Ichiro Suzuki is set to become the third player inducted to the National Baseball Hall of Fame with the Seattle Mariners in 58 days on July 27 in Cooperstown... he is also set to have his #51 retired by the Mariners on Aug. 9 at T-Mobile Park.

The Mariners and Twins square off in their first of two series this season...the teams will meet again at Target Field in Minneapolis, MN for 4 games (6/23-26).

<u>TONIGHT'S TILT</u>...the Mariners play the first of three games against the Minnesota Twins...the Mariners have hosted the Washington Nationals (1-2) already on the homestand, and will host their Capital Beltway neighbors the Baltimore Orioles (3 G, 6/3-5) to close out the homestand...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Dave Valle** on the call, with **Jen Mueller** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Shannon Drayer** on the call.

<u>ODDS AND ENDS</u>...the Mariners dropped last night's game by a 9-3 score in 10 innings...Seattle is 14-13 at home and 16-12 on the road this season...the Mariners are 21-4 when scoring 5+ runs and 25-7 when scoring at least 4.

- Wild, Wild West The Mariners are in 1st place in the AL West Division, a half-game ahead of second place Houston and 4.0 games ahead of the Rangers...Seattle is 14-8 against divisional opponents.
- After Seven Only 3 MLB teams are undefeated when leading after 7 innings this season: the Mariners (22-0), the Nationals (21-0), and the Guardians (24-0).
- FOX on Saturday Tomorrow's first pitch is set for <u>4:15 p.m.</u> and will air exclusively on FOX with Jason Benetti and Adam Wainwright on the call.
- Rehab Update RHP Logan Gilbert made his first rehab appearance yesterday with Triple-A Tacoma tossing 1.2 innings and throwing 45 pitches.
- The Fireman Matt Brash has made 8 scoreless appearances since returning from injury, recording 8 strikeouts.
- Recently INF Ben Williamson is batting .333 (11x33) with a .371 OBP over his last 10 games (5/19-c)...OF Leody Taveras is batting .323 (10x31) with 2 HR, 4 RBI, 2 SB and a .871 OPS over his last 9 games (5/20-c).
- Yesterday's Roster Moves Yesterday RHP Casey Lawrence was selected from Triple-A Tacoma
  for his 5th stint in the Majors with Seattle this season...to make room on the active roster, RHP Blas
  Castaño was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma and to make room on the 40-man roster, C Blake Hunt was
  designated for assignment.

CAL: BEST CATCHER IN THE GAME...catcher Cal Raleigh is batting .260 (52x200) with 35 runs, 10 doubles, 19 home runs, 37 RBI, 36 walks and 6 stolen bases, with a .379 on-base percentage and .595 slugging percentage...he leads MLB catchers in virtually every offensive statistical category, and overall in the Majors ranks T-2nd in home runs, 8th in walks, 4th in slugging percentage, 6th in OPS, T-7th in extrabase hits (29), T-6th in total bases (119), T-4th in bWAR (3.0), 4th in OPS+ (184), 2nd in fWAR (3.4) and 5th in wRC+ (179)...Cal has appeared in all 55 of the Mariners games this season.

HISTORIC TERRITORY WITHIN REACH...Cal Raleigh could become the first catcher in MLB history to reach 20 home runs before the end of May if he homers tonight or tomorrow...he would also join fellow Mariners Ken Griffey Jr. (3x, 1994, 1997 and 1999) and Alex Rodriguez (1998) to record 20 home runs before the end of May.

<u>SERIES-LY SPECTACULAR</u>...heading into tonight's rubber match, the Mariners own an 11-6-1 series record in 2025 (4-4-1 at home and 7-2 on the road)...the Mariners won 9 consecutive series from April 7-May 7, the second-longest series winning streak in club history...since **Dan Wilson** took the helm on Aug. 23, 2024, Seattle owns a 18-8-3 series record.

BRYAN WOO: AL PITCHER OF THE MONTH CANDIDATE...Mariners starter Bryan Woo has a 2.27 ERA (8 ER, 31.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 1 walk in 5 May starts, holding opponents to a .225 batting average...Woo's 30.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks 2nd to Kevin Gausman-TOR (33.0 SO/BB)...in Mariners history, the only pitchers with a better strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 25 IP) in a calendar month than Woo's current 30.0 mark are Hisashi Iwakuma (39 SO, 1 BB in 42.2 IP) in July 2014 and Logan Gilbert (31 SO, 1 BB in 35.2 IP) in June 2024...overall this season, Woo is 5-2 with a 2.69 ERA (19 ER, 63.2 IP), 8 walks, 60 strikeouts and a 0.94 WHIP...among qualified MLB starters, he ranks 8th in WHIP, 3rd in SO/BB (7.50), 2nd in BB/9 (1.13) and 19th in ERA.

MUÑOZ: REPEAT AL RELIEVER OF THE MONTH?...Andrés Muñoz is tied for the Major League lead with 17 saves this season (also: Robert Suarez-SD)...in 24 appearances, the reigning American League Reliever of the Month for March/April is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 23.2 IP) with 8 hits allowed, 2 runs allowed (0 earned runs), 8 walks (2 intentional) and 29 strikeouts, sporting a 0.68 WHIP, while limiting opponents to a .104 batting average (8x77)...his 23.2 innings pitched and counting without allowing an earned run to begin the season are a Mariners franchise record for a relief pitcher...Muñoz leads MLB relievers in bWAR (2.2) and has already surpassed his career-high 2.0 bWAR from last season...the franchise record for highest bWAR in a season by a Seattle reliever belongs to Bill Caudill (4.4 bWAR) in 1982.

A TRIP DOWN I-5...a pair of Mariners top prospects INF Cole Young (No. 43 in MLB according to MLB Pipeline) and C Harry Ford (No. 67 in MLB) have had standout months for Triple-A Tacoma...Young is batting .370 (37x100) with 28 runs, 10 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 15 walks to just 8 strikeouts, 4 stolen bases, a .466 OBP, slugging .680 with a 1.146 OPS...Ford is batting .402 (33x82) with 17 runs, 6 doubles, 5 home runs, 20 RBI and 10 walks, getting on base at a .467 clip and slugging .659 (1.126 OPS).

**MARINERS-TWINS CONNECTIONS**...several players on the Mariners and Twins active rosters have ties between the two teams...INF **Jorge Polanco** spent 10 Major League season with the Twins (2014-23) while C **Mitch Garver** (2017-21) and INF **Donovan Solano** (2023) have appeared in the Majors for Minnesota... RHP **Casey Legumina** and INF/OF **Luke Raley** have each spent time in the Twins organization...active Twins that have played for the Mariners include INF Ty France (2020-24) who was an All-Star in 2021 for Seattle and owns the franchise record for HBP (95) and RHP Justin Topa (2024).

ON THE HOMESTAND...the Mariners continue the 9-game homestand, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, 5/30-6/1) and Baltimore Orioles (3 G, 6/3-6/5)...the rest of the homestand is highlighted by **K-Pop Fireworks Night** on May 30, **Little League Day** on June 1, **Pride Night** on June 4 and a pair of **Mariners Value Games** on June 3 and June 5, with <u>tickets starting at \$11</u>.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Bryan Woo has made 50 Major League starts in a Mariners uniform, going 18-10 with a 3.27 ERA (99 ER, 272.2 IP), 52 walks, 254 strikeouts and a 1.01 WHIP, but...DID YOU KNOW?...among Mariners pitchers in their first 50 starts with Seattle, he ranks 2nd in ERA, trailing only Hisashi Iwakuma (2.72)?...Woo ranks ahead of current rotation mates George Kirby (3rd, 3.33) and Luis Castillo (5th, 3.39).

#### ABOUT BRYAN WOO.

- The 25-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 11th start of the season tonight and his 1st against the Twins...marks his 51st Major League start and 2nd career start against the Twins.
- Selected by Seattle in the 6th round (174th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Cal Poly University...signed by Mariners scout Chris Hom.
- Spent 3 seasons at Cal Poly before being drafted, making 31 appearances (6 GS) for the Mustanas
- Did not pitch in 2021 while recovering from right elbow surgery.

LAST TIME OUT...L#2 on May 24 at Houston, throwing 6.0 innings, allowing 10 hits with 2 runs and 5 strikeouts in his 3rd straight start with 0 walks...Woo is the only starting pitcher this season to thrown at least 6.0+ innings pitched in their first 10 starts, and the first since Joe Musgrove-SD threw 6.0+ innings in his first 15 starts of the 2022 season (4/9-7/7/22)...he has the 2nd most innings pitched (63.2 IP) in a pitcher's first 10 appearances this season (trailing only PHI-Zack Wheeler: 64.0 IP).

AMONG MARINERS ACES...he joins Logan Gilbert and Cliff Lee as 1 of the 3 pitchers in franchise history with at least 60 strikeouts and 10-or-less walks in their first 10 starts of the season...Woo is also 1 of 7 pitchers in franchise history to throw 6.0 innings in their first 10 starts of the season (last: Cliff Lee 13 starts, 4/30/10-7/4/10).

MANY MAY FLOWERS ... Woo has a 2.27 ERA (8 ER, 31.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 1 walk in 5 May starts, holding opponents to a .225 batting average.. Woo's 30.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks 2nd to Kevin Gausman-TOR (33.0 SO/BB)...in Mariners history, the only pitchers with a better strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 25 IP) in a calendar month than Woo's are Hisashi Iwakuma (39 SO, 1 BB in 42.2 IP) in July 2014 and Logan Gilbert (31 SO, 1 BB in 35.2 IP) in June 2024.

FROM EDGAR & DAVE ... since 2024, in 13 starts at T-Mobile Park, he is 8-1 with a 2.08 ERA (18 ER, 77.2 IP) and 73 strikeouts to 9 walks and a 12-1 Mariners record...he has allowed 3-or-less runs and 5-or-less hits in 11 of those 13 starts.

KEEPING IT CENTRAL ... across 8 starts against AL-Central teams, Woo has a 1-2 record and a 3.60 ERA (16 ER, 40.0 IP) with a 1.05 WHIP, recording 1-or-less walks in 7 of those 8 starts, and a Mariners record of 6-2...since last season in 5 starts against the AL-Central, Woo has walked just 4 hitters with 22 strikeouts, and a 4-1 Mariners record.

UNDER THE LIGHTS...in 4 night game starts for Woo this season, he is 2-1 with a 1.35 ERA (4 ER, 26.2), an 1.89 AVG against, 0.79 WHIP, while walking just 3 hitters with 25 strikeouts.

HOT START...in his first career 50 games, Woo ranks, 2nd in ERA (3.27), fewest hits allowed (223), and runs allowed (104), 3rd in fewest BB (52), 4th with a .643 W-L% (18-10), and 5th in SO (254), in franchise history (min. 250.0 IP)...Woo also joins teammate George Kirby as 1 of 2 pitchers in franchise history in their first 50 games to record more than 250 strikeouts and 55 or less walks.

INSTANT IMPACT...since his big league debut (6/3/23), Woo ranks within the top-ten in ERA (3.20), WHIP (1.00), hits allowed (222), earned runs allowed (97), runs allowed (104), walks (52), BB/9 (1.72), K/BB (4.88), and BB% (4.8%) among all pitchers with at least 250.0 IP during that span.

LOOKING AT THE SPLITS...in 23.2 innings pitched combined in the 5th, 6th, and 7th innings this season, Woo has a 0.46 WHIP, and has allowed no runs, with only 6 hits and 5 walks to 24 strikeouts...against left-handed hitters this season, they hold a .217 AVG against, with Woo walking just 3 batters to 26 strikeouts with a 0.91 WHIP.

LOW, LOW, LOW...his 1.01 WHIP through his first 3 seasons is the lowest in franchise history by a starting pitcher through 3 seasons...his 3.27 ERA is ranked 5th best by a starting pitcher in franchise history (min. 250.0 IP)...since the 2023 season, Woo ranks within the top-10 in WHIP (1.00), ERA (3.54), AVG against (.216), BB/9 (1.72), K/BB (4.88), BB (52), QS (22), wins (18), innings pitched (272.2 IP), among starting pitchers who are 25-or-younger (min. 150.0 IP).

**ONE OF WOO**...Woo is 1 of 3 pitchers (Hisashi Iwakuma, and teammate **George Kirby**) in franchise history to record at least 160 strikeouts and 25 or less walks in a 32-game span...he also has thrown at least 6.0 innings pitched in 19 of his last 22 starts (8/2/24-c).

KEEPING HIS STEP... since the start of last season, in 32 starts Woo is 14-5 with a 2.82 ERA (58 ER, 185.0 IP), 21 walks, 161 strikeouts, with 22 of those starts throwing at least 6.0 innings...among pitchers with at least 150.0 IP since the start of last season, ranks among the leaders in walks allowed (21), BB/9 (1.02), runs allowed (60), K/BB (7.67), WHIP (0.91), and ERA (2.72).

EXCLAMATION ON 100...in his 5th road start of the season (5/7 at ATH) Woo threw a career high 100 pitches...on his 100th pitch of the game, Woo recorded his 3rd strikeout of the 6th inning, and it was the 3rd time this season he has recorded 3 strikeouts in an inning (4/24 at BOS in the 1st inning and 5/2 at TEX in the 5th inning).
