**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5, going 1-2 at New York-NL and 0-3 at Tampa Bay...tonight, Minnesota will begin a seven game homestand with the first of three against the Mariners through Wednesday...after this series, the Twins will welcome the Blue Jays for four games from Thursday-Sunday.

☞ Twins are just 1-9 in their last 10, following a stretch where they went 8-1 in nine games from April 6-14.

☞ Twins are looking to snap a five-game losing streak, their longest since they lost five-straight from September 16-20, 2025...they are looking to avoid losing six-straight for the first time since September 1-6, 2025 (also 6).

☞ Twins are 7-6 at home, compared to 5-10 on the road...the offense has scored 5.2 runs-per-game at home, compared to 4.3 runs-per-game on the road...the pitching staff has posted a 3.63 ERA at home, compared to a 4.97 ERA on the road.

**TWINS SWEPT OUT OF ST. PETE:** The Twins lost to the Rays on Sunday afternoon by a score of 4-2, suffering their second sweep of the season...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-4) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks, two strikeouts and a home run (2-run shot by Yandy Diaz)...the bullpen of Banda, Funderburk, Sands and Topa, combined to pitch 3.2 scoreless innings with one hit allowed and one walk...the offense recorded just five hits and scored their only two runs on a Brooks Lee home run in the seventh inning.

**GRUNGE MATCH:** The Twins and Mariners are playing for the first of six times this season...Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from July 31-August 2...last season, the Twins went 3-4 vs. the Ms, going 1-2 at Seattle from May 30-June 1 and 2-2 at Target Field from June 23-26.

☞ Byron Buxton has a .931 OPS (.336 OBP / .595 SLG) in his last 27 games against Seattle...in that span, he has 10 home runs and 29 RBI.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .405 (15-for-37) with two doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, a .463 on-base percentage, a .784 slugging percentage and a 1.247 OPS in his last nine games vs. Seattle pitching.

☞ Over his last nine games vs. the Mariners, Victor Caratini is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with seven RBI, a .472 on-base percentage and a .956 OPS.

☞ Brooks Lee has hit safely in all six career games vs. Seattle, hitting .320 (8-for-25) in those games.

☞ Matt Wallner has a .901 OPS and a .581 slugging percentage in 13 career games vs. Seattle, hitting five home runs with eight RBI in 50 plate appearances.

**KEEP AUSTIN WEIRD:** Austin Martin has reached base safely in 17-straight games with a plate appearance and in 20 of 22 games with a plate appearance...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-game on-base streak from May 28-June 20, 2025...the 17-straight is tied for sixth-longest active streak in baseball...below are baseball's longest active on-base streaks:

**MORE ON A-MAR:** Martin currently leads the club with 18 walks...he has posted a .500 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances.

☞ Martin on MLB Savant's 2026 MLB Percentile Rankings: 92nd in batting run value (8), 87th in xwOBA (.396), 100th in chase % (11.5%), 90th in whiff % (16.5%), 100th in walk % (23.7%).

**SIMP-LEE STUNNING:** Brooks Lee finished the roadtrip, hitting .348 (8-for-23) with one double, two home runs, three RBI and a 1.052 OPS...below are Lee's numbers through the first 10 games (March 26-April 8), compared to his last 16 (since April 9):

**RISPING IT ALL:** Twins began the season hitting .306 (49-for-160) with runners in scoring position through their first 20 games...in their last eight games, they are hitting .181 (13-for-72) with RISP, since game two of the Reds series on April 18 — 1-7 since that date...despite the recent slide, they still rank fourth in the AL in RISP average and ninth in baseball.

☞ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .444 (8-for-18)...Josh Bell is hitting .385 (10-for-26)...Brooks Lee is hitting .450 (9-for-20)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .333 (10-for-30)...Tristan Gray is hitting .357 (5-for-14).

**TOP JEFF AMERICA:** Over his last 13 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with one double, one triple, three home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks, a .460 on-base percentage, a .590 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS...Jeffers has started 17 games at catcher this season and is on pace to start behind the plate 98 times this season, which would mark the most in his career (88 in 2025).

### THIS AND THAT:

☞ Twins have scored 5.15 runs-per-game at home this season, fifth-most in the AL.

☞ Despite having a run differential of 0, that figure still ranks fifth-best in the AL.

☞ Twins have hit 33 home runs on the season, tied for fifth-most in the AL...13 of those homers have come at Target Field.

☞ Twins have posted a walk percentage of 11.1%, third-best in the AL, trailing New York (12.6%) and Los Angeles (11.5%).

**THERE GOES MY HERO:** Continuing to celebrate legends of our game, the Twins, in conjunction with the Minnesota Ballpark Authority and local artist Antione Jenkins, earlier today unveiled a new piece of art at Target Field, the "Baseball Heroes" mural located on the Main Concourse at Sections 114-116...in bright, bold colors and with a unique narrative flair, the Baseball Heroes mural honors greats of Black baseball with ties to the Upper Midwest.

**SLICK RIC:** Double-A Wichita catcher Ricardo Olivar has been named Texas League Player of the Week by Minor League Baseball...in five games for the Wind Surge, Olivar hit .438 (7-for-16) with one double, five home runs, nine RBI, five walks, a .571 on-base percentage, a 1.438 slugging percentage and a 2.009 OPS...he homered in four of the five games, including a multi-homer game on Wednesday at Northwest Arkansas.

- Connor Prielipp will make his second career start tonight against the Seattle Mariners; this will be Prielipp's first career start at Target Field.
- Prielipp made his major league debut on April 22 at Citi Field against the New York Mets; he started and went 4.0 innings pitched, giving up two runs on four hits with zero walks and six strikeouts.
- Upon his callup, Prielipp was listed as the fifth ranked prospect and top-ranked pitching prospect in the Twins' system, per MLB.com; he was ranked as the no. 81 prospect in all of baseball and fourth in the Twins' system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per *Baseball America*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his major league debut on April 22 at Citi Field against the New York Mets... Prielipp went 4.0 innings pitched, giving up two runs on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts... took the no-decision and exited the game with the Twins trailing 2-1; the team would go on to drop the game by a score of 3-2.

**FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:** Prielipp became the 19th pitcher in Twins franchise history to strike out at least six batters in his debut and the first to do so in four-or-fewer innings (1961-).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** In his final start for Triple-A St. Paul on April 16 before being called up, Prielipp earned the win, going 5.0 innings, while giving up one run on four hits with one walk and eight strikeouts...the eight strikeouts were a minor league career-high and he was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week (April 12-19) for his performance.

**TARGET FIELD DEBUT:** Prielipp will make his home debut at Target Field tonight...here are how some other Twins top-pitching prospects did in their first starts at Target Field:

**WITH A WIN:** If Prielipp earns the win tonight, he will be the first Twins starting pitching prospect to win in their home debut since Zebby Matthews on August 13, 2024 vs. Kansas City.

**KEEPING THEM OFF BALANCE:** Of his 82 pitches against the Mets, 60 of them were offspeed (Slider - 42, Changeup - 13 and Curveball - 5)...If qualified, Prielipp's 25.6% fastball usage would rank last on the Twins starting staff (next closest, Bailey Ober - 32.9%) and his slider usage (51.2%) would rank as the highest usage of any pitch for a Twins starter.

**THERE'S A REASON FOR IT:** Prielipp's slider and changeup usage is due to the fact that both are plus pitches: In 2025, he was ranked as having the best slider and best changeup among Minnesota minor leaguers.

**GET TO KNOW CONNOR:** Born in Tomah, WI and went 6-2 with a 0.85 ERA and 118 strikeouts (21.7 SO/9) against just five walks (23.60 SO/BB) in 49.0 innings as a senior...named the Gatorade Wisconsin Player of the Year and Collegiate Baseball News First Team All-American.

**TUSCALOOSA WE GO:** Despite being selected by Boston in the 37th round of the 2019 draft, Prielipp decided to attend the University of Alabama, where he earned National Freshman Player of the Year, and was named a first team All-American and Freshman All-America by Collegiate Baseball News.

**WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY:** Despite Tommy John surgery, the Twins drafted Prielipp in the second round (48th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft...since being drafted, Prielipp has stormed through the minor leagues to the tune of a 3.72 ERA (128.1 IP, 53 ER) with 50 walks, 168 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP.

**2025 WAS AWARD SEASON:** Prielipp broke out in 2025, pitching a minor league career-high 82.2 innings (previous high: 23.1 IP in 2024) with a 4.03 ERA, 31 walks and 98 strikeouts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul...he ranked second among all Twins pitchers in starts and was tied for seventh in strikeouts.

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on May 11 while pitching for Double-A Wichita; then on September 21 named for a second time while pitching with Triple-A St. Paul.

**PITCHER OF THE MONTH:** Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for July after recording a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks (9 BB%) and 17 strikeouts (29 K%) across four starts.

**PITCHER OF THE YEAR:** Following the season, was named the Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year, becoming the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In his debut, Prielipp had only two at-bats against left-handed hitters and 15 against right-handed hitters, here are his splits: lefties slashed .000/000/000 (0-for-2) with zero double, zero walks and zero strikeouts, while righties slashed .267/.267/.400 with two doubles, two RBI, zero walks and six strikeouts

**SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** In his minor league career, lefties are slashing .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties are slashing .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** In his debut, Prielipp used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

**THAT'S A LOT OF FRISBEES:** Prielipp threw his slider 51.2% of the time in his MLB debut... to put it into perspective, among MLB starters that would easily rank as the highest slider usage in baseball...Chris Sale of the Atlanta Braves currently leads qualified starters in slider usage at 43.9%.

**CAREER NOTES**

- Upon call-up, currently ranked fifth in the Twins system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per MLB.com and ranked as the no. 81 prospect in baseball and fourth-best in Twins system by *Baseball America* (highest ranked pitcher)...ranked 94th-best prospect in baseball by *Baseball America* entering 2026.
- In 2025, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combined to go 1-9 with a 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks and 98 strikeouts in 24 appearances (23 starts).
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year...is the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).
- Ranked as having best slider and best changeup among Minnesota minor leaguers.
- Entering 2025, ranked seventh-best prospect in Twins organization by *Baseball America* entering 2025, and 21st by MLB.com.
- Began season at Double-A Wichita and pitched in short spurts, not going beyond the fourth inning and topping out at 76 pitches in a single outing for Wind Surge...despite innings restrictions, struck out at least five batters in nine of 19 starts.
- Among Texas Leaguers with at least 50.0 inning pitched, ranked ninth in the league in strikeout rate (27%) while holding the 13th-lowest walk-rate (7%).
- Named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after recording a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks (9.0 BB%) and 17 strikeouts (29.0 K%) across four starts.
- Promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 16, where he finished season.
- In 2024, ranked 16th-best prospect in the Twins farm system by *Baseball America* entering 2024 and was 21st by season's end...began season on 60-day Injured List with High-A Cedar Rapids...had rehab assignments with the FCL Twins and Low-A Fort Myers...was reinstated from the Injured List on July 22 and went 0-1, 3.26 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts in seven starts for the Kernels.
