2026 DRAFTTEES GIVE BACK: The club's 2026 draft class will visit the D-backs Branch of the Boys & Girls Club of the Valley today from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm to spend the morning with local youth, enjoying wiffleball, coloring, interactive games, the Avnet America250 Reading Station and lunch.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs' 7-2 (.778) record since July 9 is best in the NL and tied for third in MLB (also: Guardians), behind the Red Sox (9-0, 1.000) and Orioles (7-1, .875).

- Since July 4, their 9 wins are tied for second in MLB (also: Brewers and Tigers), behind the Red Sox (13).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 18 straight games and 37 straight starts...in his last 12 games, since July 6, has reached base 2+ times in 9 of those games, batting .400 (18-for-45)/.957 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 RBI and 8 walks.
- **Merrill Kelly** in his last 3 starts, is 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA (4 ER in 17.0 IP), opponent .238 AVG, 7 walks and 15 strikeouts...in his last 2 home bids, is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (3 ER in 10.0 IP), 4 walks and 9 strikeouts.
- **Brandyn Garcia** has a career-high 15-game score-less streak (12.0 IP) with 1 save, an opponent .079 AVG (3-for-38)/.252 OPS, 0.50 WHIP, 3 walks and 18 strikeouts, including just 1 extra-base hit (2B).
- Is scoreless in 18 straight home games (15.1 IP) with an opponent .143 AVG (7-for-49)/356 OPS, 0.65 WHIP, 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs walked off the Athletics 6-5 last night in 10 innings on Ildemaro Vargas' second career walk-off single.

- **Kohl Drake**, in his MLB debut, allowed 1 run on 4 hits and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts over 5.0 frames.
- **Max Kepler** paced the D-backs to a 3-0 lead in the first inning with his 3-run homer (2) and reached base 4 times (2-for-3, HR, 3 RBI, 2 BB).
- **Ketel Marte** added a RBI sac fly in the seventh.
- **Nolan Arenado** had a game-tying RBI single in the 10th inning.
- **Gabriel Moreno** scored the winning run and extended to a career-best 37 straight starts reaching base safely while going 1-for-3 with 2 walks.

YESTERDAY’S ROSTER MOVES: Before yesterday's game, the D-backs recalled RHP **Gerardo Carrillo** from Triple-A Reno and placed RHP **Drey Jameson** the 15-day IL (right hip inflammation, retro to July 20).

ADDING HIS NAME: **Kohl Drake** became the 10th D-back starter ever to toss 5.0+ innings with 1 run or fewer and 5+ strikeouts in their Major League debut (ND, 1 ER in 5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 5 K).

- **Drake** is the third D-back pitcher to make his MLB debut in a start this season (also: José Cabrera on June 21 vs. Twins and Mitch Bratt on June 24 @ Cardinals) and 37th all-time in franchise history.
- Is the third time in club history with 3 starters making their debut in a season (also: 2012 with Patrick Corbin, Trevor Bauer and Tyler Skaggs, and 2022 with Tommy Henry, Ryne Nelson and Drey Jameson).

MORENO’S ON-BASE STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 37 straight starts (C: 30, DH: 7), since June 2, hitting .346 (46-for-133)/.920 OPS with 7 doubles, 3 homers, 14 RBI and 25 walks (16 K).

- Majors' longest active starts streak and second-longest this season, behind 48 starts by Nick Kurtz/ATH (April 3-May 25).
- Is the third-longest streak in club history, behind Jay Bell (39 in 1998) and Corbin Carroll (44 in 2024).

LINEUP 4-9 PRODUCTION: Since July 9, the D-backs 4-9 batters' combined .286 AVG (57-for-199) leads the Majors, ahead of the Padres (.285, 55-for-193) and Rays (.279, 64-for-229).

INTERLEAGUE BATS: **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 11 of his last 12 Interleague games, carrying an .872 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 4 walks.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base 2+ times in 8 of his last Inter-league games, batting .333 (11-for-33)/.935 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 8 straight Interleague starts, batting .367 (11-for-30)/.841 OPS with 1 double, 2 RBI and 4 walks.

DAY GAMERS: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 14 of his last 15 day games, hitting .362 (17-for-47)/1.087 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 10 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 day games, batting .350 (14-for-40)/.935 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 11 straight day games, hitting .297 (11-for-37)/.933 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 9 walks.

STINGY SNAKES DUO: **Brandyn Garcia** (0 IS/13 IR) and **Jonathan Loaisiga** (0/10) are 2 of 5 relievers in the Majors since May 8 with 10+ inherited runners and none scoring [also: Hunter Gaddis/CLE (0/11), Yoendrys Gómez/ MIN (0/11) and Hogan Harris/ATH (0/13)].

VS. ATHLETICS: The D-backs have won their previous 3 series vs. Athletics (2-1 at the Coliseum in '23, 2-1 at home in '24, 2-1 at Sacramento in '25).

- **Ketel Marte** vs. Athletics, has reached base safely in 11 straight games, batting .356 (16-for-45)/.979 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks...has reached 2+ times in 7 of those games.
- **Max Kepler** vs. Athletics, has reached base in 15 straight games, bat-tling .373 (19-for-51)/1.025 OPS with 3 homers, 9 RBI and 9 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 15 games, batting .305 (18-for-59)/.845 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 5 walks...has reached 2+ times in 7 of those games.

ON DECK VS. CARDINALS The D-backs still lead the 4-game set @ Cardinals from June 22-25, dropping the first game then winning the next 2 games, before the fourth game was postponed due to rain and re-scheduled in St. Louis for tomorrow at 2:15 p.m. AZ.

- The D-backs have taken the last 3 series and won or split each of their last 4 season series (3-3 in 2023, '24, '25 and 4-2 in 2026).

- NEXT STARTER: BRANDON PFAADT (4-1, 4.58)**
- Has won 4 straight games, 1 shy of his career high.
 - In his last 4 bids, is 4-0 with a 2.14 ERA (5 ER in 21.0 IP), opponent .235 AVG (19-for-81), 1 walk and 13 strikeouts.
 - In 5 career starts vs. Cardinals, is 2-0 with a 3.99 ERA (13 ER in 29.1 IP), opponent .222 AVG (24-for-108), 6 walks and 22 strikeouts.
