Hard to Handle

Freddy Peralta has limited opponents to a .189 batting average since the start of the 2021 season, the lowest mark in the majors in that span..... opponents are batting just .169 (14-for-83) against Peralta through 4 starts this season, the fifth-lowest mark in the National League.

Like A Rock

Bryan Hudson has allowed just 1 run over 13.1 innings in 9 appearances, including 6 straight scoreless outings (8ip).....his 0.68 ERA ranks second among qualified NL relievers behind the Cubs' Mark Leiter Jr. (0.00).

The Brewers are a Major League-best 180-121 (.598) in 1-run games since 2017, which was their first of six straight full seasons with 86+ wins (not including 2020).....Milwaukee has gone a Major League-best 6-1 (.857) in 1-run games this season.

Day Dreamers

The Brewers hold the best record in the Major Leagues in day games this season at 9-2 (.818).

New York, New York

Following today's game, the Brewers return home to host the Yankees for 3 games.....this will be just the fourth trip to Milwaukee by the Yankees since the Brewers moved to the National League in 1998 with the Brewers taking 2 of 3 games in 2005, 2014 and 2022.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 4-4 at home, going 1-1-1 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 11-4 on the road, going 4-0-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....

Rickie Weeks (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1.....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.
