ATLANTA BRAVES (29-20) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (25-28)

THE PIRATES:...beat the Braves 4-1 Saturday afternoon to earn a series win...Scored a season-high 11 runs Friday night to snap their brief two-game losing streak...Have gone 5-2 in their last seven games...Have played in 13 games decided by one or two runs in their last 21 contests...Have played in 19 one-run games, which are the second-most in

MLB behind the Cubs (20)...Are tied with the Phillies and Cubs for the most wins (10) in one-run games in all of MLB...Have gone 5-2 in extra innings; the third-most wins in MLB behind the Guardians and Marlins with six apiece...Have hit 19 home runs against left-handed pitchers, which are tied for the third-most in MLB along with the Athletics and Phillies (the Orioles rank first with 24 followed by the Guardians with 20)...Have gone 11-9 in games started by opposing lefthanders, which are the fourth-most wins in MLB behind the Phillies (13), Dodgers (13) and Orioles (12)...Have gone 15-0 this season when recording 10-plus hits; the only undefeated team in the Majors in such games and a club record for the longest such streak to start a season, surpassing the 1939 club that started 14-0 when recording 10-plus hits to start the season...Have gone 10-6 against the National League East while outscoring the division by 20 runs (87-67).

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen comes into today one hit shy of 1600 as a member of the Pirates, which ranks 12th all-time in team history...Since May 11, McCutchen ranks sixth among all National League players in batting (.346) and slugging (.596), tied for third in runs scored (12), tied for fourth in hits (18), fourth in OPS (1.039) and eighth in OBP (.443).

CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET: This afternoon the Pirates will look to sweep the Braves here at PNC Park for the first time since

doing so in three games from April 7-9, 2017...A win today would also give the Bucs their second sweep of the 2024 campaign...The first one came during their season-opening fourgame series at Miami from March 28-31.

NICKY G: Nick Gonzales has hit safely in each of his last six games (9-for-22, .409 average), has an extra base hit in each of his last three contests, and has hit safely in 12 of his 14 games with a plate appearance since being promoted from Triple-A on May 10...He is also hitting .320 (8-for-25) with runners on base since his season debut on May 10, which ranks fifth among all National League players with at least 30 plate appearances behind Bryce Harper (.417), Luis Matos (.353), William Contreras (.346) and Shohei Ohtani (.321).

GUIDING THE SHIP: Today will be Derek Shelton's 600th game as manager of the Pirates... Shelton was named the team's 41st manager on November 27, 2019...He earned the first win of his managerial career on July 26, 2020, at St. Louis...Last year Shelton guided the Pirates to a 14-win improvement from 2022, making Pittsburgh one of only six Major League teams to do so, and the largest increase by the club since 2013 when they began a stretch of three consecutive playoff berths.

KNOW WHEN TO HOLDERMAN: Colin Holderman stranded his inherited runner while going on to toss 1.1scorelss innings in his last appearance on Saturday...Holderman's 0.55 ERA (16.1ip/1er) is the fifth-lowest among all relievers in MLB (minimum 16.0ip) behind Emmanuel Clase (0.34), Dylan Floro (0.35), Robert Suarez (0.40) and Yimi Garcia (0.47)... Holderman also ranks fourth among all National League relievers in batting average against (.138) behind Alex Vesia (.123), Kyle Finnegan (.134) and Robert Suarez (.135).

INTERLEAGUE ON DECK: The Pirates will depart tomorrow for a five-game road trip that gets underway Tuesday night...The Bucs will face the Tigers Tuesday and Wednesday before concluding the trip with three games against the Blue Jays next weekend...The Pirates split a two-game series against the Tigers here at PNC Park from April 8-9...It will be Pittsburgh's fourth trip to Toronto in interleague play (also 2003, 2011 and 2017).

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Martín Pérez gets the start today in the finale of this three-game series...Pérez had a no-decision (4.2ip/4r/2er) in the team's 7-6, 10-inning walkoff win Tuesday night against the Giants...Today will be Pérez' 299th appearance in the big leagues... Coming into today he is also tied for second in the National League in double plays induced (nine) along with Jordan Hicks (Logan Webb leads with ten).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 26, 2003: The Bucs scored nine times in the eighth inning on their way to a 10-0 win at Wrigley Field. Kenny Lofton extended his hitting streak to 24 games, while Jeff Reboulet and Brian Giles collected two hits apiece in the win. Josh Fogg, activated from the disabled list earlier in the day, held the Cubs to three hits over 7.0 innings while not allowing a runner past first base. The nine-run frame was Pittsburgh's biggest offensive output in one inning since June 12, 2001, vs. the Tigers at Comerica Park.

TUESDAY'S STARTER

JARED JONES: The 22-year-old righthander will make his 11th start Tuesday when the Pirates open a two-game series at Detroit...Was in line for the win (6.0ip/3er) in his last start but had a no-decision in a 9-5, 10-inning loss Wednesday night against the Giants...Has five games of seven-plus strikeouts and no walks allowed in his first 10 career starts...That's two more than the previous Major League record by a pitcher to start their career (Stephen Strasburg and Masahiro Tanaka held the previous high of three such games)...Has thrown 5.0-plus innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his 10 career starts...Ranks first among all National League rookies in strikeouts (68) and third in ERA (3.05), batting average against (.215) and WHIP (0.97)...Ranks 11th in all of MLB in both strikeouts per 9.0 innings (10.37) walks per 9.0 innings (1.53).

vs. DETROIT: Has never faced the Tigers.
