NOTABLE OFFSEASON TRANSACTIONS: **10/30**, declined the mutual option on **OF Ryan Braun**....**11/4**, named **Ed Sedar** advisor to the Major League coaching staff; named **Quintin Berry** first base coach....**11/19**, promoted **Matt Arnold** to senior vice president and general manager....**12/2**, acquired a player to be named (**LHP Leo Crawford**) from Los Angeles-NL for **RHP Corey Knebel**....**1/21**, signed **INF/OF Daniel Robertson** to a 1-year contract....**2/5**, signed **2B Kolten Wong** to a 2-year contract with a club option for 2023....**2/22**, re-signed **LHP Brett Anderson** to a 1-year contract....**2/23**, signed **3B Travis Shaw** to a Minor League contract with an invitation to Major League camp....**3/8**, signed **OF Jackie Bradley Jr.** to a 2-year contract with a player opt-out clause after 2021 and mutual option for 2023.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (435-415) and sixth full season....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502)....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach **Jacob Cruz** (2nd season), hitting coach **Andy Haines** (3rd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (3rd season), bullpen coach **Steve Karsay** (3rd season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach **Walker McKinven** (2nd season) and bench coach **Pat Murphy** (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff....new to the staff is first base coach **Quintin Berry**.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (1gs, 0-0, 6.75)

RHP Brandon Woodruff will make his second start of the season tomorrow.....Woodruff started on Opening Day vs. Minnesota and received no decision in the Brewers' 6-5, 10-inning win (4ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 5k, 1wp, 78 pitches).....he became the first Brewers pitcher to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons since Yovani Gallardo started a franchise-record five in a row from 2010-14.....Woodruff has gone 0-1 with a 4.65 ERA in 8 career games / 6 starts against the Cubs (31ip, 16er), including 0-1 with a 2.76 ERA in 3 starts last season (16.1ip, 5er).....he is 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA in 4 career games / 2 starts at Wrigley Field (11.1ip, 6er).

#41 OF JACKIE BRADLEY JR. (4g, .083, 1hr, 1rbi, Osb) **last HR:** 4/4 vs. Min (off Cody Stashak)

- Has appeared in all 4 games, including 3 starts (2g in CF, 1g in RF)
- Needs 1 HR for 100 career.....belted a solo homer on Sunday vs. Minnesota for his first hit as a Brewer
- Prior to this season had not appeared in a game in right field since 8/5/19 vs. Kansas City or started a game in right field since 5/23/19 at Toronto.....has not appeared in a game in left field since 10/1/15 at New York-AL (start)
- Signed as a free agent on 3/8.....is signed through 2022 (can opt out after 2021) with a mutual option for 2023
- Previously spent his entire career (2013-20) with Boston.....batted .283 with 7 HR and 22 RBI in 55 games in 2020
- Is a 2018 Gold Glove Award winner.....was a World Series champion in 2013 and 2018.....was an All-Star in 2016

#6 OF LORENZO CAIN (2g, .143, Ohr, Orbi, Osb) **last HR:** 9/27/19 at Col (off Antonio Senzatela)

- Has appeared in 2 games, both starts in center field
- Scored the winning run in the 10th inning on Opening Day vs. Minnesota on Orlando Arcia's ground ball
- Appeared in 5 games last season, all starts in center field, before opting out of the season on 8/1
- Was an All-Star in 2015 and 2018.....is a 2019 Gold Glove Award winner.....was a World Series champion in 2015

#24 OF AVISAÍL GARCÍA (3g, .231, Ohr, Orbi, Osb) **last HR:** 8/19/20 at Min (off Lewis Thorpe)

- Name pronounced "ah-vee-sigh-EEL".....has appeared in 3 games, all starts in right field and batting fourth
- Needs 2 HR for 100 career
- Batted .238 with 2 HR and 15 RBI in 53 games last season.....made 50 starts (42g in CF, 5g in RF, 3g at DH)

#18 INF KESTON HIURA (4g, .000, Ohr, Orbi, Osb) **last HR:** 9/16/20 vs. StL (off Adam Wainwright)

- Name is pronounced "HEER-uh".....has appeared in all 4 games, all starts at first base.....is 0-for-15 on the season
- Prior to this season had never appeared in a game at first base
- All of his defensive appearances in the Major Leagues prior to this season came at second base (130 games)
- Batted .212 with 13 HR and 32 RBI in 59 games last season.....made 59 starts (49g at 2B, 10g at DH)
- Led the Brewers in HR and RBI last season despite not recording a HR or RBI over his last 11 games

#11 OF BILLY MCKINNEY (4g, .667, Ohr, Orbi, Osb) **last HR:** 9/25/19 vs. Bal (off Gabriel Ynoa) - leadoff

- Has appeared in all 4 games, all as a pinch hitter (2-for-3).....was announced last night, but did not bat
- Appeared in 2 games with Toronto last season before he was claimed off waivers by Milwaukee on 9/14
