TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today activated from the 10-day injured list **INF/OF Connor Joe** (Hand, Mouth, and Foot Disease); optioned to AAA-Louisville **OF Rece Hinds**.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of a 4-game series vs Adam Nichols' Marlins and the first game of a 7-game homestand before the All-Star break that includes a weekend series vs the Rockies.
- Following Sun's "first-half" finale vs Col, the Reds will enjoy 4-day break before lifting the lid on the season's "second half" at NYM (7/18-7/20) and Wsh (7/21-7/23).
- The Reds are coming off a 2-4 road trip at **Bos** (1-2) and **Phi** (1-2).

ELLY DE LA ALL-STAR: On Sun, **SS Elly De La Cruz** was named to the National League All-Star team for the second consecutive season.

- He's the first Reds player to be selected as an All-Star in back-to-back years since **Joey Votto** (2017-18).
- Is the <u>sixth</u> primary shortstop in Reds history to make consecutive All-Star teams, joining Barry Larkin (1988-91, '93-'97, '99-2000), David Concepcion (1975-82), Leo Cardenas (1964-66), Roy McMillan (1955-57), and Eddie Miller (1943-44, '46-'47).
- Is the seventh Red to earn multiple All-Star selections within his first 3 career seasons, the first since **Chris Sabo** (1988, '90).
- Joins Johnny Bench (4, 1968-71), Frank Robinson (3, 1956-59), and Vada Pinson (2, 1959-60) as the only Reds players named to multiple All-Star teams before turning 24.

FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS: Terry Francona enters tonight's game 4 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (**Tex' Bruce Bochy** 2,215).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for **Bochy** and **Dusty Baker**, are in the Hall of Fame.
- **Baker** (2,183) and **Sparky Anderson** (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
 Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining Bochy (SF), Bucky Harris (Det), and John McGraw (NYG).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds are 135-104 all-time vs the **Marlins**, including 42-27 here at **Great American Ball Park**.

- Cin went 1-2 at Mia from 4/21-4/23 when the roof was open at loanDepot park for all 3 games...it marked the Reds' first series loss to the Marlins since 8/7-8/9, 2023 at GABP (1-2).
- The Reds have gone 24-13 over the last 7 seasons (6-1 in 2019, 0-0 in 2020, 5-2 in 2021, 4-3 in 2022, 3-3 in 2023, 5-2 in 2024, <u>1-2 in 2025</u>) following 4 straight season series losses to the **Marlins**.

HARD TO SWALLOW: The Reds have lost 17 games this season in which they held a lead, including 3 times on the recently-completed road trip (7/5 & 7/6 at **Phi**; 7/1 at **Bos**).

- Have been held to 1 hit in a game 3 times this season, including yesterday at **Phi** (**Zack Wheeler**, 1-hit CG).
- Cin is 2-35 this year when trailing after 7 innings.
- Are 1-38 when trailing after 8 innings, their lone victory in that scenario coming on 6/29 vs SD (trailed 2-1 entering the 9th inning, won 3-2).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 29 series this season, including the recently-completed 3-game set at **Phi** (1-2).

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when they went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs Phi.
- The Reds are the only Major League team that have yet to be swept this season.

ELLECTRICITY: Over his last 42 games dating back to 5/19, SS Elly De La Cruz is slashing .313/.385/.581 (50-for-160, 10hr, 21xbh, 38r, 19bb, 29rbi).

- His 60 RBI in 2025 are most by a primary Reds shortstop (>50% of G at the position) before the All-Star break in club history (the first ASG was in 1933), surpassing the previous mark of 52 set by **Barry Larkin** 1999...are also the most ever by a Cin switch hitter prior to the ASB.
- Is batting .294/.376/.532 this season <u>vs RHP</u> (68-for-231, 13hr, 44rbi).
- <u>Against left-handed pitchers in June</u>, slashed .338/.442/.646 (3hr).
 Is 2 HR shy of joining **Eric Davis** (23hr/33sb, 1987) as the only players
- in Reds history with at least 20 HR and 20 SB before the All-Star break.
 Swiped his 20th base of 2025 in the 4th inning of the 1-0 win on 6/10 at Cle, making him the first player in Reds history with 20 or more steals in each of his first 3 seasons in the majors (*courtesy Elias*).

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 27 times this season, but haven't plated a run in the opening frame since 6/28 vs **SD**, a span of 7 straight games without a 1st inning run.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: C Alfredo Duno and INF Sal Stewart on Mon were selected to represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the All-Star Futures Game, which will take place on 7/12 at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor in the decision in the 5-3 loss at Bos on 7/1 (3.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 4k, 56TP).

• The game was suspended due to weather in the top of the 4th inning and completed the next day...LHP Sam Moll took over for Singer on the mound when play resumed the following afternoon.

JUNE 25 vs NYY: Suffered the 7-1 loss on 6/25 vs NYY (5.0ip, 6h, 4r/4er, 3bb, 9k, 1hb, 1hr, 103TP).

- His 9 strikeouts were a season-high and his most since 8/12/24 for KC at Min (9k).
- Entered the game having allowed 3 runs or fewer in 7 consecutive starts...matched the longest-such streak of his career (also: 6/6-7/7, 2021 for KC).

JUNE 20 at StL: Suffered the 6-1 loss on 6/20 at StL (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 7k, 1hb, 102TP).

• It was his second consecutive quality start.

• Was his seventh consecutive start of allowing 3 earned runs or fewer, matching his career-best for the third time.

JUNE 14 at DET : Earned the 11-1 win on 6/14 at Det (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 3bb, 4k, 1hb, 96TP).

- It was his fifth quality start of the season and the 54th of his career.
- It marked his fifth start this season in which he didn't allow a home run...has been reached for 2 home runs total over his last 5 starts (28ip).

JUNE 8 vs AZ: Didn't factor in the decision in the 4-2 win vs AZ on 6/8 (5.0ip, 5h, 2r/2er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 77TP).

- When he left the game at the end of the 5th, the score was tied, 2-2.
- Was hit in the right arm by a line drive comebacker off the bat of Lourds Gurriel Jr. in the 4th inning.

JUNE 2 vs MIL: Suffered the 3-2 loss vs Mil on 6/2 (5.0ip, 4h, 3r/3er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 97TP).

- Gave up a 2nd-inning double to Andruw Monasterio, his first XBH allowed in 13.0ip and 52 BF.
- Threw 70 pitches through 3.0 innings.
- Threw 16 first-pitch strikes to his 21 batters.

MAY 27 at KC: Earned the 7-2 win at KC on 5/27 (7.0ip, 7h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 3k, 99TP).

- Was his first career appearance vs the Royals...was drafted by KC in the first round in 2018 and made 127 apps there from 2020-2024...has now faced all 30 teams.
- Matched a season-high with 7.0 innings.
- Retired 10 straight batters before allowing a 2-out single in

WITH 2 STRIKES: Enters tonight's game having not allowed a hit to any of the last 32 batters with which he's reached 2 strikes...the last 2-strike batter to whom he allowed a hit was StL's Thomas Saggese in the 2nd inning on 6/20.

ANSWERS THE CALL: Since his 2020 debut his 141 starts rank 14th in the majors while his 6774.0 innings rank 18th.

PERSONAL: Played collegiately at the University of Florida where he was named 2018 SEC Pitcher of the Year and winner of the Dick Howser Trophy...was named *Baseball America* College Player of the Year in 2018 and a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award... helped lead the Gators to the school's first NCAA College World Series championship in 2017...struck out 12 vs LSU in Game One of the CWS finals, the most strikeouts in the championship round since at least 2003...was teammates at Florida with another 2018 firstround pick, Jonathan India, for whom he was traded in 2024...Graduated from Eustis High School (FL), the same school attended by 1972 Nobel Prize winner John Robert Schrieffer, former NASA astronaut David Walker, and former Reds catcher Chris Okey.
