- Jake McCarthy, in the second inning, was the second player to hit a triple off Paul Skenes this season (also: Victor Scott II/STL on April 8).
- Tristin English, in the third inning, collected his first Major League hit (double) off Skenes.
- Zac Gallen took the loss after allowing 4 runs on 5 hits over 6.0 innings with 1 walk and 5 strikeouts... the Pirates had 1 hit thru the first 2.0 innings, scored 2 runs on 3 hits in the third, went hitless in the fourth and fifth, and plated 1 run in the sixth on 1 hit after a hit-by-pitch.
- Brandyn Garcia made his D-back debut, tossing 1.0 hitless inning with 1 walk.

GENO BACK WHERE IT ALL BEGAN: Eugenio Suárez was signed by Tigers as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 9, 2008 [signed by Alejandro Rodriguez] and made his Major League debut with the Tigers on June 4, 2014 vs. Blue Jays.

• On June 7, 2014 vs. Red Sox, he became the 23rd player in franchise history to record a home run for his first Major League hit (solo off John Lester)...on deck, the first person waiting to congratulate him was Miguel Cabrera, his countryman and a player he grew up revering: "It's a moment I will never forget. And to have Miggy there to be the first person to shake my hand was very special. For all of us, he is not only a great player but a mentor in this game."

TOREY, THE FORMER TIGER: D-backs manager, Torey Lovullo, made his Major League debut with the Tigers on Sept. 10, 1988 @ Yankees, entering the game as a defensive sub (3B) for Tom Brookens in the eighth inning... in his first career at-bat in the ninth inning, hit a 2-out line drive single to right fielder Dave Winfield.

• Lovullo cites Hall of Fame former Tigers manager Sparky Anderson as the biggest influence on his managerial career, telling the Detroit Free Press: "...one of the things Sparky taught me from Day 1: Your family, your parents are the people that are going to be around to support you, they need to love you the most. My thoughts and strategies of how I get to know the players on that level first...Having conversations beyond the game and asking about parents, children, understanding how important

TIGER TALES: LHP Eduardo Rodriguez pitched 2 seasons (2022-23) with the Tigers, going 18-14 with a 3.58 ERA over 43 starts (24 quality).

- Corbin Carroll, on June 9, 2023 @ Tigers, had his first career 2-homer game, including his first career grand slam, along with a career-best 10 total bases.
- D-backs assistant hitting coach Damion Easley played for the Tigers from 1996-2002...he tied Detroit's 9.0-inning record with 6 hits on Aug. 8, 2001 @ Texas (also: Carlos Pena on May 27, 2004 @ Kansas City, George Kell on Sept. 20, 1946 @ Cleveland, Ty Cobb on May 5, 1925 @ Baltimore and Kid Nance on July 13, 1901 vs. Cleveland).
- D-backs first base coach Dave McKay made his Major League debut with the Twins on Aug. 22, 1975 vs. Tigers and homered in his first career at-bat (off Vern Ruhle).

JULY FREE PASSES: Since July 1, the D-backs' 76 walks are most in the NL and fourth in the Majors, behind the Angels (88), Guardians (80) and Blue Jays (80), while their 9.1 pct. walk rate ranks second in the NL (fifth in MLB).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 6-0 @ Pirates yesterday, fall- | VS. TIGERS: Since 2023, the D-backs are 4-2 in their last 6 games.

> • Arizona swept Detroit 3-0 in their last road series from June 9-11, 2023...in the series finale, the D-backs plated 5 unanswered runs in the final 2 innings after trailing 5-2 through the seventh.

> CARROLL IS 1 TRIPLE SHY: Corbin Carroll is 1 triple shy of a career high...in the last 10 seasons, since 2016, is 1 of 3 players (also: Jarren Duran/BOS-14 in 2024 and Charlie Blackmon/COL-14 in 2017) with 13+ triples in a season but currently the only one to do so in consecutive seasons (also: 14 in 2024)...since 2010, the most triples in a season was 16 (Jose Reyes/NYM and Shane Victorino/PHI)...since 2008, the most triples in a season was 19 (Reyes/NYM).

> PERDOMO COMING OUT STRONG: Since the All-Star break, Geraldo Perdomo has reached safely in 8 of his 9 games (including 4 multi-hit games), hitting .382 (13for-34)/.432 OBP/.500 SLG/.932 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 7 RBI, 3 walks and 2 stolen bases.

- Yesterday, in the first inning @ Pirates, he snapped his consecutive streak of plate appearances without a strikeout at 39 PA (since July 12)...was his second streak of 30+ consecutive PA without a strikeout this season (also: 40 PA from April 4-13)...those streaks are the longest by a D-back since 2023 (Christian Walker, 38 PA from June 17-25, 2023).
- Yesterday, he also ended his 13-game on-base streak, since July 9, where he batted .354 (17-for-48)/.456 OBP/.542 SLG/.998 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 8 walks (3 K).

ALL-IN PITCHING: Since July 13, D-backs pitchers' (starters + relievers) 2.80 ERA (28 ER in 90.0 IP) is the second fifth in the Majors, behind the Rangers (1.68), Brewers (2.53), Marlins (2.69) and the Padres (2.78).

- · Since July 13, D-backs' pitching ranks among the Majors in runs per game (2nd, 2.90), lowest OPS (4th, .623), lowest SLG (4th, .329), fewest extra-base hits (T-4th, 23 with the Nationals), and lowest opponent AVG (9th, .222).
- It is the D-backs' lowest ERA in an 10-game span in a season since their 2.73 ERA from July 8-21, 2024.

STARTING RHYTHM: D-backs' starting pitchers, in their last 10 games, are 5-5 with a 2.54 ERA (17 ER in 60.1 IP), opponent .191 AVG (42-for-220)/.569 OPS, 1.01 WHIP and 47 strikeouts.

Arizona starters, since July 13, rank among the NL in ERA (1st, 2.54), opponent AVG (1st, .191), opponent OPS (1st, .569), innings (1st, 60.1), innings per game (1st, 6.0), quality starts (T-1st, 6), fewest hits (T-1st, 42) and fewest runs allowed (T-2nd, 18).

RELIEVERS RECENTLY: D-backs relievers, in their last 19 games since July 4, are fifth in the NL with a 2.81 ERA (18 ER in 57.2 IP)...are scoreless in 11 of the games and limited to 1 run in 2 of the games.

• The D-backs bullpen's 3.10 ERA in July is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87)...their last month finishing with a sub-3.00 ERA was Sept. 2023 (2.16).

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (10-6, 4.76)

- · Will be making his first career start vs. Tigers.
- Is 1 win shy of tying his career high (11).
- In his last start on July 23 vs. Astros, did not factor in the decision after allowing 2 runs over 5.1 innings on 5 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts.

- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- · Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.
- From 2018-23, his 63 wins tied for third most in the AL (also: Justin Verlander), behind Gerrit Cole (86) and Jose Berríos (66).
- · Carried a no-hitter into the eighth inning on Sept. 4, 2016 @ Athletics that was broken up by a Marcus Semien 2-out single.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: 18th start (10th road).

- Made 2 Opening Day starts during his stint with the Tigers (2022-23).
- First Tigers' lefty with 6 consecutive starts with 5.0+ innings and 1 run or fewer allowed from April 12-May 10, 2023 (also longest streak of his career)...all-time, tied Michael Fulmer (May 21-June 17, 2016) and Al Benton (April 19-May 20,1945) for the second-longest streak in Tigers history, behind Justin Verlander's 7 starts (June 9-July 10, 2011)...over the streak, he went 4-0 with a 0.43 ERA (2 ER in 41.2 IP) and 41 strikeouts.
- In 2022, he became first Detroit starting pitcher to make his Tigers debut on Opening Day since Kenny Rogers in 2006.
- In 2 interleague road starts this season, is 1-1 with a 0.84 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 10.2 IP) and 14 strikeouts.
- Owns a 5-game road winning streak @ AL Central opponents, going 5-0 with a 1.97 ERA (7 ER in 32.0 IP), opponent .202 AVG, 0.94 WHIP, 7 walks and 31 strikeouts.
