Olson 40-40?

Matt Olson lined his 31st double of the season down the right-field line in last night's eighth inning, after clubbing his 36th home run on Sunday afternoon.

Olson is the only player in baseball this season with 30 doubles and 30 home runs.

Last night's double puts Olson on pace for exactly 40 two-base hits this season, while his homer pace currently sits at 47.

In Braves franchise history, there has been exactly one season in which a player collected at least 40 doubles and 40 homers.

Chipper Jones slugged 45 homers and 41 doubles in 1999, on his way to earning NL Most Valuable Player honors.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Twins tonight continue a three-game mid-week series in what are the only scheduled matchups between the clubs this season...The clubs last saw each for three games at Truist Park in Atlanta in April of 2025.

 The Twins beat the Braves, 4-2, in the series opener last night to snap an 11-game winning streak by Atlanta in the series...It was the Braves' longest winning streak in series history between the two clubs.

 The Braves have never lost a series here at Target Field, going 9-3 (.750) here all time since the park opened in 2010...Atlanta swept three games here in its last visit in 2024...The Braves need wins tonight and tomorrow to win this series.

 Atlanta and Minnesota have played just 29 total games since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with the Braves going 20-9 (.690) all-time against the Twins...The two franchises squared off in the 1991 World Series, with Minnesota claiming the title in seven games.

 RH Zebby Matthews is set tonight to make the 42nd start of his major league career, and his first versus Atlanta...The 6-foot-5, 225-pound North Carolina native has won back-to-back starts and the Twins have won each of his last three turns in total, during which the right-hander has fanned 18 batters over 15.0 innings.

TYLER MAHLE: Makes his third start for the Braves after Atlanta acquired him at the trade deadline, and has combined to allow just seven hits and one run over 12.0 combined innings (0.75 ERA) over his first two turns... The Braves acquired him from the San Francisco Giants on August 2 in exchange for RHP Anthony Molina.

 Mahle has accumulated 0.5 fWAR since the trade deadline on August 3, 18th most in the majors and **the most by any pitcher traded at the deadline.**

 His 0.75 ERA with Atlanta ranks fourth in the majors among pitchers with multiple starts since the deadline, and his 12.00 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ranks 10th.

 The 6-foot-3, 212-pound Californian has made nine starts between the Giants and Braves since returning from the injured list (strained left hamstring) on June 24, and has pitched to a 3-2 record with a 3.06 ERA (17 ER/50.0 IP) and a 1.080 WHIP in that span.

 Mahle has made seven prior starts against the Twins in his career, and enters play 2-1 with a 5.17 ERA (18 ER/31.1 IP) all-time against the club.

BALDWIN LEADING OFF: Drake Baldwin lined a 1-1 pitch into right field leading off last night's first inning, and is batting .316/.381/.579 as the leadoff batter in the game's opening inning this year.

 Among batters with at least 40 games hitting leadoff, Baldwin's .316 average as the first plate appearance of a game ranks fourth in the majors.

BULLPEN SCORELESS: Three Braves relievers combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings last night, the 37th game this season in which the Atlanta bullpen went at least 3.0 innings and did not allow a run...That total is the most such outings in the majors.

 Detroit's bullpen has done so 36 times to rank second.

 The Braves' bullpen currently leads the National League and ranks third in the majors with a 3.47 ERA on the season, and the unit's .674 winning percentage (31-15) is the highest mark in all of baseball.

TWIN CONNECTIONS: Four of Atlanta's 10 assistant coaches return to Minnesota this week after spending time on staff with the Twins earlier in their careers...Last night's starter Martín Pérez also made 32 appearances and 29 starts for Minnesota in 2019, his lone season with the club, while tonight's starter Tyler Mahle made nine starts for the Twins across 2022 and 2023.

 Tommy Watkins returns to Minneapolis this season after 28 years in the Twins organization...He was selected by Minnesota in the 38th round of the 1998 draft and spent his entire professional career in the organization prior to joining Atlanta this offseason...Following his playing career he coached nine seasons in Minnesota's minor leagues, before spending seven seasons (2019-2025) as a base coach on the major league staff.

 Tony Diaz spent six seasons on staff with the Twins, from 2019-24, as third-base coach (2019-21) and assistant bench coach ('22-24).

 Jeremy Hefner was Minnesota's assistant pitching coach in 2019 after serving as the Twins' advance scout in 2017-18.

 J.P. Martinez worked for six seasons as a minor league coach in Minnesota's system, from 2015-2020, before his first major league appointment with the Giants in 2021.

RONALD NEARING HISTORY: Ronald Acuña Jr. drove a 2-2 changeup in Saturday night's first inning out to center field for his 13th home run of the season...The drive was also the 199th home run of his career.

 Acuña Jr.'s next home run will stand as the 200th of his career, and he is looking to become the fastest player in major league history, by games played, to reach at least 200 home runs and 200 stolen bases.

 Alfonso Soriano holds the current record, swiping a pair of bases in his 929th career game to reach 203 home runs and 201 stolen bases...Acuña Jr. currently has 220 stolen bases to go with his 199 home runs... Tonight's game will be the 891st of his career.

 Just two Braves in history have reached 200 career homers prior to playing their 891st game...Bob Horner hit his 200th in his 882nd game in 1986, while Eddie Mathews needed just 779 games to reach the mark in 1957.

Today's Game

A Makes his third start with Atlanta, the 21st of his season and the 162nd of his career, in the middle game of a three-game series at Minnesota...Atlanta is 1-1 in his two turns since acquiring him.

Will make his eighth career start against the Twins and his first with Atlanta... Is 2-1 with a 5.17 ERA (18 ER/31.1 IP) all-time against Minnesota, a club he pitched for in 2022-23.

His most recent win against the Twins came here at Target Field on June 10 of last season, when he allowed four runs over 5.2 innings in a 16-4 Texas victory.

A Is 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP) and 16 strikeouts over his first two starts with Atlanta since being acquired from San Francisco on August 2.

A Earned his first win as a Brave in his most recent outing, August 12, striking out seven over 6.0 innings in a 6-3 win over New York (NL) at Truist Park.

A Has struck out at least seven in each of his last three starts, totaling 25 over 17.2 innings dating to August 1.

🔴 Fanned nine August 7 at New York (AL) and seven August 12 against the Mets...is the only pitcher in the Atlanta era (since 1966) to open with seven-plus strikeouts in each of his first two starts after joining the Braves from another major league team.

A Has pitched to a 2.52 ERA (10 ER/35.2 IP) over his last six starts, dating to July 11.

Is 0-6 with a 7.07 ERA (39 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 road starts this season, compared to a 4-3 record and a 2.53 ERA (16 ER/57.0 IP) in 10 home starts...his 7.07 road ERA is the second-highest in the majors among pitchers with at least 10 starts, trailing only Cincinnati's Rhett Lowder (7.23).

Has thrown his splitter more often since the trade, using it 36.8 percent of the time over his two starts with Atlanta after a 25.1 percent rate across 18 starts with San Francisco.

🔴 Signed a one-year contract with San Francisco on January 5 and made 18 starts for the Giants before the August 2 trade to Atlanta, going 3-9 with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER/94.2 IP) and 89 strikeouts.

A Opened the year in the San Francisco rotation and made his first start March 28 against New York (AL).

A Was placed on the 15-day injured list May 27 with a left hamstring strain and reinstated June 24.

A Matched a season high with 104 pitches July 11 against Colorado, earning the win on 7.0 innings of one-run ball.

A Made his Braves debut August 7 at New York (AL), tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in a no-decision.

A Earned his first win as a Brave August 12 against New York (NL), allowing one run over 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts in a 6-3 victory.

Career Recap

A In his 10th major league season and his first with Atlanta...has pitched for four organizations: Cincinnati (2017-2022), Minnesota (2022-2023), Texas (2024-2025) and San Francisco (2026).

A Made his major league debut August 27, 2017 with Cincinnati against Pittsburgh.

🔴 Set career highs in 2021 with the Reds, going 13-6 with a 3.75 ERA, 210 strikeouts and 180.0 innings over 33 starts.

Underwent Tommy John surgery in May 2023 and made three starts in 2024 while working back.

A Posted a career-low 2.18 ERA (21 ER/86.2 IP) over 16 starts for Texas in 2025.
