Interleague

The Braves beat the Blue Jays yesterday, 4-3, to move to 16-9 (.640) in interleague play this season.

Their 16 interleague wins rank third in Major League Baseball behind the Milwaukee Brewers (18) and Cincinnati Reds (17).

Nine of the 15 National League clubs are above .500 in interleague play, compared to just three in the American League.

The NL has played to a .560 interleague winning percentage so far this season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Blue Jays today continue a three-game midweek series with the second of three games between the clubs this season...This is their only scheduled meeting this year.

A The Braves dropped last season's series to the Blue Jays in Canada, 2-1...Since 2021, Atlanta's .250 winning percentage (4-12) against Toronto is its worst against any single opponent.

A The Braves endured a nine-game losing streak against the Blue Jays from 2021-2023...Atlanta was outscored 57-27 (-30) during that stretch, wherein its pitching staff logged a 5.94 ERA (51 ER/77.1 IP).

A Despite that period, the Braves have only lost one series to the Blue Jays here at Truist Park since the venue opened in 2017, playing to a 3-1-2 series record.

A RH Grant Holmes is 1-0 in one start (two appearances) against the Blue Jays with a 6.48 ERA (6 ER/8.1 IP)...He's allowed three earned runs in both appearances, first in 0.2 innings of relief on September 7, 2024 at Truist Park, then across 7.2 innings of his start at Rogers Centre on April 14, 2025.

FACING CORBIN: LH Patrick Corbin tonight will make his 22nd career start (24th appearance) against the Braves after facing them 14 times while the Nationals and nine times with the Diamondbacks...Corbin is 6-12 against Atlanta all-time, but is 0-11 against the club in his last 12 turns dating to September 6, 2019.

A Corbin's 11-game losing streak is currently tied for the third-longest against the Braves in modern franchise history...Paul Minner (1951-56) and Eppa Rixey (1916-20) each lost 12 straight decisions against the Braves.

A Arizona's Merrill Kelly is the most recent pitcher to endure a single-team losing streak as long as Corbin's...He is 0-11 in his 17 career starts against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

A Should Corbin's streak be extended, MLB-wide, the last pitcher to suffer a 12-game losing streak to the same team was Mark Buehrle, who lost 12 consecutive decisions to the New York Yankees from 2004-14.

A Corbin's team is winless in the last 12 games he has started against Atlanta...His club last won one of his Braves-facing starts on July 29, 2019, when the Nationals beat Dallas Kuechel and the Braves, 6-3.

A From September 6, 2019-July 15, 2022, Corbin was dealt a loss in nine straight games against Atlanta (without a no-decision in-between)...Minner and Rixey's 12 losses all came consecutively, while Dave Koslo was charged with a loss in 10 straight starts against the Braves from 1942-48.

A Corbin's first 27.2 career innings against the Braves were all scoreless...He owns a 5.87 ERA in the following 89.0 innings...All-time, he has gone 6-12 against Atlanta with a 4.55 ERA (58 ER/114.2 IP).

THE BULLPEN: The back end of Atlanta's bullpen pitched the final 2.1 innings against the Blue Jays last night, as RHP Robert Suarez and RHP Raisel Iglesias held Toronto scoreless while whiffing three batters.

A Suarez (0.68) and Iglesias (0.96) comprise one of two pitching duos in MLB with sub-1.00 ERAs (min. 10 games)...Mason Miller (0.72) and Jason Adam (0.89) have also done so for San Diego... Apart from the aforementioned four players, only six other pitchers in MLB have a sub-1.00 ERA and at least 10 appearances.

A Individually, Suarez owns the second-best ERA (0.68) in MLB among pitchers with as many appearances (26)...Toronto's Louis Varland (0.29) is the only hurler with a better mark.

A Iglesias earned the save yesterday and is still perfect across his 11 opportunities this season...He has converted his last 29 save chances dating to July 23, 2025, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball...The stretch has already surpassed his previous career-long streak, which was 21 games-long and spanned the 2021-22 seasons.

A RHP Craig Kimbrel was the last Brave to post a longer save streak, stringing together 37 straight from May 9-September 14, 2013...He finished fourth in NL Cy Young Award voting that season.

OZZIE ALBIES: Logged two of Atlanta's four RBI and was productive in each of his four plate appearances, going 2-for-2 with a pair of singles, a walk, and a sacrifice fly...It's his third multi-hit game in his last eight contests.

A The effort improved his batting average with runners in scoring position to .346 (18-for-52), good for ninth in the NL.

A Within those eight games, dating to May 24 versus Washington, the switch-hitter has slashed .375/.400/.531 (12-for-32)...His batting average is tied alongside teammate Michael Harris II for the fourth-best in the National League in that time.

A Defensively, according to Statcast, the second baseman has posted four outs above average, ranking in the 94th percentile MLB-wide.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Patrick Corbin this evening...The team enters play 18-7 (.720) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins in such games in the majors this year.

A The Tampa Bay Rays are the only team with a better winning percentage when facing a left-handed starter (.750, 12-4)

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 184-106 (.634) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .622 (204-124).

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 15 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 11-4 record in those games.

Today's Game

Makes his 12th start of the season and the 40th of his career in the second game of a three-game series against Toronto at Truist Park.

Owns a 1-0 record and a 6.48 ERA (6 ER/8.1 IP) in two career appearances against Toronto, one a start...His lone start, April 14, 2025, produced a career-high 7.2 innings in an 8-4 win at Rogers Centre, when he allowed two hits and three runs with two walks and four strikeouts.

Received a no-decision in his last turn May 29 at Cincinnati, allowing three runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings with one walk and five strikeouts on 80 pitches in Atlanta's 8-3 win at Great American Ball Park...Made his first career appearance at the ballpark.

Enters with a streak of 32 consecutive appearances issuing at least one walk, dating to March 31, 2025, the 20th-longest active such streak in the majors.

Has posted four quality starts over 11 outings this season, going 3-2 with a 3.95 ERA (25 ER/57.0 IP) and 53 strikeouts...Is holding opposing hitters to a .234 average (51-for-218).

Has issued 25 walks and surrendered 11 home runs through 11 starts, equating to a 3.95 BB/9 and a 1.74 HR/9.

Has generated 36 of his 53 strikeouts this season with his slider, tied for the fourth-most slider strikeouts in the majors among pitchers with at least 10 starts.

Hitters are missing 42.4 percent of their swings against the pitch, the third-highest slider whiff rate among pitchers with at least 300 thrown.

Has held opponents 0-for-7 with the bases loaded in 2026.

Needs four strikeouts to reach 250 for his career.

His 39 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

2026

Received a no-decision May 29 at Cincinnati, allowing three runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings with one walk and five strikeouts on 80 pitches in the 8-3 win at Great American Ball Park...Two runs scored on solo home runs in the fourth inning; the third came home after he departed.

Took the loss May 23 against Washington, allowing two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 2-0 defeat at Truist Park...Both Washington runs came on solo home runs...Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career, his first of 2026, and fanned the side in order in the first inning, the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.

Earned the win May 17 against Boston, allowing no runs on five hits over 6.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 8-1 victory at Truist Park...A rain delay ended his afternoon.

Received a no-decision May 12 against Chicago (NL), allowing two earned runs on one hit over 4.0 innings with four walks and five strikeouts on 78 pitches in the 5-2 win at Truist Park...Was the seventh Braves pitcher since 2000 to allow two-plus earned runs while exiting a start having surrendered one hit or fewer, and the first since Spencer Strider on June 15, 2022 at Washington (5.2 IP, 1 H, 2 ER).

Was charged with five earned runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision May 1 at Colorado, scattering seven hits with three walks and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 8-6 win at Coors Field...The six total runs allowed tied his career high, last reached April 26, 2025 at Arizona.

Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.

Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

Career Recap

Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).

In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.

In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.

Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.

Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Strippers relievers in strikeouts (74).

Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.

Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).

On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.

Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.

Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
