FIREWORKS & POSTGAME CONCERT: Tomorrow, the D-backs feature their first Postgame Fireworks show of the season, presented by Budweiser...on Saturday, fans can enjoy a free (with a game ticket) postgame concert from The All-American Rejects...fans can upgrade to a field pass for on-field access at dbacks.com/aar.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs look to win 4 straight games for the first time since Sept. 13-16, 2025...had 8 streaks of 4+ wins last season...won season-high 5 straight games twice in 2025 (last: June 9-14, 2025).

- **Corbin Carroll** has an extra base hit in 3 straight games and RBI in 4 straight games, hitting .462 (6-for-13)/1.683 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 3 walks (2 K).
 - Previous longest extra-base hit streak by a D-back was 5 games by Carroll (Aug. 6-11, 2025).
 - Previous longest RBI streak by a D-back was 6 games by Lourdes Gurriel Jr. (Aug. 19-25, 2025).
- **Ryne Nelson** makes his fourth career start vs. Braves...in his last 6 starts vs. NL East, has gone 2-1 (team is 3-3) with a 2.43 ERA (10 ER in 37.0 IP), opponent .186 ERA, 9 walks and 27 strikeouts.
 - Off his slider in his last start @ Dodgers, hitters went 0-for-8 (3 K).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 1-0 vs. Tigers yesterday, secured by **Corbin Carroll's** first-inning solo homer off of Tarik Skubal and **Zac Gallen's** 6.0 scoreless innings (4 H, 0 BB, 2 K).

- MLB's first 1-0 game this season.
- 14th 1-0 win all-time @ Chase Field (last: May 18, 2025 vs. Rockies).
- Fifth shutout all-time vs. Tigers and second @ home (last: May 18, 2008, won 4-0 @ Chase Field).
- First-ever home sweep vs. Tigers [previously swept 3 road series from June 9-11, 2023 (3-0), June 13-14, 2017 (2-0) and June 27-29, 2003 (3-0)].
- Fourth season-opening home series sweep all-time and first since April 6-8, 2012 vs. Giants (3-0) [also: April 4-6, 2000 vs. Phillies (3-0) and April 7-9, 2008 vs. Dodgers (3-0)].
 - First sweep since Aug. 8-10, 2025 vs. Rockies (3-0).
 - First sweep vs. AL since June 9-11, 2025 vs. Mariners (3-0).
- **Carroll** went 2-for-3 with 1 homer, 1 RBI and 1 walk...became the sixth left-handed hitter ever to homer off Tarik Skubal (139 career games/136 starts)...has now homered off of 6 former Cy Young Award winners (10 total HR) in his career [also: Shane Bieber/TOR (in 2023), Sandy Alcantara/MIA (in 2023), Max Scherzer/TOR (in 2023), Clayton Kershaw/LAD (3x, last in 2023) and Justin Verlander/DET (3x, last in 2026)].
- **Taylor Clarke** made his second consecutive scoreless outing (1.0 IP).
- **Juan Morillo** made his second consecutive scoreless outing (1.0 IP) and third in 4 appearances (2 ER in 3.0 IP).
- **Jonathan Loaisiga** earned his first save (1.0 IP) in his third consecutive scoreless outing (3.1 IP).

DEFENSIVELY: The D-backs 9 defensive runs saved (DRS) rank second, behind the Dodgers (10) and ahead of the Pirates (7), Braves (6) and Cubs (6).

- Their 3 DRS at second base rank tied for the most with the Mariners, 2 DRS at third base also rank tied for the most with the Blue Jays and Astros and 2 DRS in LF rank tied for second most with the Rays, behind the Mariners (3).
- **Jordan Lawlar** (11th - 2 DRS) and **Jose Fernandez** (12th - 2 DRS) rank in the top 12 players...8 others at 2 DRS...Cole Young/SEA and Randy Arozarena/SEA at 3 DRS.

TRENDING: Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 home games since Sept. 15, 2025, with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI and 7 walks.

- Yesterday, he ended his on-base streak at 22 games...dated back to Sept. 9, 2025 and was the Majors' second longest active on-base streak...marked his longest on-base streak of his career (combined seasons).
- Has reached base in 22 of his last 23 games with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 13 walks (12 K).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 28 home games since Aug. 6, 2025, batting .340 (35-for-103)/1.143 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 triples, 7 homers, 24 RBI, 18 walks and 12 stolen bases.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in his last 9 home games since Sep. 19, 2025, batting .333 (12-for-36)/.928 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 5 RBI.
- **Jordan Lawlar** has hit safely in his last 7 home starts since Sep. 2, 2025, batting .409 (9-for-22)/.940 OPS with 2 doubles and 3 RBI.

VS. BRAVES: The D-backs have won 4 straight games (1 @ home, 3 on road).

- In their last win on June 5 @ Braves, the D-backs scored a historic 7 unanswered runs in the ninth inning en route to an 11-10 comeback win.
- Among active NL players vs. Braves since 2024, **Ketel Marte** ranks in OPS (2nd, 1.260), SLG (2nd, .825), homers (T-2nd, 6) and AVG (10th, .350).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely 2+ times in 4 straight games, hitting .400 (6-for-15)/1.133 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 4 straight games, batting .313 (5-for-16) with 1 double and 4 RBI.
