ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 29-18 on the road, going 11-3-1 in series play.....had a season-high 6-game road winning streak from 5/22-6/8 and a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....are currently on a 4-game road winning streak

ALL-STARS: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by Corbin Burnes, Josh Hader, Freddy Peralta, Brandon Woodruff and Omar Narváez.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019).....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (490-453) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617)... under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinyen (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA [18g, 17gs, 7-3, 2.39]

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: First-time All-Star Freddy Peralta, 25, will make his 19th appearance and 18th start.....Peralta last started on 7/10 vs. Cincinnati and received no decision in a 4-3 loss (5ip, 2h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 2hbp, 92 pitches).....the team is 11-6 in his starts.....he has 10 quality starts....opponents are batting .131 (44-for-335, 10hr).....he has 135 strikeouts in just 98.0 innings.....he has a 1.91 ERA in his last 11 starts (66ip, 14er).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

ALL-STAR FREDDY: Peralta made his All-Star Game debut this season, striking out the side - Adolis García, J.D. Martinez and Matt Olson in the seventh inning.

CAREER: Is 23-11 with a 3.90 ERA in 88 games / 40 starts [290.2ip, 126er].....has pitched four seasons, all with the Brewers (2018-21).....is 15-10 with a 4.06 ERA as a starter [208.1ip, 94er] and 8-1 with a 3.50 ERA in relief [82.1ip, 32er].....notched his only career save on 7/24/19 vs. Cincinnati.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 14-4 with a 2.80 ERA in 45 games / 18 starts (151ip, 47er).....is 4-1 with a 2.04 ERA in 10 games / 9 starts this season (57.1ip, 13er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 9-7 with a 5.09 ERA in 43 games / 22 starts (139.2ip, 79er).....is 3-2 with a 2.88 ERA in 8 starts this season (40.2ip, 13er).

CAREER vs. WHITE SOX: His only career outing came in relief on 8/8/20 at Guaranteed Rate Field.....he threw 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing 1 hit (1bb, 6k, 1hbp).
