BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles conclude a six-game road trip today at Tropicana Field, having dropped four of their last five...Baltimore and Tampa Bay will meet four times in the next eight days, with the Rays coming to Camden Yards from May 25-27...Following tomorrow's off day, the Birds open an 10-game homestand against the Tigers (3 G), Rays (3 G), and Blue Jays (4 G)... Baltimore is 6-12 since May 1, having been outscored 112-67 (-45) during that period and are a season-high seven games below .500.

♫ **Taylor Ward** was responsible for the Orioles lone run last night, hitting his 11th career leadoff home run, including his first since April 13, 2025 at Houston.

♫ **Kyle Bradish** suffered the loss after working 5.1 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts...Despite the defeat, he owns a 2.45 ERA (5 ER/18.1 IP) over his last three starts after posting a 5.03 ERA (19 ER/34.0 IP) over his first seven starts of the season.

♫ The Birds swiped a season-high-tying three bags last night (also 4/11 vs. SF).

♫ Today, the O's look to avoid their third sweep of the season (4/3-5 at PIT & 5/1-4 at NYY)...They have not been swept by the Rays since a three-game set from April 8-10, 2022 at Tropicana Field.

STREAK ENDS TODAY: In his return to Tropicana Field, **Shane Baz** looks to end a nine-decision losing streak on the road dating to July 7, 2025...He is seeking his first victory on the road since tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts on June 26, 2025 at Kansas City.

♫ In 10 career starts at Tropicana Field, Baz is 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA (17 ER/56.1 IP), .174 opponent average (35-for-201), and 61 strikeouts.

LOUD CONTACT: In five games since May 15, the O's have recorded an MLB-best 46 batted balls hit at 100.0+ mph, ahead of the Nationals (42) and Brewers (41).

♫ **Jeremiah Jackson** and **Gunnar Henderson** each have nine such batted balls during that period, tied for the MLB lead with NYM's Bo Bichette.

SOUTHPAW STORY: The Orioles are 3-10 (.231) against left-handed starters, tied with the Mets (also 3-10) for the second-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Royals (2-11, .154).

♫ In six games since May 13, Baltimore is slashing .292/.342/.431 (21-for-72) with four doubles and two home runs off left-handed pitching...In their previous eight games off southpaws from May 4-12, the Birds slashed .160/.259/.320 (12-for-75) with one double, one triple, and three home runs.

♫ **Samuel Basallo** is 7-for-15 (.467) off southpaws since April 24 after opening the season 1-for-12.

♫ The Orioles faced a right-handed starter in a franchise-record 17 straight games to open the season, surpassing the previous record of 14 in 1975.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: Despite seeing his career-high 10-game hitting streak come to an end last night, **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .368/.407/.605 (28-for-76) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 runs, and 13 RBI in 22 games since April 20.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (1st, 45), doubles (T-2nd, 15), times on base (T-3rd, 91), and on-base percentage (4th, .416).

♫ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

♫ His 91 times on base are the third most in a players' first 48 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing Roberto Alomar (105 in 1996) and Frank Robinson (99 in 1966).

♫ Ward has seen 988 total pitches this season, most in the majors ahead of WSH's James Wood (971) and ATH's Nick Kurtz (941)...An MLB-best 370 of those pitches have come in a 3-2 count.

ROAD TRIPPIN': O's pitchers have posted an MLB-high 5.86 ERA on the road, with the next closest clubs being the Astros (5.47) and Angels (5.29)...Their .817 opponent OPS is also the highest in majors, ahead of the Astros (.794) and Twins (.787).

TROUBLESOME TWO'S: Oriole pitching has allowed opponents to slash .260/.356/.421 (144-for-554) and a .777 OPS with two outs...The .777 OPS is the second-highest mark in the majors ahead of the Astros (.794).

♫ The Rays are 11-for-25 (.440) with three doubles, one triple, 11 RBI, seven walks, and four strikeouts with two outs this series.

♫ Baltimore hurlers own a .559 opponent OPS with two strikes, the fourth-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.590) and Houston/Washington (both .582).

SECOND-INNING STRUGGLES: Baltimore has been outscored 42-14 in the second frame this season...The 42 runs allowed are the most by any club in the majors with the next closest being Washington (35), while the 14 runs scored are fifth fewest.

♫ Overall, the Birds have been outscored 94-51 (-43) from innings 1-3...From innings 4-6, the O's are trailing their opponents, 88-87...From the seventh frame on, they have been outscored, 87-74 (-13).

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: Oriole pitching has allowed opposing right-handed hitters to bat .288, the highest clip in MLB, with the next closest club being the Rockies (.271)...Opposing righties have also posted an .822 OPS, the highest mark in the majors with the next closest being the Astros (.782).

♫ Left-handers have hit .244 against the Birds, the 14th-highest mark in MLB, while their .746 OPS is ninth highest.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 10th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his third consecutive loss on May 15 at Washington after throwing a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts...Threw a career-high 108 pitches, 69 strikes.

⚡ Has thrown at least 95 pitches in a career-high eight straight starts, surpassing his previous high of three (2x, last: 6/15-26/25)...He is the first Oriole to accomplish the feat since Kevin Gausman's nine-start stretch from April 6-May 22, 2018.

⚡ Recorded his first quality start since September 1, 2025 vs. Seattle (W, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 6 K).

FAMILIAR FOE: Baz is set to make his first career start against his former club... He made 63 starts with Tampa Bay from 2021-25, going 17-17 with a 4.25 ERA (135 ER/286.0 IP).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 21 doubles, ahead of SEA's Logan Gilbert and COL's Michael Lorenzen (both 16)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his nine starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

ROAD TRIPPIN': Baz is on a nine-decision losing streak on the road dating to July 7, 2025...During that period, he has pitched to a 4.92 ERA (39 ER/71.1 IP).

⚡ Today, he is seeking his first victory on the road since tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts on June 26, 2025 at Kansas City.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 15 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted six home runs over 79.2 innings (0.68 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ He has, however, allowed one homer in each of his last four starts, tied for the second-longest streak of his career behind a seven-start stretch from May 1-June 4, 2025.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Left-handed hitters are slashing .316/.393/.500 (36-for-114) with 15 doubles, two home runs, and 16 walks, compared to .241/.290/.458 (20-for-83) with six doubles, four home runs, and six walks by righties.

⚡ He has limited lefties to a .234 (11-for-47) clip over his last four starts after they went 25-for-67 (.373) with 10 doubles over his first five outings.

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 3-for-21 (.143) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

⚡ Baz has allowed hitters to go 15-for-35 (.429) with seven doubles and one home run on the first pitch of an at-bat.

⚡ Has limited opponents to a .236 (17-for-72) mark the first time through the lineup, compared to a combined 39-for-125 (.312) clip the second, third, and fourth time through.
