TODAY'S GAME: The Giants wrap their first homestand of the year this afternoon with the final game of this three-game series with Washington...having already lost the series, SF is searching for a win to secure a .500 homestand after taking two-of-three from San Diego over the weekend.

- San Francisco has lost six straight games to the Nationals entering play today (dating to May 10 of last year)...the six-game losing streak is tied for the club's longest vs. the Washington franchise (since 2005) with a six-game losing streak from September 22, 2005-August 1, 2006.
- Over their last 11 matchups also dating to April 29, 2022, the Giants have gone 2-9 with a - 41 run differential vs. the Nationals...SF pitchers posted a 6.56 ERA in that stretch with the offense averaging just 3.5 runs per game.

ODDS \& ENDS: Last night the Giants rattled off 10 hits, their second-highest total of the year behind a 13-hit performance back in the second game of the season on March 29 in San Diego.

- However, all 10 of the Giants hits last night were singles...SF had one such game last season (10 or more hits and no extrabase hits)...that came on May 17 vs. Philadelphia, a game SF won 7-4 when they pounded out 11 hits (all singles)
- Since 2010, last night was the 12th instance where SF recorded at least 10 hits with none going for extra-bases.

WHO TRIPPED THE BREAKER?: After homering in each of their first seven games to start the season, Giants hitters have failed to record a home run in five straight games since returning home.

- The last time the Giants went five consecutive games without a homer was in 2018, when SF didn't homer for six straight games from September 10-16.
- The last time SF went homerless in five straight games in April was April 19-23, 2016 (also all at home)

WAKE UP THE BATS: The Giants scored just 10 runs thus far during the homestand (five games) after averaging 5.1 runs in their first seven games of the year...they've scored less than five runs in nine straight contests

- SF's 2.78 runs/game rate since March 31 is the lowest in the National League and third-lowest in MLB ahead of the White Sox (1.89) and Twins (2.43).
THREE LITTLE BIRDS?: After starting the season 11-for-26 (.423) with runners in scoring position during the first three games of the year, the Giants have just six hits in their last 61 at-bats (.098) with RISP and are just 2-for-33 (.061) in the five games at home.
- SF's . 284 OPS with runners in scoring position since March 31 is lowest in MLB, with their . 098 average ranking 29th of the 30 teams

WASHINGTON. BIANTS

JORDAN 1s: SF gives the ball to RHP Jordan Hicks in the series finale this afternoon...he has been stellar in his first two starts as a Giant, allowing just one earned run in 12.0 innings over two starts vs. San Diego (one in SD and one here in SF).

- Last time out on Friday in the home opener, Hicks set a career-high with 7.0 innings pitched and needed only 91 pitches to navigate the 7.0 innings.
- The Giants have won both of Hicks' starts so far in 2024

JUNG OF ALL TRADES: OF Jung Hoo Lee has reached base safely in five of his nine plate appearances in this series (4-for- 8 with a double, run scored and one walk)

- Lee hasn't struck out in his last 26 plate appearances...his 26 consecutive PA's without a strikeout is currently the thirdlongest such streak in MLB behind NYY's Alex Verdugo (33) and ARI's Joc Pederson (27)
- According to Statcast, Lee has seen 199 pitches so far this season...he's swung and missed at just five of those 199
BANG, BANG: Lee and IF Matt Chapman each have 22 hardhit balls so far this year ( $95+\mathrm{mph}$ ) according to Statcast...they are both tied for fourth-most in the Majors entering play today with their 22 hard-hit balls.

- Not one member of the Giants current 26-man roster was on the club the last time these two teams played against one another in Tampa, however LHP Blake Snell was on the Rays' roster as a rookie...the current longest tenured Giant, OF Austin Slater, did not make his debut with SF until nearly a year later on June 2, 2017.

## JORDAN HICKS RHp <br> Born: Houston, TX <br> Age: 27 (September 6, 1996) <br> Bats/Throws: R/R <br> Signed Through: 2027

WELCOME TO SF: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth $\$ 44$ million.... he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Is transitoning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 10 career starts entering today...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

LAST OUTING: Threw a career-high 7.0 innings and allowed two runs (one earned) with five hits and five strikeouts in the Giants 3-2 walk-off victory over the Padres last Friday in the home opener at Oracle Park...according to SIS, he recorded 14 outs, 73\% strikes with his sinker...through his first two starts he's recorded 75\% strikes with his sinker...last year, his strike rate with it was 66\%.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Threw 75\% first-pitch strikes in his first start and $72 \%$ in second start...the last two seasons he threw an average of $58 \%$ and $59 \%$ first-pitch strikes (SIS).

VS. THE NATIONALS: Has appeared in 11 games against the Nationals, all out of the bullpen, posting a 3.55 ERA (5er, 12.2ip) with eight strikeouts...his career-high is 2.0 innings pitched against Washington.
FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league.. he has thrown 4,272 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (39.3\%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph .
LIMIT THE LONGBALL: Has allowed just 13 home runs over 255.1 career innings (0.46 HR/9.0ip).

2023 SEASON: Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals ( 40 games) and Blue Jays ( 25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2 ip ) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, $11.1 \mathrm{~K} / 9.0 \mathrm{ip}$, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at $100+$ MPH ( $42.2 \%$ off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action. went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

- Recorded his first save of the season on Sunday, striking out the side and allowing one hit vs. San Diego.
- Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only Rod Beck in 1997 had more (29) before the break
Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since Brian Wilson (48 in '10)
