JACKIE ROBINSON DAY HIGHLIGHTS: Jackie Robinson Day will be celebrated league-wide and the Diamondbacks special pregame ceremony will salute those in the community who are making a positive impact and carrying on the legacy of Jackie Robinson...Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church Choir will perform the National Anthem as well as the Black National Anthem...the ceremonial first pitch will be thrown by Valley-native Raven Gibson, the founder of Legendary Rootz, a Phoenix business that sells apparel and gift items celebrating the Black community and was one of Target's featured businesses for Black History Month...the team will recognize the Boys & Girls Club Youth of the Year as well as the East Valley United Black Firefighters, who focus on involvement and development in African-American communities, fostering promotion and advancement and promoting overall well-being...fans with the special event ticket package will receive an exclusive hat featuring Robinson's number "42."

SNAKEBITES

THE NL CHAMPS: Last season, the D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23).

A BOND BEYOND BASEBALL: MLB Network's Anthony Castrovince and Paul Solga teamed up on "A Bond Beyond Baseball," a compelling, heartfelt story about the friendship and working relationship of Arizona Diamondbacks' General Manager **Mike Hazen** & Manager **Torey Lovullo.**

VS. CUBS: Since 2022, the D-backs are 10-4 vs. Cubs (4-2 @ home, 6-2 on road) and have outscored them 63-49.

- ◆ Last season, the D-backs faced off vs. Cubs in September with 7 games in 11 days (4 on road and 3 @ home) and took 6 of the 7 matchups, including a sweep at Chase Field.
- ♦ In 17 plate appearances last season vs. Cubs while with the Giants, **Joc Pederson** hit .733 (11-for-15) with 2 doubles, 2 homers and 6 RBI.

SERIES-LY: The D-backs have won 2 consecutive series (@ COL, vs. STL) and 3 of their 5 on the season.

SHUT 'EM OUT: Yesterday's victory marked their first shutout at home vs. Cardinals since April 28, 2016 (W; 3-0)... it was Arizona's second shutout this season (also: W, 7-0 vs. Yankees on April 2).

OH MY, LOURDES: Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 18 RBI are tied for second in the Majors (also: Spencer Steer/CIN), behind Marcell Ozuna/ATL (21)...Gurriel's 18 RBI thru the team's first 16 games of a season also ties for the most by a D-back in the span (also: Mark Trumbo/2014 and Luis Gonzalez/2001).

This season, Gurriel Jr. is batting .500 (11-for-22)/1.405 OPS with runners in scoring position, with 2 doubles, 2 homers and 15 RBI.

LIMITING THE STRIKEOUT: Corbin Carroll's 7.2 strikeout pct. (69 PA) ranks second among qualified hitters this season, behind only Luis Campusano/SD (6.9% in 58 PA). Biggest Drop in Strikeout Rate so far in 2024 (MIN: 400 PA in 2023 and 40 PA in 2024) [source: MLB]:

HITTING & RUNNING: Since 2023, Arizona's 125 player games with 1+ hits and 1+ stolen bases are the second most in the Majors, behind the Reds (143) and ahead of the Guardians (124) and Rays (119).

SCORING FIRST: The D-backs have scored first in all 8 games they have won this season...they have scored first in a game 12 times, tied for the second most in the Majors (also: Dodgers and Royals), only behind the Red Sox (13) and ahead of the Cubs (11) and Padres (11).

FIRST-INNING STRIKERS: The D-backs' 10 games this season with 1+ runs scored in the first inning is the most in the Maiors.

- The D-backs have scored 2+ runs in the first inning in 8 of their first 16 games this season...no other team
- has more than 5 instances so far this season (Angels). In the opening frame, the D-backs have scored 1 run twice, 2 runs 4 times, 3 runs 3 times and 6 times once, tallying 25 runs with a .439 average (36-for-82)/1.288 OPS and 9 doubles, 7 home runs and 8 walks.

5+-RUN INNINGS: The D-backs 5-run fifth inning yesterday was their fourth inning of 5+ runs, tied for the most in the Majors (also: Rangers, Royals, Padres, and Reds):

STOPPING THE OPPONENT RUNNING GAME: Through 16 games this season, **Gabriel Moreno** has held opponents to an MLB-low 2 stolen bases in 4 attempts...Moreno's 39.7 caught-stealing pct. (31-for-78) since 2022 is highest among all active MLB catchers.

- There has been only 4 stolen base attempts against Arizona over 211 stolen base opportunities.
- The 4 stolen base attempts vs. Arizona are the fewest among all MLB teams...the second fewest is 7 stolen base attempts (against Tigers, Rangers and Royals).

BARRELING IT UP: Ketel Marte's 31 hard hits (No. of batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) rank third in the Majors, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (34) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (33) while Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 29 are tied for fifth.
Christian Walker's 17.5 barrel pct. (percentage of batted balls that are classified as barrels) ranks tenth... Bobby Witt Jr./KC (24.0) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (23.3) are top 2 in MLB.

OFFENSE ON STARTERS: D-backs hitters, against opposing starting pitchers, are batting .323 (105-for-325)/.883 OPS with 58 runs, 19 doubles, 14 homers and 27 walks. Among all teams' offenses vs. starting pitchers, the

D-backs are first with 105 hits and 166 total bases and boast the lowest strikeout rate (15.4%).

NEXT STARTER: LHP TOMMY HENRY (0-1, 5.79) Took a no-decision in his last start on April 10 @ Rock-

- ies (ND; 2 ER in 5.0 IP, 6 K).
- ♦ Has tossed 5.0+ innings with 2 or fewer earned runs allowed and 5+ strikeouts in 2 consecutive starts.
- Will make his first career start vs. Cubs...grew up 150 miles from Wrigley Field in Portage, Michigan.
