**TODAY'S TILT...**the Mariners wrap up the 6-game homestand with the last of a 3-game set against the Chicago White Sox (1-1)...Seattle also hosted the San Diego Padres on the homestand (0-3)...following the off-day tomorrow, the Mariners will embark on a 6-game road trip at Kansas City (3 G, 5/22-24) and Sacramento (3 G, 5/25-27) to take on the Athletics...today's tilt will be televised live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** serving as field analyst...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS...**the Mariners dropped yesterday's game by a 2-1 final against the White Sox...the Mariners are 13-12 over their last 25 games since April 22.

- **On a Stroll** - The Mariners are one of 4 teams in the Majors this season to rank in the top 10 in both most walks by an offense and fewest walks allowed by a pitching staff, along with the Cubs, Yankees and Dodgers.
- **Young and Spry** - Second baseman **Cole Young**'s 11 defensive runs saved lead MLB infielders and rank T-3rd in the big leagues among all positions.
- **J-Rod Staying Toasty** - Over his last 22 games (4/25-c), **Julio Rodríguez** is batting .268 (26x97) with 16 runs, 6 doubles, 7 home runs, 13 RBI, 3 stolen bases, a .304 OBP and slugging .546 (.850 OPS).

**BRASH IS BACK!**...today the Mariners reinstated RHP **Matt Brash** from the 15-day Injured List and optioned LHP **Robinson Ortiz** to Triple-A Tacoma (post-game May 19)...Brash has been out since May 1 with right lat inflammation...in 14 appearances this season, Brash has yet to allow an earned run over 11.1 IP with 8 strikeouts.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW, COLT EMERSON!**...**Colt Emerson**, the Mariners top prospect and the #3 overall prospect in baseball (*Baseball America*) was recalled from Triple-A Tacoma on Sunday for his MLB debut...he has reached base safely in all 3 Major League games he has played:

- **The Debut** - At 20 years, 301 days, Colt became the youngest Mariner to make his MLB debut since Félix Hernández (19 years, 118 days, 8/4/05 at DET)...he is the 12th-youngest player overall to debut for Seattle.
- **Sense of the Dramatic** - Emerson became the 11th player in Mariners history to homer for their first career hit...Colt also homered for his first professional hit (8/4/23) and his first Triple-A hit (9/16/25)...his first Triple-A hit was also a 3-run homer...he is also the first Mariners player to hit a 3+ run homer for their first career homer since **Julio Rodríguez** (5/1/22 at MIA).
- **Young Man** - Colt became the youngest Mariners player to homer since José López (20 years, 294 days, 9/13/04 vs. LAA) and is the 7th Mariners player age 20-or-younger to homer, joining López, Orlando Mercado, Marc Newfield, Chris Snelling, Alex Rodriguez and Ken Griffey Jr.

**SOLID ON THE MOUND...**the Mariners pitching staff has been solid this season, posting a combined 3.66 ERA (181 ER, 445.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 128 walks and 432 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 1st in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.38), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.59), 7th in ERA and T-7th in WHIP (1.22)...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 287.0 innings pitched and ranks 4th in quality starts with 22.

**NAYLOR LOVES A PAIR OF WHITE SOX...**Josh Naylor is batting .474 (9x19) with 4 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 4 RBI and a 1.208 OPS in 5 games against the White Sox this season...for his career against the South Siders, Naylor is batting .364 (80x220), with 40 runs, 21 doubles, 12 home runs, 46 RBI and 7-for-7 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .407 clip and slugging .623 for a 1.030 OPS...among all opponents Naylor has faced in his career his 12 HR against the White Sox are the most against any opponent while his 1.030 OPS ranks 2nd, trailing only his 1.102 OPS against the Pirates.

**RANDY! RANDY! RANDY!**...Randy Arozarena is batting .300 (54x180) with 33 runs, 13 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 19 RBI, 12 stolen bases, a .386 OBP and slugging .450 for an .836 OPS in 50 games this season...among AL left fielders this season, he ranks 2nd in average, 3rd in OBP, 4th in slugging, 2nd in wRC+ (143) and T-2nd in fWAR (1.8)...Randy has been scorching hot as of late, batting .409 (18x44) with a 1.049 OPS in his last 12 games (5/8-c).

**BALL MAGNETS...**Seattle has 33 HBP this season, 3rd-most in MLB, trailing only the St. Louis Cardinals (35 HBP) and Los Angeles Angels (34 HBP)...Seattle has led MLB in HBP in 3-consecutive seasons (2023-25)...since the '23 season, Seattle has 349 total HBP, with Minnesota having the 2nd-most in MLB at 313 HBP...during that same time frame, Mariners pitchers have 211 HBP, 12th-fewest in MLB.

**SEE YOU HERE NEXT WEEK...**following the upcoming road trip, the Mariners return home for a 6-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (3 G, May 29-31) and Mets (3 G, June 1-3)...featured on the homestand is **'90s Weekend** (May 29-31) with **'90s Fireworks Night** on Friday, May 29, **Julio Rodríguez '90s Jersey Night** on Saturday, May 30 and **'90s Pin Day** on Sunday, May 31.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Luke Raley recorded 2 HR and 7 RBI on May 8 against the White Sox, the most RBI in a game this season, and...**AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...**Raley has excelled against the White Sox in his career, batting .289 (13x45) with 3 doubles, 7 home runs, 17 RBI, slugging .822 with a 1.127 OPS in 46 PA, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...among active players with at least 40 PA against the White Sox, his 1.127 OPS ranks 6th?...he trails Aaron Judge-NYY (1.452), Royce Lewis-MIN (1.291), Juan Soto-NYM (1.228), Shohei Ohtani-LAD (1.181) and Nolan Arenado-ARI (1.147).

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 20

- **1990** - Edgar Martínez's two-out, two-run homer in the 10th caps a 4x5, two homer day as the Mariners outlast Cleveland 8-7 in ten innings. Martínez had a triple and a single to go with the pair of home runs.
- **1994** - Mariners set club record for runs in 19-2 win vs. Texas. Club also establishes game records for largest victory margin (17), most RBI (19) and most total bases (42).
- **1994** - Ken Griffey Jr becomes the third youngest player in history to hit 150 HR's trailing Mel Ott and Eddie Mathews.
- **2000** - Rickey Henderson becomes the 7th player to homer in his first at-bat as a Mariner...its his 76th career lead off HR.
- **2010** - Ken Griffey Jr. recorded his 2nd career pinch-hit walk-off, and his 10th career walk-off ever.
- **2016** - Nelson Cruz recorded his 250th career home run.
- **2025** - Seattle falls 1-0 to the White Sox, with the Mariners pitching staff allowing exactly 1 run in 5 consecutive games, tying the MLB record (done 10x, last: Pirates from Aug. 16-20, 2018).

ABOUT EMERSON HANCOCK...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season and the 41st start of his career...this will be his 47th career appearance including the 6 relief appearances he made throughout the 2025 regular season...it will mark his 2nd start against the White Sox this season, 3rd career appearance and 3rd career start against Chicago-AL.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (6th overall) of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Scott Hunter on June 25, 2020.
- Spent 3 seasons at the University of Georgia, 2018-20...in 2020, was named Vince Dooley Athlete of the Year as the top male student-athlete at the University of Georgia.
- Was named to CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team in 2020.

LAST TIME OUT...L#2 on May 15 vs. San Diego, tossed 6 strikeouts across 6.0 innings and allowed 1 run (1 ER) on 5 hits (1 HR) and 1 walk...he threw 91 pitches (64 strikes) in his 9th start of the year...gave the team 6.0+ innings in his 4th-consecutive start, surpassing his previous career-best streak of such games (3x, last: 4/23-5/6/25).

HOME TURF...across his last 8 appearances at home (9/10/25-5/15/26) he is 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA (8 ER, 36.2 IP), 4 walks and 46 strikeouts for a 11.5 K/BB and a 0.801 WHIP...in 4 home starts in 2026, he is 2-1 with 3-or-fewer runs allowed over 5.0+ IP in all 5 appearances...has had 3 starts with 1-or-fewer runs and 6+ strikeouts over 6.0+ IP...6th in WHIP (.90) and 10th in opponent OBP (.247) in home games in the AL this season (min. 20 IP) while ranking 5th in MLB in BB% (3.7%) and 4th in K/BB (9.3).

SOMETHING ABOUT THE SUNSHINE...will be making his 3rd day start of the season in today's game...the Mariners are 2-0 over those 2 starts and are 7-2 since 2025 when Hancock gets the start in a day game...in his last 2 day starts, went 6.0 innings, allowing 2-or-fewer runs and 2-or-fewer walks in each...ranks 8th in WHIP (0.833), T-10th in ERA (1.50), and T-7th in opponent batting average (.171) among AL pitchers in day games this season (min. 2 GS).

KEEP THE K'S COMING...continues his early-season strike throwing through his first 3 starts in May...his career K/9 of 7.5 during May is the highest of any month...in 2026 his May K/9 (11.4) and K/BB (6.00) top his March/April marks of 8.3 K/9 and 5.33 K/BB...owns the 5th most strikeouts (24) in May this season and the 8th best K/BB (6.0) among AL starting pitchers with a 32.0 K% ranking T-9th with Paul Skenes-PIT among starting pitchers in MLB.

CAREER STRETCH...over his last 9 starts he has struck out 56 batters and thrown 53.2 IP for a 3.02 ERA, all career best marks over a 9-game span in a single season...is 1-of-5 pitchers this season to have 50+ strikeouts and 9-or-fewer walks through their first 9 starts...owns a 5.6 K/BB and a 27.1 K% through his first 9 games of 2026, both marks outpacing his a career-high 2.06 K/BB and 16.6 K% recorded in 2025...his 6 quality starts this season already surpass his career high 5 such games set in 2025.

SWING BATTER BATTER SWING...recorded a career high 21 swings and misses in his May 2 start, the most by a Mariners pitcher this season...has 57 whiffs on his 4-seamer, ranking T-3rd in the AL, matching Luis Castillo-SEA and just trailing Bryan Woo-SEA (60).

TRAFFIC CONTROL...his 56 base runners allowed over 53.2 innings in his first 9 starts, are tied for 6th fewest among pitchers in 2026 through their first 9 games (min. 53.0 IP)...owns a baserunners-per-9 of 9.39, ranking 7th in AL in 2026, (min. 45.0 IP)...ranks 13th in WHIP (0.96) with runners on base in the AL in 2026 (min. 15.0 IP) while tying for the 9th fewest runs allowed in runners on situations among AL starting pitchers (min 15.0 IP).

QUALITY CONTROL...has recorded a quality start in 6 of his 9 starts this season...is 1-of-2 pitchers in 2026 to have 5 quality starts with 1-or-fewer walks and 5+ strikeouts (also: Cristopher Sánchez-PHI)...the Mariners are 9-6 when Hancock logs a quality start since 2023 and are 7-4 since the start of 2025.

NO FREE PASSES...is 1-of-7 pitchers this season to have allowed 3-or-fewer walks over 5.0+ IP in each of their first 9 starts, along with George Kirby-SEA...his 4.8 BB% is the 5th best in MLB (min. 50.0 IP)...has contributed 6 starts with 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks to a Mariners pitching staff that leads the league in such games (25) in 2026.

UP TO BIG UNIT STANDARDS...on May 2, followed up Mariners legend Randy Johnson's number retirement ceremony with a performance of his own, setting the single-game high in strikeouts this season with 15 Ks and becoming the 4th player with 14+ strikeouts and no walks allowed in Mariners franchise history, joining Randy Johnson (done 2x), George Kirby (done 2x) and Mark Langston...is 1-of-5 pitchers in MLB to have 14+ strikeouts and no walks since the start of 2023, along with George Kirby (2x, last: 9/14/25), Max Meyer-MIA (4/21/25), Tyler Glasnow-LAD (4/9/24), and Pablo López-MIN (9/10/23)...is the most recent pitcher to record 13+ strikeouts in a game, joining George Kirby (14, 9/14/25 vs. LAA), Bryan Woo (13, 9/13/25 vs. LAA) and Logan Gilbert (13, 8/24/25 vs. ATH) as 4 of the last 5 pitchers in MLB to record 13+ strikeouts in an outing...Max Fried-NYY (13, 9/18/25 at BAL) is the last non Mariner with 13+ SO in a game.
