## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (11-6) vs. NEW YORK METS (8-8) APRIL 16, 2024 at Citi Field, Queens, NY - 7:10 EDT - GAME #18/ROAD #13 RHP JARED JONES (1-2, 4.00 ERA) vs. LHP JOSE QUINTANA (1-1, 3.45 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...lost 6-3 last night in the opener of their three-game series at Citi Field...Are 2-3 on their current seven-game road trip to Philadelphia (2-2) and New York (0-1) to face the Mets...Have yet to lose back-to-back games on the road this season...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Swept a season-opening four-game series on the road for the first time since doing so in 1903 in Cincinnati.

**KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES':** Righthander Jared Jones had eight strikeouts Thursday night and has now recorded seven-plus punchouts in each of the first three games of his career...Only one Pirate to debut since 1893 when the current mound distance was established began his career with three straight appearances with seven-plus strikeouts, which was Jose DeLeon (he did so in five straight from July 23, 1983 to August 10, 1983).

**WHAT A DEBUT:** Jared Jones became the first Pirate since Tim Wakefield in 1992 and the third pitcher in team history to record at least 10 strikeouts in his big league debut on March 30 at Miami...In addition, the 22-year-old Jones became one of just five starting pitchers since 1900 to strike out at least 10 batters in less than 6.0 innings in a big league debut...Dick Hall struck out 11 batters in his first MLB start, but he made his MLB debut as a third baseman for the Pirates on April 15, 1952.

**FROM THE TOP:** Connor Joe is hitting .333 (10-for-30) in seven games out of the leadoff spot this season...Joe's .333 average out of the leadoff spot ranks fifth in MLB behind Jose Altuve (.403), Anthony Volpe (.368), Steven Kwan (.356) and Mookie Betts (.347)... Joe also ranks sixth among leadoff hitters in MLB in OPS (.878), fifth in OBP (.412) and eighth in slugging (.467).

**SEEING SOUTHPAWS:** Tonight will be the eighth time this season the Pirates will be opposed by a starting lefthander...The Pirates are 6-1 in games started by opposing lefties, losing for the only time on Thursday in Philadelphia against Ranger Suarez...Bryan Reynolds has gone 9-for-25 (.360) with a pair of home runs against lefthanders this season.

**FROM 1 TO 2055:** Andrew McCutchen comes into today fourth among all active players with 2055 career hits behind Joey Votto (2135), Freddie Freeman (2135) and Jose Altuve (2076)...McCutchen's first career hit came on June 4, 2009, in his big league debut when he singled off Mike Pelfrey of the Mets leading off the game at PNC Park.

**COMING THROUGH IN THE CLUTCH:** Connor Joe went 1-for-2 with runners in scoring position last night and is hitting .529 (9-for-17) with four doubles and eight RBI in those situations this season...Joe's .529 average with runners in scoring position is tied for the fourth-highest among all players in the National League along with William Contreras...The only three National League players with a higher average with RISP are Mookie Betts (.545), Christian Yelich (.545) and Jake Burger (.528).

**START ME UP:** Pittsburgh's starting pitching staff has allowed 20 earned runs in 68.2 innings in the last 11 games (2.62 ERA)...Pittsburgh's 3.56 starting rotation ERA (98.2ip/39er) is the sixth-lowest among all teams in MLB...The only five starting rotations to record a lower ERA are the Red Sox (1.92), Royals (2.29), Phillies (2.95), Yankees (3.32) and Rangers (3.45).

**ROTATION RANKINGS:** Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks sixth in all of MLB in walks per 9.0 innings (2.28)...The only five starting rotations averaging fewer walks per 9.0 innings are the Mariners (1.60), Orioles (1.94), Royals (2.12), Rays (2.26) and Twins (2.28).

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Triple-A Indianapolis' Nick Gonzales is hitting .362 (21-for-58) with eight doubles, a home run, eight RBI and .965 OPS during his 14-game on-base streak (the longest active on-base streak in the International League and tied for the second-longest in all of MiLB)...Gonzales ranks ninth in the International League in batting (.362), tied for third in hits (21), first in doubles (eight), tied for seventh in extra base hits (nine), 10th in total bases (32) and third in runs (15)...The 24-year-old Gonzales is currently rated as Pittsburgh's ninth-best prospect according to Baseball America.

**BAILEY FALTER:** The 26-year-old lefthander (turns 27 on 4/24) will make his fourth start of the season tomorrow afternoon...Earned his first win of the season (5.0ip/1r) in his last start against the Phillies Friday night at Citizens Bank Park...Gave up just one hit in 6.0 scoreless innings but had a no-decision in the team's 5-4, 11-inning walkoff win on 4/6 vs. Baltimore...Has limited right-handed hitters to a .105 batting average against (4-for-38)...Opposing hitters are batting .103 (3-for-29) against his four-seam fastball (has thrown the pitch 116 times).

**vs. NEW YORK (NL):** 1-1 with a 2.76 ERA (16.2ip/5er) in four appearances (three starts)...Allowed one run in 5.1 innings but had a no-decision in his last start in a 7-4 win at Citi Field on 8/15/23...His other appearances came as a member of the Phillies in 2022...He allowed one run in 6.0 innings and won a 4-1 decision in his outing against the Mets on 8/20...His relief appearance came on 4/13, while his other start (3.0ip/5r/2er) came on 5/27.
