BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore opened a three-game series in Kansas City with a comeback win last night at Kauffman Stadium, using a five-run 12th inning for a 7-5 victory...Seven of the 11 victories have been with the team trailing at some point, including three when trailing in the seventh inning or later...The series with the Royals continues through Wednesday before the Orioles enjoy an off day on Thursday...The club can even the road trip tonight after dropping three of four in Cleveland over the weekend.

♫ **Leody Taveras** hit his first career grand slam in the 12th inning...Marked the second grand slam by an Oriole this season (also Jackson, 4/13 vs. AZ) and the first by an Oriole in extra innings since Pedro Álvarez in the 14th inning on April 6, 2018 at New York-AL.

♫ **Samuel Basallo** reached base a career-high four times (2 H, 2 BB)...At 21 years, 250 days old, Basallo became the fourth-youngest Oriole (since 1954) with a go-ahead RBI in the 12th inning or later behind Manny Machado (20-069, 9/13/12 vs. TB, 14th), Brooks Robinson (20-350, 5/3/58 vs. CLE, 13th), and Eddie Murray (21-086, 5/21/77 at NYY, 12th).

♫ **Anthony Nunez** earned his first MLB win.

♫ Orioles pitching stranded 16 Royals on base, tied for the most by the team since 2009... The last time an O's opponent left 16 runners on base was May 20, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay.

♫ The five runs in the 12th inning are the most in extras by Baltimore since April 11, 2024 at Boston (6, 10th) and the most in the 12th inning or later since June 25, 1970 at Boston (6, 14th).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles reinstated catcher **Adley Rutschman** (left ankle inflammation) from the 10-day Injured List and designated catcher **Sam Huff** for assignment.

♫ Prior to Rutschman being placed on the IL on April 11, he was tied for second in the AL and third in the majors with six doubles.

ACTION JACKSON: Since the beginning of the previous homestand on April 10, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .349/.364/.744 (15-for-43) with two doubles, five homers, seven runs scored, 13 RBI, and one walk in 11 games...During that time, he's tied for second in the majors in RBI with LAA's Mike Trout, behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (14), tied for second in hits with HOU's Yordan Alvarez, LAD's Max Muncy, and ATH's Jacob Wilson, trailing TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (18), and third with 32 total bases behind Alvarez and Muncy (both 37).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 21 of the last 22 games since March 28 while slashing .307/.410/.477 (27-for-88) with 12 doubles, one homer, 11 runs scored, 11 RBI, 15 walks, and one hit by pitch during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

♫ His 12 doubles lead the majors ahead of SF's Willy Adames and ATL's Matt Olson (both 10)...The 12 doubles are tied for the most in an Orioles first 23 games of a season in team history (since 1954) along with Jose Iglesias in 2020.

♫ Ward has faced 469 total pitches this season, fourth in the majors behind SEA's Cal Raleigh (477), and Gunnar Henderson and LAA's Zach Neto (both 474).

LEAVE IT TO LEODY: **Leody Taveras** is batting .368/.489/.605 (14-for-38) with three doubles, two home runs, eight runs scored, 12 RBI, nine walks, and one stolen base as a starter this season...He's 1-for-6 with one RBI off the bench this year.

♫ Taveras has hit safely in seven straight starts since April 12 and in 11 of 12 starts overall this season.

♫ He's recorded 13 RBI in 19 games (54 PA) this season after tallying 17 RBI in 58 games (180 PA) last year between Texas and Seattle.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has yet to allow a hit in a career-high 11 straight appearances (11.0 IP) to open the season, the longest active stretch in the majors and the longest season-opening hitless streak by a Baltimore pitcher in team history...Garcia has recorded 33 outs without giving up a hit, tied for the longest hitless streak to begin a season by an Oriole in the expansion era (since 1961) with **Yennier Cano** in 2023, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The last MLB pitcher with a longer such stretch was HOU's Ronel Blanco (44) in 2024.

♫ Garcia has also stranded all seven inherited runners, only the second pitcher in MLB history to begin a season with 11+ scoreless appearances of no hits and no inherited runners scored along with TB's Scott Aldred, who did so in 11 straight from April 8-May 1, 1999.

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks third in the AL with a 3.40 ERA behind the Rangers (2.91) and Mariners (3.38), though relievers have allowed 11 runs (5 ER) in the last four games (15.2 IP) and 19 runs (12 ER) in the last nine games (32.1 IP).

♫ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on Friday night...It was most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

WALK IT OUT: The Birds have drawn 4+ walks in 16 games this season, the most such games in the majors ahead of the Cubs, Twins, and White Sox (all 15).

♫ Baltimore has drawn at least four free passes in 11 of the last 13 games.

♫ Despite ranking sixth in the AL and eighth in MLB with 96 walks this year, the Orioles have drawn 96 free passes in the first 23 games of a season for the first time since 2004 (97).

THE ROYAL GUARD: The Orioles and Royals are meeting for the first of two series this season this week at Kauffman Stadium...Kansas City visits Oriole Park from July 10-12...According to *Stats Perform*, the last 21 O's road games against the Royals have been decided by two or more runs, the longest active such streak by any MLB team on the road against an opponent.

♫ Royals Hall of Famer **Whitey Herzog**, who managed Kansas City from 1975-79, played more games for the Orioles than any other team, appearing in 212 games with Baltimore from 1961-62.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his fifth start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Baz suffered his second consecutive loss on April 16 at Cleveland after tossing a season-high 6.0 innings, permitting four runs on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with a season-high six strikeouts...Threw a season-high-tying 99 pitches (also 4/10 vs. SF), 62 strikes.

👉 José Ramírez took him deep for a two-run homer in the first frame...A two-out single by Steven Kwan put the Guardians ahead, 3-0, in the fifth frame...His final run allowed came via a George Valera single in the sixth inning.

THE K: Baz has made two career starts against the Royals, going 1-1 with a 4.61 ERA (7 ER/13.2 IP).

👉 In his lone career start at Kansas City on June 26, 2025, Baz tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts.

👉 In 10 career starts opposite the AL Central, Baz is 2-6 with a 6.88 ERA (41 ER/53.2 IP), his highest figure against any division ahead of the NL Central (5.30).

FOUR-SEAM FOCUS: Opponents are hitting .429 (9-for-21) with four doubles and one home run off Baz's four seamer this season, tied for the third-highest opponent batting average in the majors (min. 20 AB ending in pitch) ahead of WSH's Cade Cavalli (.519) and LAD's Emmet Sheehan (.450).

👉 His expected opponent batting average on the heater, however, is .304, compared to that of Cavalli (.354) and Sheehan (.393).

👉 Last season with Tampa Bay, Baz held batters to a .244 clip (53-for-217) on the offering while throwing it 43.9 percent of the time.

RIGHT SIDE STORY: Over his first two starts, Baz limited right-handed hitters to a 1-for-17 (.059) clip, the lone hit being a double by MIN's Byron Buxton on March 29.

👉 In his last outing at Cleveland, righties went 0-3 for with a strikeout.

👉 On April 10 vs. San Francisco, however, righties went 6-for-14 with three doubles and one home run...The three doubles allowed to right-handed hitters matched a career high, joining May 1, 2025 vs. Kansas City.

NO APRIL FOOL: He has made eight career starts in the month of April, going 3-2 with a 3.13 ERA (16 ER/46.0 IP) while limiting opponents to a .666 OPS...In six career starts in May, Baz is 1-3 with a 7.26 ERA (25 ER/31.0 IP) and a 1.001 opponent OPS.

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 2-for-12 (.167) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

👉 Baz has allowed hitters to go 9-for-16 (.563) with four doubles on the first pitch of an at-bat.

👉 He has limited opponents to a .226 (7-for-31) mark the first time through the lineup, compared to a combined 19-for-55 (.345) clip the second and third time through.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on April 17 at Cleveland after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering four hits and four walks with two strikeouts...Marked his first start of 5.0+ scoreless innings since July 18, 2025 vs. San Francisco (W, 6.1 IP, 10 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).

vs. KANSAS CITY: Has made eight career starts opposite the Royals, going 1-2 with a 3.60 ERA (18 ER/45.0 IP)...Last faced Kansas City as a member of Toronto on August 3, 2025 at Rogers Centre and did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on one hit with three walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings.
