NOTABLE OFFSEASON TRANSACTIONS: 10/30, declined the mutual option on OF Ryan Braun.....11/4, named Ed Sedar advisor to the Major League coaching staff; named Quintin Berry first base coach......11/19, promoted Matt Arnold to senior vice president and general manager......12/2, acquired a player to be named (LHP Leo Crawford) from Los Angeles-NL for RHP Corey Knebel......1/21, signed INF/OF Daniel Robertson to a 1-year contract......2/5, signed 2B Kolten Wong to a 2-year contract with a club option for 2023......2/22, re-signed LHP Brett Anderson to a 1-year contract......2/23, signed 3B Travis Shaw to a Minor League contract with an invitation to Major League camp.....3/8, signed OF Jackie Bradley Jr. to a 2-year contract with a player opt-out clause after 2021 and mutual option for 2023.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (435-415) and sixth full season.....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (1g, Ogs, O-O, O.OO)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 24, will be making his second appearance of the season and first start.....Peralta made his season debut on Opening Day against Minnesota and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief [2h, 3bb, 6k].....he went 0-1 with a 3.95 ERA in 4 games / 2 starts in Spring Training [13.2ip, 14h, 6r, 6er, 3bb, 23k, 2hr]..... Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 3-1 with a 3.99 ERA in 15 games / 1 start last season.....he held opponents to a .204 batting average [22-for-108, 2hr] with 47 strikeouts in just 29.1 innings.....he began the season in the starting rotation, making his only start in a 9-1 loss on 7/26 at Chicago-NL (3ip, 3h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 3k, 1hbp, 1wp).....he went 3-0 with a 3.08 ERA in his 14 relief appearances [26.1ip 9er].....his 15.04 K/9 IP as a reliever ranked fifth in the Major Leagues.

CAREER: Is 16-8 with a 4.62 ERA in 71 games / 23 starts (194.2ip, 100er).....has pitched four seasons, all with the Brewers (2018-21).....is 8-7 with a 5.45 ERA as a starter (112.1ip, 68er) and 8-1 with a 3.50 ERA in relief (82.1ip, 32er).....he notched his only career save on 7/24/19 vs. Cincinnati.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 10-3 with a 3.20 ERA in 36 games / 9 starts (95.2ip, 34er).....went 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA in 8 relief outings last season (14ip, 4er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 6-5 with a 6.00 ERA in 35 games / 14 starts (99ip, 66er).....went 1-1 with a 5.28 ERA in 7 games / 1 start last season (15.1ip, 9er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 2-1 with a 5.40 ERA in 6 career games / 1 start against the Cubs (11.2ip, 7er).....his lone start vs. Chicago came last season on 7/26 at Wrigley Field in a 9-1 loss (3ip, 3h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 3k, 1hbp, 1wp).

RHP Brandon Woodruff will make his second start of the season tomorrow.....Woodruff started on Opening Day vs. Minnesota and received no decision in the Brewers' 6-5, 10-inning win (4ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 5k, 1wp, 78 pitches).....he became the first Brewers pitcher to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons since Yovani Gallardo started a franchise-record five in a row from 2010-14.....Woodruff has gone 0-1 with a 4.65 ERA in 8 career games / 6 starts against the Cubs (31ip, 16er), including 0-1 with a 2.76 ERA in 3 starts last season (16.1ip, 5er)....he is 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA in 4 career games / 2 starts at Wrigley Field (11.1ip, 6er).
