THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (2-2 in Detroit and 0-3 in Baltimore), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a series loss to the Tigers over the weekend, winning just the middle game on Saturday...tonight, the Twins will continue the homestand with the first of four against the White Sox...they will host Chicago through Thursday afternoon, then begin a six-game roadtrip with stops in Anaheim and Chicago-AL. **⚡** Seven of the Twins next 10 games will come against the White Sox.

ADJUST YOUR BUNNY EARS: Along with Bally Sports North, tonight's game will also be nationally televised on Fox Sports 1...additionally, due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Suns), tomorrow night's Twins-White Sox game will be broadcast on Bally Sports North Extra.

SUNDAY, BLOODY SUNDAY: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-1, dropping the series two games to one and making them 1-4-2 in series play in 2024 (0-3-0 at home)...Louie Varland (0-4) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on three hits in 2.2 innings pitched, with four walks and two strikeouts...Varland threw 39 balls compared to 35 strikes...the offense recorded seven hits, just two going for extra bases, a Willi Castro double and an Austin Martin home run — the first of his career.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins went 9-4 against the Sox last season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 4-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Minnesota started 2-3 in their first five against the Sox, then went 7-1 in their final eight...the Twins outscored Chicago 70-41 in 2024...the Twins scored 30 runs in their last four games, including a pair of 10-spots on September 14 and 15. **⚡** Since 2015, the Twins have gone 87-69 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

⚡ The Twins have beat the Sox 70 times (53 losses) at Target Field (since 2010), second most against any opponent (Kansas City - 72).

⚡ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .333 (26-for-78) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI and an .891 OPS in 22 career games vs. the Sox...he has driven in 15 runs in his last 14 games against Chicago.

⚡ Carlos Santana is the all-time leader among active in walks (113) and games (180) against the White Sox...also, on that list, he ranks second in runs (88), and third in hits (146), home runs (24) and RBI (78).

⚡ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .296 (16-for-54) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBI and an .867 OPS in his last 16 games vs. the White Sox.

⚡ Byron Buxton is hitting .347 (33-for-95) with five doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 23 RBI, an .800 slugging percentage and a 1.215 OPS in his last 25 games against the Sox...last season, Buck hit four home runs vs. Chicago.

AUSTIN MARTIN, INTENSITY. DRIVEN.: Austin Martin enters today with a seven-game hitting streak, tied for the longest by a Twin this season (streaks below)...the streak is tied for fifth longest active streak in the AL...during the streak, Martin is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with four RBI, eight runs scored and an .845 OPS...Martin's longest streak of 2023 was also seven games for St. Paul from August 13-22...Martin's longest hitting streak of his professional career is eight games with Double-A Wichita from May 13-24, 2022...here are the Twins longest streaks this season:

TWINS MAKE ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have returned outfielder Max Kepler from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...additionally, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez, and optioned catcher Jair Camargo and Louie Varland to Triple-A St. Paul.

⚡ Kepler, who missed the Twins last 13 games with a right knee contusion, played in three games on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul, going 4-for-10 (.400) with three walks.

⚡ Henriquez, 23, has appeared in seven games for the Saints this season, posting a 4.05 ERA (13.1 IP, 6 ER) with one save, two walks, 14 strikeouts, a .235 (12-for-51) opponent batting average and a .637 opponent OPS.

⚡ To make room for Kepler and Henriquez on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned catcher Jair Camargo and right-handed pitcher Louie Varland to Triple-A St. Paul...Camargo, 24, appeared in two games for the Twins, going 0-for-4 with one walk...Varland, 26, made four starts for the Twins, going 0-4 with a 9.18 ERA (16.2 IP, 17 ER), nine walks and 18 strikeouts.

⚡ To make room for Henriquez on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Daniel Duarte to the 60-day Injured List...Duarte is scheduled to have surgery on his right elbow on May 8 and will not pitch again in 2024.

DOG DAYS: Target Field will go to the dogs tonight, as the Twins host their first-ever Bark at the Park...fans who purchased this sold-out Theme Night package will receive a ticket to the game, a separate ticket for their dog and an exclusive Twins portable dog water bottle...a portion of the proceeds from each ticket package sold will benefit local nonprofit Can Do Canines, which is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for people with disabilities by creating mutually-beneficial partnerships with specially-trained dogs...Can Do Canines will also be recognized on the field prior to the game.

GO SHORTY, IT'S YOUR EARTH DAY: Since opening Target Field in 2010, the Twins are the first and only MLB club to achieve five separate LEED certifications: LEED Silver for New Construction (in 2010, the second MLB team thus honored); LEED Silver for Existing Buildings: Operations & Maintenance (in 2011, making the Twins the first professional sports franchise to earn Silver for both construction and operations); LEED Gold for Existing Buildings: Operations & Maintenance (in 2017, becoming the first organization in pro sports to attain Gold in this category); LEED Gold recertification (in 2019); and LEED Platinum (in 2022, becoming the first MLB club to earn the U.S. Green Building Council's highest possible honor via the new LEED v4.1 rating system)...the Twins are 21-24 all-time on Earth Day, since the holiday's inception in 1970.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1961, the Twins won their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington, D.C....the score was 5-4 over the Washington Senators in 10 innings...they won on a Zoilo Versalles sac fly, scoring Earl Battey in front of a crowd of 17,445.

ICYMI: A 2016 spring training game-worn navy blue #56 Tomás Telis jersey was spotted behind the visitors dugout yesterday...h/t Kris Atteberry.

- ☞ Has never faced Chicago-AL...five current White Sox hitters have faced Paddack, combining to go 5-for-21 (.238) with no extra-base hits and four strikeouts.
- ☞ Seeking first win as a starter since May 2, 2022 in Baltimore...earned a relief victory September 30, 2023 in Colorado.

BOMBARDED IN BALTIMORE: Took his first loss of the season April 16 in Baltimore...allowed nine runs on 12 hits – both career highs – in 5.1 innings, walking one and striking out two...yielded two-run home runs to Gunnar Henderson in the second inning and Jordan Westburg in the third...exited with one out in the sixth and Adley Rutschman on third; Caleb Thielbar entered and allowed a single that scored Paddack's ninth run.

- ☞ 13 of 26 batted balls were hard-hit (95.0+ mph)...seven of the 13 went for base hits...also allowed a 410-foot Ryan O'Hearn flyout (104.0 mph) that would've been a home run in 16 of 30 ballparks.
- ☞ Generated just six whiffs on 89 pitches (6.7%).
- ☞ Both home runs came against sliders.

SOLID SECOND START: Started series finale vs. Los Angeles-NL on April 10 at Target Field, opposite Bobby Miller...allowed two runs on six hits in 4.2 innings, exiting with a 2-2 tie and not factoring into the decision...surrendered first-inning RBI double to Teoscar Hernández and fourth-inning solo home run to Max Muncy...pulled with runners on first and third in the fifth inning; Kody Funderburk entered and struck out Muncy to end the inning...Edouard Julien homered in the next half-inning and Minnesota held the 3-2 lead.

- ☞ Struck out the side – James Outman, Miguel Rojas and Austin Barnes – in a 1-2-3 second inning.
- ☞ Generated 10 whiffs on 86 pitches (11.6%), compared to six whiffs on 82 pitches (7.3%) on April 3 at Milwaukee.
- ☞ 4-seam fastball topped out at 97.3 mph, on his 83rd pitch – a foul ball by Hernández.

NEW SOX: Hasn't faced Chicago-AL in his career...has made two career starts vs. American League Central opponents, April 20, 2022 at Kansas City and April 26, 2022 vs. Detroit, going 0-1 with a 2.53 ERA (10.2 IP, 3 ER), one walk and 10 strikeouts...five current White Sox hitters have faced Paddack, combining to go 5-for-21 (.238) with no extra-base hits and four strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making second home start of 2024...since joining Minnesota in 2022, has gone 0-1 with a 5.79 ERA (18.2 IP, 12 ER), .860 opponent OPS and 0.96 home runs-per-9.0-innings at Target Field, compared to 2-2 with a 5.56 ERA (22.2 IP, 14 ER), .800 OPS and 1.19 HR/9 on the road.

PLATOON SPLITS: April 16 at Baltimore, left-handed hitters went 9-for-22 with a home run and nine hard-hit balls, while righties went 3-for-6 with a double, a home run and four hard-hit balls...through three starts, lefties have hit .400 (14-for-35) with a 1.021 OPS, 87.5-mph average exit velocity and 38.2-percent hard-hit rate against Paddack; righties have hit .357 (10-for-28) with a 1.043 OPS, 89.3-mph exit velocity and 47.6-percent hard-hit rate.

- ☞ As a team, the White Sox have a 32.3-percent hard-hit rate this season, the worst mark in baseball.
- ☞ Facing right-handed pitching, White Sox lefties have hit .209 (61-for-292) with a .600 OPS, while their righties have hit .164 (36-for-220) with a .515 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has thrown a four-pitch mix through three starts, per Baseball Savant...pitch velocities were slightly down April 16 in Baltimore, compared to first two outings...Statcast registered one sinker, his first of the season, in that Baltimore start...here's a breakdown of his repertoire thus far in 2024:

- ☞ Threw 9 sliders on 89 pitches (10.1%) in Baltimore, compared to 25.6 percent vs. Los Angeles-NL...Orioles swung five times: one whiff, two home runs.
- ☞ Paddack's changeup has resulted in a .750 slugging percentage, the 10th highest in baseball (min. 10 PA)...the pitch's .804 expected slugging percentage is the highest in baseball.

BARRELS, BARRELS, BARRELS: Through three starts, has allowed a 12.7-percent barrel rate...compares to MLB average of 6.9 percent and Paddack's career average of 8.5 percent...among MLB pitchers with 50-or-more batted ball events this season, Paddack's 12.7-percent barrel rate ranks 14th highest.

- ☞ By definition, a barreled ball has an expected batting average of .500-or-more and an expected slugging percentage of 1.500-or-more.

WOES WHEN AHEAD: In 2024, when Paddack gets ahead 0-1 in the count, opponents are hitting .444 (12-for-27); MLB average is .210...when the count begins 1-0, opponents are hitting .269 (7-for-26); MLB average is .253...when he gets ahead 0-2, opponents are hitting .333 (5-for-15); MLB average is .161.

- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
- Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
- In 2020, made Opening Day start and earned win July 24 vs. Arizona...posted 4.73 ERA across 12 regular season outings...became seventh pitcher in San Diego franchise history with 200+ strikeouts in first 35 career starts.
- As a rookie in 2019, posted career-bests in wins (9), ERA (3.33), innings (140.2) and strikeouts (153)...named to *Baseball America's* Major League All-Rookie Team.
- Made major league debut March 31, 2019 vs. San Francisco, yielding one run on two hits and striking out seven in 5.0-inning no-decision.
- Entering 2019, was ranked Padres' No. 4 prospect by ESPN.com, No. 5 by MLB Pipeline and No. 6 by *Baseball America*.
- Missed entire 2017 season rehabbing from first Tommy John surgery in August of 2016.
- Acquired by San Diego from Miami in June 30, 2016 trade that sent Fernando Rodney to Marlins.
