Two of the National League's top pitchers battled it out in San Francisco, as the Phillies' Cliff Lee and the Giants' **Matt Cain** traded zeroes for a combined 19 innings. **Melky Cabrera** hit an RBI single off Antonio Bastardo in the 11th, scoring **Bronson Belt** from second base to give the Giants a 1-0 victory.

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to secure their third series win of the season with a victory in today's game at Washington...SF has won two straight after snapping its four-game losing streak on Thursday with a win over Cincinnati.

- ▶ This is the third and final stop on the Giants' three-city, 11-day road trip through the east coast...SF is 3-4 on the trip so far, going 1-2 in both Baltimore (last weekend) and Cincinnati (earlier this week) before winning last night's series opener at Washington.
- ▶ SF has won three of its last four series in D.C., which is its second-best series record (3-1) at an NL opponent since 2022, behind only its 4-0 series record at Pittsburgh (*Stats, LLC*).

IS THIS MY HOUSE?: RHP Adrian Houser looks for his first win as a Giant after starting the season 0-2 over his first three starts.

- ▶ In six career games (four starts) vs. the Nats, Houser is 0-1 with a 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip)...the 1.37 ERA is his best vs. any team that he's started three or more games against.
- ▶ Houser's most-used pitch is his sinker (41.1% usage rate)...the pitch has a .323 opposing batting average against this season...the Nationals have a .342 batting average vs. sinkers (second-best in MLB behind Tampa Bay's .360 average).
- ▶ The righty has an ERA of 1.50 (2er, 12.0ip), a 0.83 WHIP, three extra-base hits allowed and a .485 opposing OPS in innings 1-4 this season...from the 5th inning on, he has a 15.75 ERA (7er, 4.0ip), 3.75 WHIP, five XBHs allowed and a 1.276 OPS...the Nationals' .757 OPS in innings 1-4 is fifth-best in MLB.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: The Giants scored a season-high 10 runs in yesterday's win...it was their first game with 10+ runs at Washington since scoring 12 on April 24, 2022.

- ▶ The 10-run outburst moved SF from 30th in MLB in runs to 28th with 68 on the season...the Giants' .248 batting average in 2026 is now ninth in MLB.
- ▶ The Giants hit three homers in yesterday's win after entering with nine on the season.
- ▶ A difference was SF's hits when in favorable counts...the Giants entered yesterday with an .873 OPS when in a hitter's count (29th in MLB)...they went 3-for-8 with a double and a homer in yesterday's game in hitter's counts.

TOP OF THE LINEUP: The Giants' 1-3 hitters in their lineup (**IF Willy Adames**, **IF Luis Arraez** and **IF Matt Chapman**) combined to go 7-for-15 yesterday...this season, SF's 1-3 hitters have a .268 batting average (fourth-best in MLB).

- ▶ Collectively, the Giants' second basemen, third basemen and shortstops have combined for a .282/.323/.419 slash line with the .282 batting average ranking second-best in the Majors (Miami leads with a .303 average).
- ▶ Arraez has hit safely in each of his 12 career games here at Nationals Park, going 26-for-53 (.491) with three homers, 10 RBI and 14 runs scored.
- ▶ He has reached base safely in 20 consecutive games against the Nationals regardless of venue...Arraez is slashing .393/.427/.512 with 17 runs, five extra-base hits, eight RBI and a .939 OPS over that span.

BRING ON THE HEATER: Nationals starter Cade Cavalli's most-used pitch is his four-seam fastball (34.9% usage rate)...opponents are batting .450 (9x20) vs. his 4SFB thus far.

- ▶ The Giants have a .613 OPS vs. four-seamers this season, which is the lowest OPS vs. 4SFB in MLB...SF's three homers vs. four-seamers this season is tied with Tampa Bay for second-fewest in MLB (Boston has one).
- ▶ Cavalli also has a 16.2% walk rate this season, which is fourth-highest in MLB (min. 15.0ip)...the Giants have a 5.7% walk rate this season (30th in MLB).

DAN THE MAN: C Daniel Susac went 2-for-5 with a double last night...in his first nine MLB games he is batting .524 (11x21) with a run, two doubles, a triple, five RBI and a walk.

- ▶ He is one of 16 MLB players since the year 2000 to have 11+ hits in his first 21 at-bats, joining teammate **Casey Schmitt** (also 11 in 2023) (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ Susac is one of five Giants with 11+ hits in his first 21 at-bats since 1901, joining Schmitt, **Jim Davenport** (12 in 1958), **Glenn Adams** (11 in 1975) and **Walter Holke** (11 in 1914).

PEN TO PAPER: The Giants' bullpen has allowed just one earned run over their last four games (0.69 ERA, 13.0ip, 16k, 4bb)...since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 2.33 ERA (7er, 27.0ip) over its last nine games.

- ▶ In the last two games (both wins), the Giants' bullpen has allowed just one hit (a homer) and two walks in 6.0 innings with nine strikeouts.

ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

2026 RECORD: 0-2, 5.06 ERA

YO ADRIAN: Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Received his second loss in three starts to begin the season...allowed four runs on five hits and two walks across 4.2 innings at Baltimore on April 12.

AGAINST THE NATIONALS: Despite zero wins in six career games (four starts) vs. the Nationals, his 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip) is his best vs. any team that he's started three or more games against...has a career 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip) here at Nationals Park...last season he allowed one run on six hits and three walks while striking out four across 4.0 innings at Washington on August 25 with Tampa Bay.

SINK OR SWIM: Houser's sinker had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*, which is the pitch's best mark since it had a +23 run value in 2021...so far in 2026, opponents are batting .323 (10x31) vs. his sinker...the Nationals are batting .342 vs. sinkers this season, which is the second-best batting average vs. sinkers this season behind only Tampa Bay's .360 mark.

DAY MAN: Has been much better in day games than in night games over his career...since the start of last season he has a 2.72 ERA (18er, 59.2ip) in 10 day games compared to a 4.09 ERA (37er, 81.1ip) in 14 night games.

LEFT ON READ: Lefties slashed .274/.356/.456 (.812 OPS) vs. Houser in 2025, while righties slashed .249/.293/.320 (.612 OPS)... in 2026, lefties are slashing .382/.432/.647 (1.079) in 34 at-bats compared to righties slashing .200/.243/.229 (.472) in 35 at-bats.

EARLY BIRD: He has an ERA of 1.50 (2er, 12.0ip), a 0.83 WHIP, three extra-base hits allowed and a .485 opposing OPS in innings 1-4 this season...from the 5th inning on, he has a 15.75 ERA (7er, 4.0ip), 3.75 WHIP, five XBHs allowed and a 1.276 OPS.

CACTUS LEAGUE: Went 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP over three Cactus League starts...also made an exhibition start vs. Team USA.

2025 RECAP: Had a well-traveled 2025...he originally pitched in Spring Training with Texas on an MiLB deal...after not making the Rangers out of camp, he pitched nine games (eight starts) with Triple-A Round Rock before opting out of his contract to sign an MLB deal with Chicago-AL...he promptly went 6-2 with a 2.10 ERA (16er, 68.2ip) with the White Sox before being traded to the Rays at the deadline...he went 2-3 with a 4.79 ERA (30er, 56.1ip) in 10 starts to end the season with Tampa Bay.

ROBBIE RAY LHP #38

2026 RECORD: 2-2, 2.42 ERA

- ▶ Took the loss in the Giants 2-1 loss at Cincinnati on April 14...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on two hits (both home runs) and four walks with six strikeouts
- ▶ Ray has gone at least 5.0 innings with at least four strikeouts while not allowing more than two runs in each of his first four appearances, which is the longest such stretch to start a season of his career.
- ▶ Is 3-5 with a 5.21 ERA over his nine career outings against Washington, however, he has faced them just twice since 2020 and gone 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (2er, 12.2ip), 14 strikeouts and a 0.55 WHIP in those games.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper
Last Game: 4/15 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-13 (.154) with two walks and four strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (69-for-382) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-14 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 4/15 at CIN; 2.0ip, 2h, bb, 2k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's first 20 games and tossed 2.0 innings three times.
- ▶ Has allowed runs in one of his eight games and has issued at least one walk in six of eight contests (eight walks in 10.1ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-25 (.360) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-12 (.083).
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter
Last Game: 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, h, r, er, k, hr (15 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed a homer to James Wood on Friday night, the first homer he'd allowed in 41.0 MLB innings dating to June 11, 2023.
- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's 20 games, tossing 8.1-innings.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, bb, 2k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 8.0 innings with 12 strikeouts and five walks in nine games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

#60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup
Last Game: 4/16 at CIN; SV, 1.0ip, bb, 3k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Struck out three batters in the 9th Thursday at Cincinnati to record his first career save.
- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's 19 games, allowing four runs in 6.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 51.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fifth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter
Last Game: 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, hbp (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in five of his six outings (2er, 8.0ip) and posted a 0.75 WHIP.
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with **RHP José Buttó** being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants **MGR Tony Vitello** while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside **RHP José Buttó** and **OF Drew Gilbert** in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 4/16 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's first 20 games.
- ▶ Batters are 2-for-14 in ABs that end with his slider and 4-for-13 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider last season.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 4/16 at CIN; 1.0ip, 2k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Seven of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Traditionally has been somewhat of a slow starter but his 13 XBH in March/April have surpassed his career-best 11 from March/April 2024 (29 games).
- ▶ His 145 home runs as a shortstop since 2021 are most in the Majors ahead of NYM's Francisco Lindor (140).

#1 LUIS ARRAEZ ▶ IF

(ah-RISE)

- ▶ Has struck out just four times over his first 72 at-bats..hasn't K'ed in his last 29 PAs dating to Apr 8, the longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Approaching 300 career multi-hit games (he's at 297).
- ▶ Hit safely in 14 of his first 19 games this season (.319 AVG).
- ▶ Slashing .400/.432/.536 (.968 OPS) in 30 career games vs. Washington...here at Nationals Park, he is 26-for-53 (.491) with three HRs and 10 RBI in 12 career games.
- ▶ Has a hit in each of his 12 career games at Nationals Park.
- ▶ Owns a +1 DRS in 153.0 innings so far in 2026...was -2 DRS in 82.0 innings there last season with San Diego.
