NEW YORK METS (48-36) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (34-50)
June 29, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 1:35 EDT - Game #85/Home #44

THE PIRATES: have won each of the first two games on this six-game homestand, including a 9-2 win vs. the Mets on Saturday...Are 14-11 against the National League East (12-3 at home)...Have gone 42-34 all-time against the Mets here at PNC Park...Are 22-24 since Don Kelly took over as manager on May 8 (21 of those have been one-run games).

RHP Frankie Montas (0-0, 0.00 ERA) vs. RHP Mike Burrows (1-2, 4.45 ERA)

ON DECK: The Pirates will close out their six-game homestand with a three-game series vs. St. Louis, beginning on Monday...It's the second and final visit for the Cardinals to PNC Park this season...Pittsburgh took two of three games vs. St. Louis here at PNC Park during the first homestand of the season (April 7-9), but was swept in a three-game series from May 5-7 at Busch Stadium.

<u>CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET</u>: The Pirates will look to complete their second series sweep of the season this afternoon (they also swept Philadelphia in a three-game series from June 6-8 here at PNC Park)...Their last sweep of the Mets came from August 14-16, 2015 (three games) at Citi Field...Pittsburgh's last sweep of New York at PNC Park came that same season (May 22-24, three games).

BE LIKE MIKE: Mike Burrows will make his eighth appearance (seventh start) of the season this afternoon...He tossed 2.1 scoreless innings of relief in his last appearance on Wednesday afternoon at Milwaukee...Burrows has posted a 2.86 ERA (22.0ip/7er) in his five appearances (four starts) this month...That's the third-lowest ERA among all Major League rookies with at least 22.0 innings pitched this month...The only rookies with a lower ERA are the Athletics' Jacob Lopez (1.98) and the Yankees' Will Warren (2.86).

HOME COOKIN': The Pirates are 15-9 at PNC Park since Don Kelly made his managerial debut on May 9 vs. Atlanta...The 15 home wins during that time are tied for the fifth-most in all of MLB...Only Houston (20), Tampa

Bay (18), Detroit (16) and New York-NL (16) have more wins at home during that stretch.

THE ARMS RACE: The Pirates enter today's series finale against the Mets with a 3.55 ERA in the month of June, the sixth-lowest mark in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Houston (3.05), New York-AL (3.07), Philadelphia (3.22), Milwaukee (3.28) and Texas (3.49).

TAKING OFFENSE: Pittsburgh has scored at least nine runs in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also May 27-28 at Arizona)...The last time the Pirates did that in three straight games came from August 29-31, 2019 at Colorado (last time they did it in three straight home games came from April 18-May 4, 1992)...Since June 22 vs. Texas, Pittsburgh is hitting .307 (65-for-212) with 36 runs scored (average of 6.0 runs per game).

CALL TO THE 'PEN: Four Pirates relievers combined to allow a run over the final 7.1 innings on Saturday vs. New York (NL) after starter Bailey Falter did not return following a rain delay of 1 hour and 29 minutes...In its last 10 games (since the June 19 doubleheader at Detroit), Pittsburgh's bullpen has a 2.23 ERA (44.1ip/11er), the lowest mark in MLB during that span.

LOCK IN, KE': Ke'Bryan Hayes went 2-for-4 with a pair of RBI and a run scored on Saturday vs. New York (NL), extending his hitting streak to seven consecutive games (since game two of the June 19 doubleheader at Detroit)... During the streak, Hayes is batting .417 (10-for-24) with six RBI and five runs.

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Spencer Horwitz went 1-for-3 with a walk and two runs scored in Saturday's victory vs. New York (NL), extending his career-high on-base streak to 15 games (since June 9 vs. Miami)...It's the longest-such streak by a Pirate since Andrew McCutchen also reached in 15 straight games last season from July 28-September 2...It's the sixth-longest active streak in Major League Baseball...Horwitz has hit safely in 13 of 15 games during the streak, going 17-for-54 (.315) with six doubles, five RBI, six walks and 11 runs.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

<u>June 29, 1977</u>: Willie Stargell connected off Eric Rasmussen for his 400th career home run in Pittsburgh's 9-1 win over the Cardinals in St. Louis. The Pirates built a 5-0 lead on the strength of a two-run home run by Bill Robinson in the first inning and Stargell's two-run blast in the fifth inning. Bruce Kison allowed one run over 7.0 innings and earned his sixth win of the season.

AGE: 25 (turns 26 on November 8) **SIGNED:** Thru 2025 **HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected in the 11th round of the 2018 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Burrows faced seven batters as a reliever on Wednesday afternoon at Milwaukee, tossing 2.1 scoreless innings (was his second career relief appearance).

LAST START: Burrows allowed four runs on seven hits (two home runs) and one walk across his 4.2 innings on June 20 vs. Texas, losing a 6-2 decision (had four strikeouts).

START ME UP: Burrows earned his first win as a starter in the Major Leagues, pitching 5.1 innings while striking out six batters en route to a 3-0 win on June 4 vs. Houston at PNC Park...lt was tied for the second-longest outing of Burrows' professional career (also July 7, 2021 for High-A Greensboro vs. Asheville), trailing only an outing of 7.0 scoreless innings for Double-A Altoona on May 26, 2022 at Harrisburg...Burrows became one of just 10 Pittsburgh rookies (11 instances) since at least 1901 to pitch 5.1-plus scoreless innings with six-plus strikeouts while issuing zero walks in an outing.

IN THE SHOW: Burrows will make his seventh start of the season with Pittsburgh this afternoon...He allowed a combined nine runs over 8.1 total innings in his first two starts, which came on May 22 vs. Milwaukee and May 27 at Arizona...Over his last four starts, dating back to June 4 vs. Houston, he has gone 1-1 with a 3.20 ERA (19.2ip/7er).

RISPY BUSINESS: Burrows has limited opposing hitters to a .150 batting average against (3-for-20) with runners in scoring position...Over his last four starts (since June 4 vs. Houston), Burrows has allowed just one hit in 13 at-bats with runners in scoring position (it was a single from Miami's Xavier Edwards in the fifth inning on June 9).

DEBUT DAY: Burrows made his MLB debut in relief of Paul Skenes last season on September 28 at Yankee Stadium...In that game, he earned the win, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits, three walks, two strikeouts and one home run in 3.1 innings...He was recalled from Triple-A Indianapolis this April 24, but did not pitch before being optioned back to Triple-A after the team's April 25 victory in Los Angeles.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Burrows went 2-1 with a 2.51 ERA (32.1ip/9er) and 41 strikeouts over his eight appearances (seven starts) at Triple-A Indianapolis...At the time of his promotion to Pittsburgh on May 21, Burrows ranked second in the International League with a 1.02 ERA, 28 strikeouts and a 0.85 WHIP, as well as third with a .175 batting average against, in the month of May (four games/three starts).

TALK OF THE TOWN: Burrows is currently rated as the Pirates' No. 13 prospect, according to Baseball America (No. 15, according to MLB Pipeline)...Burrows has been a top-30 prospect for Pittsburgh, per Baseball America, in every preseason since 2020.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE: Burrows represented Pittsburgh at the 2022 All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium...He pitched a scoreless fifth inning in the National League's 6-4, seven-inning win, allowing a hit and a walk (one strikeout)...He was the first Connecticut native to be selected to the game since George Springer (2013).

THE BURROWS FILE: Burrows was drafted by Pittsburgh in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford High School (Waterford, Connecticut)... Burrows has a 3.58 ERA (291.1ip/116er) in 78 career minor-league outings (73 starts).
