



## San Francisco Giants (29-33) at Arizona Diamondbacks (29-32)

RHP Jordan Hicks (4-2, 2.70) vs. LHP Jordan Montgomery (3-3, 5.48)

**TODAY'S GAME:** Once again the Giants find themselves on the verge of getting swept after dropping the first two games of this series to Arizona after losing 8-5 last night.

- ▶ The Giants have lost a season-high six consecutive games, dating to last Wednesday vs. Philadelphia, being outscored 38-18 during the skid.
- ▶ This is the Giants longest losing streak since September 1-6, 2023 (also six games)...the last time SF had a longer streak was August 24-31, 2022 when they lost seven straight.
- ▶ SF draws another lefty in LHP Jordan Montgomery today after dropping yesterday's game when LHP Blake Walston started for Arizona...the Giants are 5-12 vs. lefty starters this year and have lost each of their last five games vs. a LHSP.
- ▶ The Giants last win versus a left-handed starter came May 18 vs. Colorado, a 14-4 win when LHP Ty Blach started.

**ROSTER MOVES:** **OF Austin Slater** returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 7-day concussion list...**OF Luis Matos** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

**SNAKEBIT:** SF is looking to turn things around at Chase Field where they have struggled over the last few seasons, posting a 4-13 record in its last 17 games here dating to July 4, 2022.

- ▶ Arizona has outscored San Francisco 95-55 during that 17 game stretch, averaging 3.2 runs/game in that time...in that time, opposing teams as a whole have averaged 4.56 runs/game at Chase Field.
- ▶ The Giants have dropped each of their last seven games here dating to May 12 last year, that's tied for the club's second-longest losing streak at this facility...the club's longest losing streak is an eight-gamer from June 16, 2011-May 11, 2012.

**GOTTA SCORE MORE:** Since scoring eight runs in their victory over the Phillies on Memorial Day, the Giants have scored a total of 19 runs in their last seven games dating to May 28 for an average of 2.7 runs/game.

- ▶ SF's offense in that time has slashed .207/.281/.308 with 13 extra-base hits.
- ▶ The Giants are 7-23 (.233) when scoring three or fewer runs and 22-10 (.688) when scoring at least four.
- ▶ Last night, SF found themselves in favorable counts most of the game but could not punch through with the big hit...for the season, the Giants have a .989 OPS in hitter's counts (1-0, 2-0, 3-0, 2-1, 3-1), which is 20th of 30 MLB teams...the league average OPS in those hitter's counts is 1.038.

**HELLO OLD 'CHAP:** **IF Matt Chapman** extended his on-base streak last night to 22 games with his 2-for-5 night...the 22-game streak is the fifth-longest active streak in the Majors.

- ▶ Chapman is slashing .306/.398/.565 with 20 runs, 10 doubles, four homers and 14 RBI during his 22-game streak that started on May 11 vs. Cincinnati.
- ▶ The 22-game streak is two shy of the second-longest streak of his career, a 24-gamer from June 11-July 9, 2021 with the A's...his career-best is a 30-game streak (also with the A's) from July 11-August 17, 2018.
- ▶ Chapman's streak is the longest by any Giant since **OF Andrew McCutchen** had a 24-game on-base streak from April 18-May 14, 2018.

**KICKS WITH HICKS:** **RHP Jordan Hicks** aims to be the stopper for the Giants today in what will be his 13th start of the season...his 2.70 ERA entering play today is fifth-best in the NL.

- ▶ Hicks allowed a season-high five runs (four earned) last time out vs. the Yankees last Friday at Oracle Park while throwing a career-high 101 pitches...he finished 5.1 innings, pitching into the sixth inning for the first time since April 27.
- ▶ He's pitched 63.1 innings so far this year, just shy of his total from last season between St. Louis and Toronto (65.2ip).

**YAZ:** **OF Mike Yastrzemski** clubbed his third career pinch-hit homer last night with his three-run blast in the 8th inning...it was his first pinch hit homer since April 5, 2021 and the Giants first pinch-hit blast of the season.

- ▶ His nine homers here at Chase Field are his second-most at any visiting stadium behind his 10 at Coors Field.

**SETTLING IN:** Since joining the Giants on May 8, **OF Heliot Ramos** is hitting .289 with 10 runs, four doubles, four homers and 17 RBI in 25 games...in his last nine games, he's 10-for-31 (.323) with two homers, eight RBI and a .432 OBP.

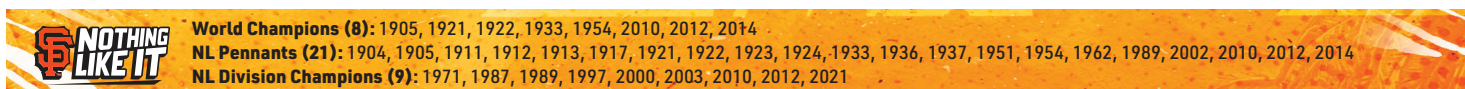
- ▶ Ramos has reached base safely in 23 of his 25 games since joining SF and has a .373 OBP.

**MEN ON THE MEND:** Three of the players on SF's injured list participated in various rehab games last night.

- ▶ **OF Austin Slater** went 1-for-4 with a leadoff homer for Triple-A Sacramento...he's 4-for-17 in five rehab games there.
- ▶ **LHP Robbie Ray** returned to game action yesterday for the first time since his Tommy John surgery last year...he threw 1.0 scoreless innings in an ACL game, allowed one hit and struck out three.
- ▶ **RHP Keaton Winn** followed Ray in that game, working 3.2 innings allowing one run on two hits with six strikeouts and two walks in 62 pitches.

**June 5, 2002** - **Barry Bonds** hit a tape measure grand slam off scoreboard in right field at Qualcomm Stadium. His blast off rookie Dennis Tankersley was his 587th career homer, passing Frank Robinson for fourth all-time in the home run list.

**WELCOME TO SF:** Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

**PUSH TO START:** Has transitioned from a relief role into a traditional starting role this year...has made 20 career starts entering today, 12 of which have come this season...prior to this year, he had pitched 204 games out of the bullpen over parts of five Major League seasons...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

**LAST OUTING:** Suffered the loss on Friday, May 31 against the Yankees...threw 5.1 innings and allowed a season-high five runs on seven hits with four strikeouts...Hicks threw a career-high 101 pitches...allowed two home runs in a game for just the second time in his career (other: May 1, 2022 vs. ARI).

**VS. ARIZONA:** Is scheduled to make his 11th career appearance against the Diamondbacks...has appeared in eight relief outings and made two starts in his career against Arizona...he faced them earlier this year at Oracle Park and threw 5.0 innings, allowing one run on one hit and four walks...has appeared in four games as a reliever at Chase Field and allowed three runs in 4.0 innings with seven strikeouts.

**SEIZE THE DAY:** The right-hander is 3-0 with a 1.36 ERA (5er, 33.0ip) and .162 opposing average in six day games this season...for comparison, Hicks has a 1-2 record and 4.15 ERA in six night starts.

**TOP OF THE CHARTS:** Has a 2.70 ERA through 12 outings, which currently ranks as the fifth-best ERA among starters in the National League...his 53.3% groundball rate is sixth-highest in the National League.

**SPLIT SECOND:** Opponents are hitting just .123 (4-for-52) with 22 strikeouts off his splitter...however, in his last start, opponents were 3-for-5 with a home run...he's been using the pitch 23.8% of the time this year.

**VIA THE LONGBALL:** Has allowed five home runs over his last four outings...prior to that, Hick had allowed just one home run over his first eight starts.

**THIRD TIME'S A CHARM:** Has faired well when pitching longer into the game so far this season, with opponents going 9-for-40 (.225) the third time through the lineup.

**HIGH-FIVE:** Hicks has pitched 5.0+ innings in 11 of his 12 starts this season...the only time he didn't reach the 5th inning was on May 3 at Philly when he tossed 4.0 innings.

**FEEL THE HEAT:** Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league...he has thrown 5,154 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 clocked at over 100 mph (32.6%)...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

**DIABETIC PHENOM:** Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself...Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.
