Matt Olson

Lined a 1-2 pitch out to right in last night's 10th inning for a three-run homer, his team-leading 27th home run of the year. His 27 total homers rank seventh in the majors.

However, seven of his 27 homers on the year have come in the ninth inning or later (25.9%), two more than any other player in the majors.

The Atlanta-franchise record for home runs in the ninth inning or later in a single season is eight, set by Andruw Jones in 2005. Jones will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame tomorrow.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Orioles tonight continue a three-game weekend series with what are the only scheduled games between the two teams this year... The two are meeting for the sixth time in the last seven seasons, and for the fourth consecutive year.

 Atlanta rallied from a two-run deficit to beat Baltimore in extra innings, 7-6, last night to take the opening game of the series.

 Baltimore swept all three games against Atlanta last season at Truist Park, and the Braves were just 1-5 versus the Orioles from 2024-2025...That was Atlanta's worst record versus any American League club in that span.

 Atlanta dropped two-of-three in its last visit here to Oriole Park at Camden Yards in 2024, but is 14-11 (.560) in 25 total games played in this park...The Braves have, however, dropped four of their last five series here dating to 2009, with a three-game sweep in 2021 standing as the only series win.

 Atlanta and Baltimore have played 58 total games since the advent of interleague play in 1997 and have split them down the middle, with each club winning 29 contests.

 RH Bryce Elder is set tonight to make the second start of his career against Baltimore, after tossing 5.1 one-run innings in a no-decision on May 7, 2023... The 6-foot-2, 220-pound Texan went 6.0+ innings in his last turn, July 20 vs. San Diego, and allowed just two runs to earn his sixth win of the season... The victory snapped a three-game losing streak that spanned four total turns.

 RH Brandon Young makes the 29th start of his career tonight, and faces Atlanta for the first time... The 6-foot-6, 210-pound Texan tossed 7.0 one-run innings in his most recent start, July 19 at Houston, and Baltimore is 13-3 over his 16 total starts this year.

HOMERS: Atlanta tied the game with a solo home run in last night's eighth inning and used a three-run shot in the 10th to break it open...The Braves' 17 total homers since the All-Star break are tied with the Padres for the most in the majors.

 Each of Atlanta's six home runs over the last two games have come from left-handed batters, and the club's 90 total homers from the left side of the plate trail just Washington (98) this season...Drake Baldwin (x2), Matt Olson, Michael Harris II, Ozzie Albies and Dominic Smith have all homered for the Braves in the last two games.

 Both of Atlanta's homers last night came in two-strike counts, and the club's 49 total two-strike home runs this season are most in the National League and behind just Houston (50) in baseball.

 Atlanta improved to 33-7 (.825) this season when hitting at least two home runs following last night's victory...The Braves have won four straight games when doing so.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Drove a 1-2 pitch in last night's eighth inning out to right to secure the first 20-homer campaign of his career...He hit 19 home runs during his Rookie of the Year-winning season last year.

 He is one of just four primary catchers this season to eclipse 20 home runs, joining Colorado's Hunter Goodman (31), the A's Shea Langeliers (23) and Detroit's Dillon Dingler (22).

 This year marks the first 20-homer season by a Braves catcher since Sean Murphy totaled 21 in 2023...Baldwin is on pace for 31 homers on the season, which would stand as the fifth most by a backstop in franchise history.

 Baldwin has reached base safely in 20 of his 38 plate appearances since the All-Star break, collecting 14 hits and six walks and batting .438/.526/.906 in total...His .526 on-base percentage since the break ranks second among qualified batters in baseball.

AUSTIN RILEY: Once again tallied the game's hardest-hit ball last night, lining a run-scoring single up the middle at 109.5 mph in the top of the fourth...Also singled at 100.7 mph in the seventh.

 Riley has the game's hardest-hit ball, regardless of team, in four of Atlanta's eight games since the All-Star break...In the other four games, he twice has the second hardest-hit ball of the game, and twice has the third-hardest.

 Twelve of Riley's last 17 balls in play have left the bat over 100 miles per hour, and 13 of the 17 have qualified as "hard hit"...His hard-hit percentage of 71.5% since the break ranks third among all qualified batters in baseball.

ERASING HOLES: Atlanta trailed, 2-0, after last night's second inning and again, 3-2, after the fourth... The Braves ultimately tied the game in the eighth and won it in the 10th.

 The Braves are now 31-41 (.431) when trailing at any point in a game this season, and 17-35 (.327) when losing by multiple runs...Only the Dodgers, at 19-30 (.388), have been better when facing such a deficit.

 For context, the major league winning percentage when down by multiple runs this season is just .193 (321-1343).

RUN, DON'T WALK: Atlanta scored seven runs across 10 innings in a win last night, but did so without the benefit of a base on balls...All 11 Braves reached via base hit.

 Last night's win marked the eighth this season for the Braves when they did not work a walk, by far the most such wins in baseball...The Reds, Red Sox and Guardians are all tied for second, with four.

 Atlanta's seven runs last night were its most in a walk-less game since a 7-5 win over the Mets on June 7, 2023.

Makes his 20th start of the season and the 98th of his career, in the middle game of a three-game series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...Atlanta is 11-8 in his 19 turns.
- 🔥

Makes his second career appearance against Baltimore and his first at Camden Yards...His only prior look came at Truist Park on May 7, 2023, a no-decision in which he allowed one run on four hits and four walks over 5.1 innings of a 3-2, 12-inning Atlanta win.
- 🔥

Earned the win July 20 against San Diego, permitting two runs on five hits with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a 3-2 victory...It was his first career win against the Padres...Makes his first road start since July 9 at Pittsburgh.
- 🔥

Works on four days' rest for the first time since June 7...Is 10-10 with a 3.58 ERA (86 ER/216.0 IP) and a 1.21 WHIP in 37 career starts on that turnaround, holding opponents to a .228 average...Is 11-7 with a 4.39 ERA (77 ER/158.0 IP) in 28 starts on five days and 9-13 with a 5.60 ERA (104 ER/167.0 IP) in 32 starts on six or more days, when opponents have hit .289...His two most recent outings came on 11 days of rest (July 9) and 10 days (July 20).

Carries a 6-6 record and a 4.06 ERA (49 ER/108.2 IP) through 19 starts...Has posted a 90-to-33 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 1.23 WHIP this season.
- 🔥

Has pitched to a 7.65 ERA (34 ER/40.0 IP) over his last eight outings, after opening the year with a 1.97 ERA (15 ER/68.2 IP) across his first 11 turns.
- 🔥

Has recorded 11 quality starts in 19 outings this season...Eight of them have come at Truist Park, where he is 4-2 with a 3.31 ERA (25 ER/68.0 IP) in 11 turns.
- 🔥

Left-handed batters are hitting .205 (53-for-259) with nine home runs against him this season, the 10th-lowest opponent average against lefties among qualified right-handed pitchers...Right-handers are batting .306 (48-for-157) with eight homers.
- 🔥

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this season after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25.
- 🔥

Throws it almost exclusively to lefties, who have seen 213 of the 239 cutters he has delivered.
- 🔥

Opponents are batting .179 (10-for-56) in at-bats ending on the offering, the fourth-lowest mark against the pitch among the 42 starting pitchers who have thrown at least 200 cutters this season.
- 🔥

Opponents are batting .210 (57-for-271) against him with the bases empty and .303 (44-for-145) with men on base...Thirty-eight of the 49 earned runs he has allowed have scored with a runner aboard.
- 🔥

Has held hitters to a .183 average (33-for-180) once he reaches two strikes.
- 🔥

Eleven of the 17 home runs he has surrendered this season have come in the second through fourth innings.
- 🔥

Is 5-3 with a 3.73 ERA (29 ER/70.0 IP) in 12 night starts this season, against a 1-3 mark and a 4.66 ERA (20 ER/38.2 IP) in seven day games.
- 🔥

Over his last 26 starts, dating to August 24 of last season, Elder is 9-8 with a 3.70 ERA (63 ER/153.1 IP) and a 1.16 WHIP...His 17 quality starts over the span are tied for the fourth-most in the majors, trailing only Miami's Sandy Alcantara (20), Los Angeles' (NL) Yoshinobu Yamamoto (19) and Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (18).

Since the start of the 2023 season, Atlanta is 49-39 in Elder's starts...His 88 starts for the Braves over the span lead the staff.

Earned the win July 20 against San Diego, allowing two runs on five hits with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a 3-2 win at Truist Park...It was his first career victory against the Padres in his third start against the club.

🔥

The outing snapped a run of four consecutive starts allowing at least four runs, tied for the longest such stretch of his career.

🔥

Surrendered multiple home runs for a third straight start July 20, matching the longest run of his career (August 6, 2024-April 11, 2025).

🔥

Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 15 of his 19 starts this season.

🔥

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts.

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.

🔥

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.

🔥

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson ('20-'21) each had five such starts.

🔥

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.
