AROUND THE HORN

SERPIENTES REPLICA JERSEY AND POSTGAME FIREWORKS: Tonight, Postgame Fireworks return with music from My Chemical Romance and Jimmy Eat World to celebrate their upcoming concert at Chase Field on September 6...tomorrow, the first 25,000 fans can get a Serpientes Replica Jersey courtesy of Talking Stick Resort.

AHMED, JACKSON, KENNEDY AND ZIEGLER TO PARTICIPATE IN HALL OF FAME MILITARY CLASSIC: Tomorrow, former D-back players **Nick Ahmed, Edwin Jackson, Ian Kennedy** and **Brad Ziegler** will participate in The Hall of Fame Military Classic presented by New Era at historic Doubleday Field in Cooperstown, a 7.0-inning legends game featuring Hall of Famers and 24 former big league stars during Memorial Day Weekend festivities that will honor baseball's longstanding connection to the military.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won a season-high 5 straight games...last had 6 straight wins twice in 2024 (Aug. 9-14 and Aug. 19-25).

- The D-backs are 6-1 in their last 7 games and 9-3 since May 9, tied for the NL's most wins in the span (also: Brewers and Braves).
- The D-backs' .640 home win pct. (16-9) ranks fifth, behind the Rays (.792, 19-5), Cubs (.692, 18-8), Yankees (.667, 16-8) and Braves (.667, 16-8).
- The D-backs' bullpen has held opponents scoreless in 3 of their last 4 games (10.0 IP, 1 R-1 ER, 6 H, 3 BB, 8 K).
- At home vs. Rockies, the D-backs have won 5 straight games, 10 of their last 11 and 21 of 26 since July 9, 2022.
- **Ketel Marte** has a 5-game hitting streak, batting .500 (10-for-20)/1.442 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 3 walks (0 K).
- **Corbin Carroll** has a season-high 9-game hitting streak, batting .387 (12-for-31)/1.343 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 10 walks (6 K).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 2-1 vs. Rockies via their second walk-off in 3 games courtesy of **Corbin Carroll's** ninth-inning, 2-out single (fourth career walk-off hit).

- **Corbin Carroll** plated both D-backs' runs...also had a RBI ground out in the sixth inning.
- **Ketel Marte** had his second straight multi-hit game and fifth in his last 7.
- **Gabriel Moreno** drew an 8-pitch leadoff walk to start the ninth inning and scored the winning run.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** went decisionless after 7.0 shutout innings (4 H, 0 BB, 4 K) for his fifth quality start and fourth of 7.0+ innings.
- **Kevin Ginkel** inherited and escaped a bases-loaded, 1-out jam in the eighth inning, inducing a pop out and ground out to hold a 1-1 tie.

1-2-3 HEATING UP: Since May 11 (10 G), D-backs' 1-3 batters have combined for an MLB-best .935 OPS and 23 walks...are hitting .301 (34-for-116) with 9 doubles, 2 triples, 4 homers, 19 RBI and only 13 strikeouts.

NO K'S: **Ketel Marte** has not struck out in 27 straight plate appearances (6 G since May 15 @ Rockies, Top 4).

• **Ildemaro Vargas** has not struck out in 33 straight plate appearances (8 G since May 13 @ Rangers, Top 7).

TRIPLE WATCH: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy (49 in 534 G) of 50 career and 4 from setting the club record (current: Stephen Drew, 52 in 773 G).

DIVISION SHOWDOWNS: The D-backs are 6-1 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups.

- The D-backs' 5-game home winning streak vs. NL West is tied for the second-longest since 2020 (also: April 26-May 21, 2025), behind their 7-gamer from May 23-June 1, 2023.

GINKEL HOLDING THE LINE: Since April 29, no reliever has stranded more runners than **Kevin Ginkel** (9 IR/0 IS)...is 1 of 3 relievers to strand 8+ inherited runners (also: Matt Festa/CLE with 8 IR and Justin Sterner/ATH with 8 IR).

PEN IN MAY: In May, the D-backs bullpen ranks among the Majors in fewest hits (1st, 30), fewest walks (1st, 15), WHIP (1st, 0.94), OBP (1st, .263), fewest homers (T-1st, 0), opponent AVG (2nd, .181), OPS (2nd, .498), fewest extra-base hits (2nd, 8) and ERA (4th, 2.08).

- The D-backs bullpen's 12 scoreless games in May are second most, behind the Dodgers (13)...last reached 13 in May from May 1-29, 2018.

BULLPEN AT HOME: In their last 10 home games, the bullpen has a 0.76 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 23.2 IP) with an opponent .127 AVG (10-for-79), 5 walks and 19 strikeouts.

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded a MLB-leading 12 quality starts in their last 16 outings and allowed 2 or fewer runs in 10 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 105.1), IP/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (1st, .255), ERA (2nd, 2.48), WHIP (3rd, 0.98) and strikeouts (T-4th, 85).
- The rotation has 7 straight quality starts at home...had 8 straight from Aug. 24-Sept. 15, 2025...team record is 9 (4x-last: July 23-Aug. 11, 2015).

ABOVE .500: The D-backs are 3 games above .500 for the first time since April 29 (16-13)...the last time they were 4 games above was April 22 (14-10).

- The D-backs were a season-high 5 games above .500 on April 18.

OFFENSE OUT OF THE GATES: In their last 7 games since May 15 from innings 1-3, the D-backs have scored 20 runs and are batting .341 (29-for-85)/.932 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers and 11 walks.

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs have won 11 of their last 13 series since 2023, going 29-13 (.690).

- Have won 7 straight home series since Aug. 7, 2022 and 13 of their last 14 home series since Sept. 27, 2020.

• **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games, batting .421 (24-for-57)/1.202 OPS with 10 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBI and 8 walks.

• **Corbin Carroll** has an 11-game hitting streak, batting .333 (15-for-45)/1.167 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 12 RBI and 8 walks.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (2-4, 4.78)

- Earned the win on May 18 vs. Giants (2 ER in 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 BB, 5 K).
- In 5 home starts, is 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA (8 ER in 26.2 IP), 3 walks and 18 strikeouts.
- Vs. Rockies at home, has allowed 1 run or fewer in 3 of his last 4 starts.

HOME SWEET HOME: In his 5 home starts (vs. DET, vs. ATL, vs. TOR, vs. CWS, vs. PIT), is 3-1 (team is 3-2) with a 1.59 ERA (5 ER in 28.1 IP), 7 walks and 30 strikeouts.

- Looks to become the fourth D-back to post a sub-2.00 ERA within their first 6 home starts with the club: Corbin Burnes (1.75, 2025), Daniel Hudson (1.87, 2010) and Omar Daal (1.96, 1998).

SENSATIONAL SLURVE: With his slurve (33.0 pct. usage) [highest usage pitch], is holding opponents to a .221 AVG (15-for-68) with 29 strikeouts and a 36.9 whiff pct.

- With his slurve, leads pitchers (min. 50 pitches) in strikeouts (29), whiff pct. (36.9), K/9 (14.24) and homers (T-1st, 0).

WIN COLUMN: Became the second D-back to record the win in his first 4 starts with the team from March 30-April 17, joining Chase Anderson from May 11-June 3, 2014 (club-record 5 straight wins).

10 STRIKEOUTS: With 10 strikeouts on March 30 vs. Tigers and April 10 @ Phillies, joined Randy Johnson (1999) as the only D-backs' starters with 10+ strikeouts in 2 of their first 3 starts with the team.

- Johnson, in 1999, had 4 straight starts with 10+ strikeouts in starts 2-5: 15 on April 10 @ Braves...10 on April 15 vs. Dodgers...10 on April 20 vs. Phillies...11 on April 25 @ Padres.

- In his last 33 games, is hitting .321 (34-for-106)/1.007 OPS with 8 doubles, 7 homers, 23 RBI and 15 walks (10 multi-hit games).
- With runners in scoring position, is hitting .325 (13-for-40)/1.106 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 21 RBI, 8 walks and 2 sac flies.
- Hit his seventh career grand slam on May 18 vs. Giants (last: August 21, 2024 vs. Brewers while with the Cardinals)...became the second D-back all-time to hit a first-inning grand slam from the cleanup spot (also: Stephen Drew on April 28, 2011 vs. Cubs).
- His grand slam was the first instance in MLB on 1 of the first 6 pitches of a game with pitch data dating back to 2000 (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
