'24 AT 24: Fresh off their first road trip of the year, the Giants returned to Oracle Park, winning 3-2 on a walk-off double by **IF Thairo Estrada**...SF will host its first night game of the home slate with game two of its three game series vs. the Padres tonight...the Giants homestand will then continue with a three-game series vs. the Washington Nationals from Monday-Wednesday.

- The Giants have played good baseball on the Shores of Mc-Covey Cove in recent years, going 163-114 (.588) at Oracle Park since 2020...SF's .588 winning percentage at home is sixth-best in MLB and third-best in the NL in that stretch behind LAD (195-86, .694) and ATL (169-104, .619).
- With yesterday's victory, the Giants have won 17 of their 25 (.680) home openers since Oracle Park was inaugurated in 2000...in the San Francisco era (since 1958), the team has now gone 41-26 (.612) in home openers.
- Yesterday marked SF's second walk-off win in a home opener in three seasons, also doing so on April 8, 2022 vs. Miami (also the first game of the season)...OF Austin Slater delivered the walk-off double that day, scoring Darin Ruf.

GETTING CONFORTABLE: OF Michael Conforto continued his hot start to 2024 with three hits yesterday, one plating SF's first run of the game, bringing him to a team-leading 10 RBI.

- Conforto has now reached base in all eight games this season...he is slashing .419/.455/.839 with four doubles, three homers and 10 RBI...he currently ranks inside MLB's top-10 in batting average (8th), RBI (T-5th), slugging percentage (3rd), OPS (1.294, 4th), hits (13, T-4th), extra-base hits (seven, 3rd) and total bases (26, T-2nd).
- He has driven in a run in four consecutive games (5 RBI total)...the four-game streak is one shy of his career-high of five straight games (done twice, last July 14-18, 2023).
- According to Sports Info Solutions, 13 of Conforto's 22 times making contact this season were considered hit hard, which is a 59% rate...he held a 40% rate in 2023.

'PEN TO PAPER: SF received a key performance from its bullpen in yesterday's win with shutout frames by **RHP Tyler Rogers** and **RHP Camilo Doval** setting up the walk-off win.

- After a tough start to the season, the Giants bullpen has performed better in recent days...SF relievers have allowed just one run (a HR) on six hits with 11 strikeouts over their last three games in 9.1ip (0.96 ERA), as opposed to a 10.00 ERA (20er, 18.0ip) with four homers and 10 walks over their first five contests.
- ► The Giants have needed to rely heavily on their young pitchers, with four relievers make their MLB debuts in the past week (RHP Nick Avila, LHP Erik Miller, RHP Landen Roupp, RHP Kai-Wei Teng).

OPPOSITE ENDS: SF has been one of the best teams in baseball when in a close game over the past year plus, while San Diego has been one of the worst...Since the start of 2023, SF's 43-32 (.573) record in two-run games ranks sixth in MLB compared to the Padres' 27-43 (.386) record, which is 28th.

GROUNDED: RHP Jordan Hicks forced 12 ground balls (10 outs) in 7.0 innings yesterday (*SIS*)...he currently ranks fourth in the Majors with a 56.3% ground ball rate (minimum 10 innings pitched).

SPLITTING HAIRS: RHP Keaton Winn threw his splitter 37 times (41.6%) with 30 being strikes in his season debut at LAD according to *Sports Info Solutions*.

- Last season, Winn used his splitter 55.4% of the time, with opponents hitting .221 against it.
- ▶ The Padres struggled against splitters in 2023 batting .217 with a .585 OPS compared to their overall season numbers of .244 average and .742 OPS...in a small sample size this season, SD has a .222/.417/.444 slash line vs. splitters.

SEND HELP!: RHP Jordan Hicks and the bullpen did a solid job in righting the unsteady ship with just two runs allowed (one earned) yesterday.

- Even so, SF's 48 runs allowed through eight games ranks tied for eighth-most by the Giants since 1901, and also tied for second-most by the Giants in the SF-era behind the 51 runs allowed in 1983...the SF-era record through nine games is 54 runs allowed by the 1999 and 1983 Giants.
- SF's 48 runs allowed are sixth-most in MLB behind Colorado (65), Miami (59), San Diego (57), Los Angeles-NL (51) and Oakland (49).

HARD KNOCKS: The Giants are hitting the ball harder than anyone this season after ranking in the bottom half of the Majors in 2023 (depicted in the table below).

SNELL DAY: Giants manager **Bob Melvin** announced that 2023 NL Cy Young Award winner **LHP Blake Snell** will make his Giants debut this Monday against the Washington Nationals at Oracle Park...Snell signed a two-year, \$62 million contract with the Giants on March 19.

LIGHT IT UP: Unveiled pregame yesterday, Oracle Park received upgrades to its sound and light systems with the addition of 11 LED video displays throughout the ballpark that add over 3.5k square feet of incremental video capacity... tonight's game offers the first chance to display the light show.

IT'S IOWA: The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to make his second start of the season...Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his first start of the season on Monday at Dodger Stadium...suffered the loss despite holding LA batters to just four hits over 5.0 innings with three runs, a walk and six strike-outs...Winn threw a career-high 89 pitches in the start.

SPRING TRAINING: Missed most of the spring while dealing with right elbow soreness...saw Cactus League action twice (one start) in late March and went 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (2er, 5.2ip) and three strikeouts for SF.

VS. SAN DIEGO: Has faced the Padres twice in his career, both times pitching bulk innings off the 'pen...the right-hander has a 0.90 ERA (1er, 10.0ip) in the two outings with six strikeouts and a .200 opposing average (7-for-35)...he's thrown 5.0 innings in each of the games and the only run he allowed was a solo homer by Juan Soto in what was Winn's second career MLB appearance (June 19, 2023).

2023 SEASON: After starting the year in Triple-A Sacramento, Winn made his Major League debut on June 13 at St. Louis in relief, firing 4.0 innings and picking up the save...he joined SF's rotation two weeks later and made five starts for the Giants, going 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA as a starter...overall, the right-hander posted a 1-3-1 record with a 4.68 ERA and 1.04 WHIP across nine MLB appearances.

SAVING THE DAY: After collecting the save in his Major League debut on June 13, 2023 at St. Louis, Winn became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).

CONSISTENCY IS KEY: Despite splitting his time between the rotation and the 'pen, Winn has thrown at least 3.0 innings in all 10 career outings...he became one of just three Giants rookies since 2010 to pitch at least 3.0 innings in each of his first nine career games (others: **Andrew Suárez** in 2018 and **Shaun Anderson** in 2019).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Winn (nine strikeouts on September 3 vs. COL) and **LHP Kyle Harrison** (11 strikeouts on August 28 vs. CIN) became the first Giants rookie duo to each strike out nine or more in a game in the same season since 2003: **Jesse Foppert** (10 strikeouts on June 11 at CWS, 10 strikeouts on July 20 vs. COL) and **Jerome Williams** (nine strikeouts on August 1 at CIN).

#58 NICK AVILA > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball **Last Game:** 4/1 at LAD; 2.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2k (38 pitches)

- Had his contract purchased from Triple-A last Monday and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/5 vs. SD; W, 1.0ip, h, bb, 2k (27 pitches)

- Made his third Opening Day roster.
- ► Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only Rod Beck in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLP hobind CLE's Empanyol Class (44)
- NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44). The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, 2k (16 pitches)

- Made his first career Opening Day roster...the southpaw made his debut on Opening Day, striking out one in 1.0 inning in San Diego.
- Appeared in four games on SF's road trip, allowing five runs in 3.2ip.
 Is ranked the Giants No. 30 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- In five spring outings, Miller gave up one earned run (a HR) on four hits (.211 avg) with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings.
- Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

- Last Game: 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, r, er, hr (21 pitches)
- Made his eighth OD roster, second with SF...made three appearances on the Giants trip, allowing a run in two of his three outings.
- Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
- Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/5 vs. SD; 1.0ip, k (12 pitches)

- Made his fifth Opening Day roster (all w/SF)...appeared in five of SF's first eight games, allowing two runs (both on HRs) in 4.0ip.
- Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring.
 Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (267g).

#65 LANDEN ROUPP ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter **Last Game:** 4/2 at LAD; 2.0ip,h, bb, 4k (43 pitches)

- Made his first career Opening Day roster and made his MLB debut on March 29...has tossed 4.0-scoreless innings, over three outings.
- Roupp struck out 13 of the 29 batters he faced this spring (44.8%).
 Is the Giants No. 12 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 14 according to *Baseball America*.
- Was selected by SF in the 12th round of the 2021 draft and appeared in his first big league camp this year.
- Had never pitched above Double-A and has only made 15 total appearances at the Double-A level prior to this year.
- Roupp struck out 42 batters over 31.0 innings (12.2 K/9ip) with Double-A Richmond in 2023 and held opponents to a .206 average.
- His 1.74 ERA prior to hitting the IL last season ranked as the fourthlowest in all Double-A (min. 30.0ip).
- Did not pitch after June 30 last year after landing on IL w/back inflammation.

#70 KAI-WEI TENG► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball, Changeup Last Game: 3/31 at SD; 3.0ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 4k (68 pitches)

- Made his Major League debut last Sunday at SD and tossed 3.0 innings with three runs allowed...became the 17th ever Taiwaneseborn player in MLB history and the first in Giants history.
- Recalled from Triple-A on March 29.
- Rated as #25 prospect in Giants farm system according to *MLB.com*.
 Was in big league camp with the Giants this year but didn't appear
- in a game due to a left oblique strain.
 Finished last year with 164 Ks between AA & AAA, ninth-most
- Finished last year with 164 Ks between AA & AAA, ninth-most among all minor league pitchers.

#74 RYAN WALKER > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/2 at LAD; 1.2ip, bb, 2k (25 pitches)

- Made his first career OD roster...pitched in four games on SF's road trip, allowing one run in 4.2ip (1.93 ERA).
