games in St. Louis, followed by two wins in three games at Chicago-AL...today, Minnesota will open its 16th season at Target Field with three games in four days against the Astros... they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then play games two and three on Saturday and Sunday... after this series, the Twins will travel to Kansas City for four games from Monday-Thursday.

TWINS GO DEEP DISH: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-1, winning the series, their first of the season...Pablo López (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Carlos Correa, Byron Buxton and Ty France... Correa snapped an 0-for-18 to start his season, recording a third-inning single...Buxton hit his first home run of the season, a 446-foot shot, the third-longest in baseball of 2025 (Judge - 468 ft and Bellinger - 451 ft)...Harrison Bader hit his team-leading third home run of the season, one of 19 players in baseball to hit at least three homers.

MINNESOTA NICE: The Twins are opening their 16th season at Target Field today...they are 36-28 all-time in Home Openers, going 12-9 at Metropolitan Stadium from 1961-81, 16-12 at the Metrodome from 1982-2009, and 8-7 at Target Field since 2010...Twins have won six of their last eight Home Openers.

♣ Twins lost their Home Opener last season, a 4-2 defeat by the Guardians.

♣ Twins are hosting Houston in a Home Opener for the second time in their history, the previous time came on April 7, 2023, a 3-2, 10-inning victory as Kyle Farmer singled in Trevor Larnach for the win — the fifth walk-off winner in Twins Home Opener history (since 1961).

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Last season, the Twins went 43-38 at Target Field...they began the year with a home record of 34-21 through August 9, then finished 9-17.

◆ The Twins have an all-time record at Target Field of 594-571 (.510).

◆ Minnesota slashed .257/.328/437 (.765 OPS) and scored 4.8 runs-per-game at home last season, compared to .236/.303/.385 (.688 OPS) with 4.4 runs-per-game on the road.

SPACEBALLS: The Twins went 4-2 against the Astros last season, going 2-1 at Minute Maid Park from May 31-June 2 and 2-1 at Target Field from July 5-7...they won the season series for the second-straight season (4-2 in 2023) and fourth time in their last five tries.

After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Fivins have gone 8-4 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023...in that span, they have outscored the 'Stros 65-52.

The Iwins are 43-46 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 32-37 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

Jose Miranda hit. 556 (10-for-18) with two doubles, two home runs and six RBI in six games against the Astros last season — he faced Houston in the middle of his historic run of 12 hits in 12 consecutive at-bats, which tied Johnny Kling (1902), Pinky Higgins (1938) and Walt Dropo (1952) for an AL/NL record.

Christian Vazquez hit .364 (4-for-11) with one double, one home run and four RBI in three games against Houston last season.

Byron Buxton hit .304 (7-for-23) with one double and one home run in six games vs. HOU.

Over the three-game series that Minnesota hosted the Astros last July, Twins batters hit .385 (42-for-109) with five home runs (Miranda, Buxton, Correa, Lee and Vazquez) and a 1.021 OPS, scoring 8.0 runs-per-game.
