

BOSTON RED SOX (12-10) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (11-10) APRIL 21, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 1:35 EDT - GAME #22/HOME #8 RHP JOSH WINCKOWSKI (1-1, 4.63 ERA) vs. LHP MARTÍN PÉREZ (1-0, 2.55 ERA)

THE PIRATES: ... have lost a season-high five straight games... Were doubled up 4-2 in the middle game of their weekend series against the Red Sox yesterday afternoon... Went 3-0-2 in their first five series before being swept by the Mets from 4/15-17 for their first series loss...Are 2-3 against the AL East this season (their next series against the AL East after today will take place in Toronto from 5/31 to 6/2)...Will close out the 2024 campaign at Yankee Stadium from 9/27-29... Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Swept a season-opening four-game series on the road for the first time since **BUCS WHEN...** doing so in 1903 in Cincinnati.

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Martín Pérez gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this weekend series against the Red Sox...Pérez comes into today 11th among all National League pitchers with a 2.55 ERA...This will be Pérez' second home start of the season...In his only other start at PNC Park, he allowed one run in 8.0 innings and was in line for the win before coming away with a no-decision in the team's last at-bat loss vs. Detroit on April 9.

<u>ON DECK:</u> Tomorrow the Pirates will open a four-game series against the Brewers, which will be their first series against a National League Central team this season...The Pirates went 25-27 against their own division in 2023.

KE'S TO THE GAME: The next game for Ke'Bryan Hayes will be the 400th of his big league career...Hayes made his big league debut as a member of the Pirates on September 1, 2020, against the Cubs...Since the beginning of the 2021 season, Hayes has the most Defensive Runs Saved (60) by any player in MLB regardless of position according to the Fielding Bible...The next closest player is Ryan McMahon (52).

REYNOLDS AND THE RED SOX: Bryan Reynolds went 3-for-4 yesterday afternoon against

the Red Sox...Reynolds has now gone 15-for-29 (.517) with two doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.766 OPS in eight career games against Boston...Reynolds is also 4-for-4 with two home runs in his career against Red Sox starter Josh Winckowski (he took Winckowski deep twice here at PNC Park in the same game on

GIVE A LIKE TO ALIKA: Alika Williams extended his hitting streak to five games on Friday with his pinch-hit triple in the ninth inning...Williams has gone 5-for-12 (.417) with a double and triple during his current five-game hitting streak...The 25-year-old Williams is tied for second in the National League with two triples...Washington's CJ Abrams leads the way with three.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S HITS: Andrew McCutchen enters today's action with 999 career singles with the Pirates...Among his 1572 hits with the Bucs, 313 have been doubles, 44 have been triples and 216 have been home runs... Arky Vaughan is 10th on the club's all-time list with 1,218 singles.

THE OUTFIELD: Andrew McCutchen played the final inning of Saturday's game in right field, which was his first appearance in the outfield since last year on May 30 at San Francisco...McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in Pirates history in games played (1336) in the outfield...Bill Virdon is sixth (1376) while Roberto Clemente is first (2370).

ON THE MEND: Yasmani Grandal went 1-for-3 while serving as the designated hitter in his third game on rehab Friday night with Triple-A Indianapolis...He is now 1-for-8 with two RBI and 12.0 innings caught on rehab with Indianapolis.
