TODAY'S GAME: Winners of two straight for just the second time this season (also March 29-30), the Giants will look to make it three in a row in the second game of this four-game series with the D-Backs.

- ▶ SF's last three-game winning streak was part of a four-game streak last September (Sept. 8-11).

THE TORTURED POETS DEPARTMENT: Last night's victory moved the Giants to 29-14 (.674) versus Arizona here at Oracle Park since 2019...they've outscored the D-Backs 214-170 (+44) in that time.

- ▶ The Giants .674 winning percentage here at home vs. Arizona since 2019 is their second-best win % at home against any opponent in that time (min. 15g) behind their .718 winning percentage (28-11) against the Colorado Rockies since 2019.

SPEAK NOW: LHP Blake Snell makes his third start with SF tonight (second here at Oracle Park)...Snell has allowed 10 runs on nine hits in 7.0 innings (12.86 ERA) over his previous two outings while striking out nine.

- ▶ When Snell records his first out tonight he will reach the 1,000-inning mark for his Major League career...he enters tonight's game at 999.2 career innings pitched.
- ▶ Tonight's outing will mark Snell's ninth career start vs. Arizona...he's gone 5-1 with a 1.11 ERA (6er, 48.2ip) in his eight prior starts against them with a whopping 70 strikeouts in his 48.2ip (12.95 K/9ip)...Snell's teams are 6-2 overall vs. the D-Backs when he has faced them in his career.
- ▶ Snell's 1.11 ERA vs. Arizona is the lowest by any starter vs. a given team in the Majors since 2019 (min. eight starts vs. that team)...coincidentally enough, Snell's 1.61 ERA in nine starts versus the Giants in that same time is sixth-lowest.

LOVER: With his 7.0 innings last night, **RHP Logan Webb** now leads the Majors in innings pitched at 30.2 and is the first pitcher in the Majors this year to reach the 30.0 innings mark.

- ▶ The righty is coming off a 2023 season where he threw a Major League-leading (and career-high) 216.0 innings.
- ▶ Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 439.0 total innings, most in the Majors...a list of the top-10 are below.

REPUTATION: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 17 of 20 games this season, and is slashing .370/.474/.500 with eight runs, three doubles, a home run and six RBI.
- ▶ His .370 batting average and .474 OBP are both third-best in the Majors (min. 50 PA) in the early going.

FOLKLORE: The Giants did not homer in last night's 5-0 win over the D-Backs, making it seven straight home games to open the season without homering.

- ▶ The seven-game stretch at home to open the season is the Giants longest such streak since the New York Giants opened the 1920 season without homering in seven straight from April 14-May 6.
- ▶ The last time a Giants team went eight straight games at home without a homer to open the year was April 12-26, 1911.
- ▶ The last time any Major League team went homerless in their first seven home games of a season was 2013 when the Marlins did so from April 8-15.
- ▶ The last time SF went seven straight games without a homer at home *at any point* in a single season was September 2-24, 2018 (eight games) (*Elias*).
- ▶ SF is the only team in the Majors in 2024 to have not hit a homer at home thus far.

SPARKS FLY: SF has at least eight hits in each of its last six games, the longest such active streak in the Majors...the longest streak of games with 8+ hits this season thus far has been turned in by the New York Mets (nine games from April 6-15).

- ▶ SF's longest streak in 2023 was seven games (June 11-18).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants have recorded 8+ hits in 13 of their 20 games so far in 2024...only the Dodgers (15) and Astros (14) have more such games...SF is tied with Texas and the Yankees for the third-most games with 8+ hits in 2024.

EVERMORE: OF Jung Hoo Lee logged two more hits in yesterday's win, extending his hitting streak to 10 games...he is slashing .349/.378/.395 with two doubles, an RBI, two walks, two steals and eight runs in that stretch (since April 7).

- ▶ The last Giants rookie to hit safely in 10 straight games was **C Patrick Bailey**, who did so in 11 straight games last year from June 17-30.
- ▶ Lee's 10-game hit streak is tied for the seventh-longest active streak in the Majors.
- ▶ Lee's 33 hard-hit balls for this season are tied for sixth-most in MLB entering play today.
- ▶ Lastly, his 89.6% contact rate is seventh-best in the Majors (fourth-best in the National League)...in the NL, only MIA's Luis Arraez (92.7%), NYM's Jeff McNeil (90.6%) and PHI's Alec Bohm (89.8%) have been better.

CITY BY THE BLAKE: The reigning NL Cy Young winner will make his third start, second at Oracle Park, since joining SF late in the spring on a two-year, \$62 million contract (includes an opt out after 2024 season).

LAST TIME OUT: Snell had a rude welcoming back to Tropicana Field, tying his career-high with seven runs allowed on six hits, two home runs and two walks over 4.0 innings vs. the Rays...it marked the sixth time in his career he allowed seven runs, with the last coming on July 28, 2021 vs. Oakland (managed by **Bob Melvin**).

VS. ARIZONA Today's game will be Snell's ninth career start vs. Arizona...he is 5-1 against the Diamondbacks, with his team going 6-2 in his starts...Snell has a 1.11 ERA (6er, 48.2ip) vs Arizona with 70 strikeouts, a .139 opposing average, 0.76 WHIP and a .457 opposing OPS...Since 2019, Snell's 1.11 ERA and 0.760 WHIP against the Diamondbacks are both the lowest by any pitcher against one team (min. eight starts)...coincidentally, Snell's 1.61 ERA in nine starts vs. the Giants in that same time is sixth-lowest.

EARLY GAME MILESTONE: The starter needs one out tonight to reach 1,000 innings in his Major League career.

NEW HOME SWEET HOME: According to *Stats, LLC*, Snell has a career .165 opposing batting average at Oracle Park (five starts), which is the third-best opposing batting average in park history (min. 100 batters faced) behind RHP Lance Lynn (.136 opposing average) and former Giant **RHP Reyes Moronta** (.163 opposing average).

NO TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Of Snell's 234 strikeouts last season, 109 came on his curveball...opponents hit .079 on the pitch with a .140 slugging percentage...his curveball had a run value of 22 last season after posting a run value of three in 2022...the 22 run value was the second-best rated curveball behind Atlanta RHP Charlie Morton's 25, and rated as the sixth-best pitch overall...the Diamondbacks have done a solid job at hitting curveballs this season, posting a .288 average (seventh), .757 OPS (ninth) and .442 slugging percentage (eighth).

NEXT BEST THING: In addition to the high strikeout numbers, Snell was good at keeping the ball on the ground last year, finishing 16th in MLB and ninth in the National League with a 44.4% ground ball rate...through two starts this season, Snell has a 52.4% ground ball rate...as a team, Arizona has a 49.6% ground ball rate, which is second-highest in MLB behind Miami (52.4%).

CYZILLA: Snell won his second career Cy Young and first in the National League last season (also in 2018 with Tampa Bay)...he went 14-9 with an MLB-leading 2.25 ERA to become the seventh pitcher in MLB history to win the Cy Young in both leagues:

WALK IT BACK: The lefty became the first pitcher since ERA was established in both leagues in 1913 to finish as baseball's leader in walks (99) and ERA (2.25), doing so last season...the Diamondbacks walk a lot, with their 10.2% walk rate ranking fourth-highest in MLB while their 29.3% O-Swing rate (percent of swings at pitches outside the strike zone) is seventh-lowest in MLB.

RARE 1-2 PUNCH: Per *Sarah Langs* and *Elias*, the duo of **LHP Blake Snell** and **RHP Logan Webb** make the Giants just the seventh team in MLB history to have both of the top-2 Cy Young Award vote getters from the prior season.

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/16 at MIA; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in just four of SF's 16 games since having his contract selected on April 1.
- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/17 at MIA; SV, 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made four appearances and gone 1-0-3 with three hits allowed, one walk, eight strikeouts and no runs allowed (4.1ip).
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/17 at MIA; 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last six outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed one run on just one hit in 6.1 innings (1.42 ERA) with 10 strikeouts and one walk.
