also the Giants last until May 16 with SF scheduled to play 16 straight games before that off day.

## 2024 RECORD: 2-3, 3.54 ERA

Bats/Throws: R/R
Signed Through: 2024
IT'SIOWA: The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Pirates for the first time in his young career.. Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second consecutive win on Monday against the Mets...matched a career-best 6.0 runs and held New York batters to a run on four hits with a walk and six strikeouts. Winn's only blemish was a solo shot by NYM's Pete Alonso, making that his second consecutive outing where a solo homer accounted for all of the runs he surrendered in the start.

TRENDING UP: Over his last three starts, Winn is $2-1$ with a 2.12 ERA and 16 strikeouts (17.0ip)...he's holding opponents to a . 339 slugging percentage in that span...the stretch comes after starting the season 0-2 with a 5.73 (7er, 11.0ip) and seven strikeouts in two starts prior.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Batters are just 3-for-25 with nine strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seam fastball this season.. Winn's .120 opposing average with the four-seamer is sixth-best among NL starters (min. 25 PA)...more specifically over his last three starts dating to April 12 in Tampa, Winn has held opponents hitless in 17 at-bats ending with the pitch while striking out nine batters in 18 plate appearances.

BANANA SPLIT: Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using $43.0 \%$ of the time this season...nine of his 23 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .195 ( $8 \times 41$ ) clip with just three extra-base hits (. 341 SLG)...Winn's $43.0 \%$ splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

GOT 'EM: Has been very successful at retiring batters when he gets ahead of the count in his young career...in 109 career plate appearances ending with Winn ahead in the count, opponents are hitting .160 with a .374 OPS.


WINNING WAYS: Has made 10 career Major League starts and has thrown at least 4.0 innings and allowed six hits or fewer in each of those outings...the 10 starts are tied with Jeff Brantley for the second-longest such streak by any Giants player to begin their MLB career in the modern era (since 1901) ...only Albert Suárez had a longer streak (12).
2023 SEASON: After starting the year in Triple-A Sacramento, Winn made his Major League debut on June 13 at St. Louis in relief, firing 4.0 innings and picking up the save...he joined SF's rotation two weeks later and made five starts for the Giants, going 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA as a starter...overall, the right-hander posted a 1-3-1 record with a 4.68 ERA and 1.04 WHIP across nine MLB appearances.

SAVING THE DAY: After collecting the save in his Major League debut on June 13, 2023 at St. Louis, Winn became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his debut (Elias)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).

## \#75 CAMILO DOVAL RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker
Last Game: $4 / 27$ vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h, k (17 pitches)

- Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made nine appearances and gone 2-0-4 with six hits allowed, one run allowed, four walks, and 14 strikeouts (9.0ip) for a 1.00 ERA.
- 11 of his 14 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).


## \#64 SEAN HJELLE $>$ RHP

## Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: $4 / 24$ vs. NYM; L, 2.2ip, 2h, 3r, 3er, bb, 2k, 2 hr (37p)

- Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19..made season on April 21 , tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring
- Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the ' 23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days
- 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.


## \#77 LUKE JACKSON $\stackrel{\text { RHP }}{ }$

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: $4 / 27 \mathrm{vs}$. PIT; $1.0 \mathrm{ip}, \mathrm{h}$, bb ( 23 pitches)

- Reinstated from the 15-day IL last Monday...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- Has made two appearances since being reinstated (2.0ip, 2h, bb)
- Batters are 4-for-8 with two walks off Jackson in his three appearances at the MLB level this year.
- Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).


## \#68 ERIK MILLER•LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: $4 / 24 \mathrm{vs}$. NYM; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- Over his last nine outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs over 9.1 innings (2.89 ERA) with 14 strikeouts, one walk, a 0.54 WHIP and a 129 opposing batting average ( $4 \times 31$ ).
- LHBs are 2-for-16 off him early on...RHBs are 4-for-25.
- The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to MLB.com.
- Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters ( $12.63 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ ip)


## \#33 TAYLOR ROGERS • LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter
Last Game: $4 / 27$ vs. PIT; 1.0ip, 2h, 3r, 2er, 2k, 2hr (14 pitches)

- Allowed two homers in the 10th inning last night... was only the second time in his MLB career ( 455 games) that he's given up multiple homers in a single inning...the only other time was August 14, 2022 at St. Louis while pitching for Milwaukee.
- Has appeared in 10 games for SF so far, allowing five runs (four earned) over 8.1 innings of work with seven strikeouts.
- Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging $11.15 \mathrm{SO} / 9$ ( $64 \mathrm{k}, 51.2 \mathrm{ip}$ ).
- Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1\%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6)


## \#71 TYLER ROGERS $\stackrel{\text { RHP }}{ }$

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: $4 / 27$ vs. PIT; 1.Oip, 2h, k(16 pitches)

- Has appeared in 14 of SF's first 28 games...his 14 appearances are tied for fourth-most in the Majors.
- Opposing batters have gone 15-for-50 (.300) with a . 325 BABIP off Rogers early here in 2024...last year hitters batted 236 with a . 274 BABIP off him.
- His hard-hit rate allowed this year is 25.6\%, which is in the top 4\% of the league.
- Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (276g)


## \#65 LANDEN ROUPP $\stackrel{\text { RHP }}{ }$

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter Last Game: 4/24 vs. NYM; 1.1 ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, k (36 pitches)

- Has allowed seven runs (six earned) with three walks and two strikeouts over his last two appearances (3.0ip)...gave up two runs in his first seven MLB games (8.2ip)
- Made his MLB debut on March 29
- Is the Giants No. 11 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 14 according to Baseball America.
- Roupp struck out 42 batters over 31.0 innings (12.2 K/9ip) with Double-A Richmond in 2023 and held opponents to a 206 average.
- Did not pitch after June 30 last year after landing on IL w/back inflammation

## Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/26 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h, bb, 2k, hbp (33 pitches)

- Threw a season-high 33 pitches on Friday.
- His 15 appearances are tied for most in the Majors with OAK's T.J. McFarland and STL's Ryan Helsley.
- 12 of Walker's 15 appearances have been scoreless.
- Has stranded four of his six inherited runners so far in 2024.
