THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

SEPT. 18

2019 - Many milestones are reached in the Astros 3-2 victory over the Rangers at Daikin Park...first, the win clinches a post-season berth for the Astros and gives the team 100 victories for the third consecutive season...secondly, **RHP Gerrit Cole** tallies 10 strikeouts in the game to reach 300 on the season, joining **RHP J.R. Richard** and **RHP Mike Scott** as the only Astros to reach that total in strikeouts...**RHP Justin Verlander** would also reach 300 later that season.

TONIGHT'S GAME: With just nine games remaining on their schedule, the first-place Astros will welcome in the Braves for their final home series of the 2026 regular season...**RHP Peter Lambert** (8-9) will make his penultimate start of the season for the Astros tonight opposite **RHP Tyler Mahle** (6-10) and the Braves.

THE POSTSEASON CHASE: The Astros and Rangers are locked in a tight race down the stretch for the AL West with the two teams entering play today separated by just one game...the Astros own the tiebreaker over the Rangers with a season series victory (9-4 record).

CHALLENGING STRETCH: The Astros are within a stretch of playing 13 of 16 games against opponents with winning records (CWS, ARI, PHI, TB, ATL), going 6-7 so far in those contests...on the season, the Astros are 28-21 against teams with .500 or better records, the third-best mark in the Majors, immediately ahead of the Braves (35-28).

OLD RIVALS: The Astros and Braves are longtime rivals, having played each other 720 times in the regular season and another 25 times in the post-season...the Braves dominated the Astros early in their playoff matchups, in 1997, 1999 and 2001, before the Astros broke through in 2004 and 2005...the two teams matched up again in the 2021 Fall Classic, won by the Braves in six games.

DUBIE!: The Astros are happy to welcome back Braves **IF/OF Mauricio Dubón**, who'll be recognized with a pregame video tonight...Dubón, a 2022 World Series Champion, played parts of four seasons (2022-25) with the Astros, appearing in 485 regular season games with Houston.

HISPANIC HERITAGE WEEKEND: The Astros are celebrating **Hispanic Heritage Weekend** starting tonight...the ballpark will come alive with Latin music, vibrant festivities, and cultural pride all weekend long...as part of the celebration, 10,000 fans in attendance will receive a **Jeremy Peña Retro Los Astros Jersey**, presented by PNC.

POSTSEASON CREDENTIALS: All media who wish to cover potential Astros postseason home games in the Wild Card Series and ALDS must apply for credentials on MLB's credentialing system...the events are now open with a deadline set for Sunday, Sept. 27...ALCS and World Series credential applications are also live online.

LAST NIGHT'S BIG WIN: The Astros hammered a season-high five home runs in their 6-2 win in the rubber game of their three-game series with the Royals last night...**SS Jeremy Peña** started the home run barrage with a leadoff homer and was later joined by **CF Daulton Varsho**, **1B LaMonte Wade Jr.**, **DH Yordan Alvarez** and **RF Taylor Trammell**, who all hit solo shots...**RHP Ethan Pecko** (1ER/5.2IP) pitched great as the bulk reliever, allowing just three hits in his outing.

GOIN' DEEP: The Astros have hit 206 homers as a team this year and have hit 200-plus homers in a single season for the 10th time in franchise history (last, 222 HR in 2023)...the Astros rank second in the AL in home runs this season behind only the Yankees (209).

TRIPLE THREAT: **DH Yordan Alvarez**, who is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award, currently ranks first or second in the AL in all three **Triple Crown** categories...he enters today leading the AL in batting avg. (.311), while ranking second in HR (40) and RBI (99)...Alvarez also leads the Majors in OPS (1.027), SLG (.598) and OBP (.429)...since **Carl Yastrzemski** won the AL Triple Crown in 1967, there has been just one Triple Crown winner in the Majors, **Miguel Cabrera** in 2012 (AL):

BIG NUMBERS: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit his 40th homer of the season last night, marking the eighth time an Astro has hit 40-plus homers in a single season in club history...he's also up to 99 RBI on the season and is looking to post the 29th 100-RBI season in Astros history...Alvarez's career high in RBI is 104, which he reached in 2021.

LEADING MAN: **SS Jeremy Peña** hit his sixth leadoff home run of the season last night, and the 11th of his career, a total that ranks fifth in Astros history...he ranks tied for second in the AL in leadoff home runs this season, trailing only the Rangers **DH Joc Pederson** (7).

NOTHING FINER THAN YAINER: **C Yainer Diaz** is hitting .362 (17x47) in the month of September with two homers, five RBI and a .932 OPS...Diaz has multiple hits in seven if his 12 starts this month.

STALKING 200: **1B Christian Walker** is currently sitting on 199 career home runs and needs just one homer to become the 35th active Major League player to reach 200 career long balls...Walker has hit 25 homers this year for his fifth consecutive 25-plus homer season (2022-26).

STARTING STRONG: In their last 13 home games, Astros starting pitchers have combined for a 2.40 ERA (17ER/63.2IP), while allowing two-or-fewer runs in 11 of those contests...additionally, Astros starters have posted a 3.28 ERA (43ER/118IP) in their last 25 games dating back to Aug. 21.

THE LAMBO: **RHP Peter Lambert** has been the most consistent starter for the Astros this season, as he leads the club in wins (8), starts (26), innings pitched (145.2) and strikeouts (141)...he's allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 18 of his 26 starts on the year and has done so in 10 of his last 13 starts.

THE FIREMAN: **LHP Josh Hader** has converted 26 consecutive save opportunities to open his season, which is the Astros club record...should Hader finish the season without a blown save, he would become the seventh pitcher in MLB history to post 26-plus saves without a blown save and the first to do so since **RHP Ken Giles** in 2018 (26 SV).

LAST START, SEPT. 12 at TB: Notched his 2nd consecutive quality start last Saturday at TB, allowing 3 runs on 6 hits through 6.0 innings while striking out 4 without surrendering a walk...marked the 5th start of his career (and 4th this season) in which he's tossed 6.0+ innings without surrendering a walk, also doing so in his previous start on Sept. 6 vs. ARI (7.0 IP).

THE LAMBO: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...was re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and started the season at Triple A....made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for the Space Cowboys, recording a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent average...was selected to the Major League roster on April 17...since joining the Astros rotation, he's recorded a 3.71 ERA (60ER/145.2IP) with 141 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP and a .225 opponent average in 26 starts....leads the Astros rotation in quality starts with 10, next closest is **RHP Hunter Brown** (7 QS)...he also leads the Astros in strikeouts and innings pitched...among AL pitchers, he ranks 12th in opponent OPS (.649) and 14th in opponent batting average (min. 130IP).

CAREER YEAR: Has already set single-season career highs in wins (8), strikeouts (141), starts (26) and innings (145.2)...including his time at Triple A, he's tossed 160.1 innings this season, which is a new career-high...his previous professional single-season career high of 148.0 innings was set in 2018, where he spent time at the Triple A and Double A levels in the Rockies system.

NO FREEBIES: Has not allowed a walk in his last 13.0 innings, spanning his last 2 starts...is his 2nd-longest walkless streak of the season...also went 13.1 consecutive innings without a walk from June 10-17, which is the longest streak by an Astro this season and the longest of his career.

VS. ATL: In 3 career apps. (1 start) vs. the Braves, he's posted a 2.89 ERA (3ER/9.1IP)...made his lone career start vs. ATL on Aug. 29, 2023 at Coors Field (3ER/5IP).

REVERSE SPLIT: Has held LHH to a .195 opponent avg. (56x287)...is the 4th-lowest opponent avg. by a RHP vs. LHH among AL pitchers this season (min. 200 AB).

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .158 average on the pitch (9x57)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

LAST APPEARANCE (9/17 vs. KC): Struck out the lone batter he faced last night vs. KC to record the final out of the 8th inning and pick up his 16th hold of the season.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 6-2-7 with a 2.15 ERA (12ER/50.1IP)...also has recorded 62 strikeouts, a 1.07 WHIP and a .171 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...among AL relievers since May 3 (min. 50 IP), he ranks 5th in opponent batting average and 5th in SO/9 (11.09).

VS. ATL: Has been scoreless and allowed just 1 hit through 5 career apps. vs. ATL (5.1 IP), also striking out 5.

ASTROS RANKINGS: Enters tonight with 526 career strikeouts and is 3 strikeouts from matching RHP Dave Smith (529) for the 3rd-most by a reliever in Astros history.
