**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (1-2 at Washington and 2-1 at Cleveland), the Twins began their nine-game homestand with a 2-1 series win over the Marlins this week...tonight, Minnesota will play the first of three against Milwaukee through the weekend...after this series, they will host Houston for three games from Monday-Wednesday. ☞ Twins have won four of their last five games...they are also 6-4 over their last 10 games since May 3, after going 3-13 during a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.

**TWO WORDS: NAZ-REID SIX TEN:** Due to Game 6 of the Wolves-Spurs Western Conference Semifinals across the street tonight at Target Center, the Twins-Brewers start time is 6:10, rather than 7:10 as previously scheduled...gates open at 4:00 pm for pregame Happy Hour, featuring \$2 beers, \$2 hot dogs, \$2 snacks and a live performance by The Johnny Holm Band.

**ZEBBY MATTHEWS' FISH FRY:** The Twins beat the Marlins yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 9-1, winning their second-straight series...Zebby Matthews (1-0) made his 2026 debut, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts, throwing just 83 pitches...the offense recorded nine hits, as Austin Martin, Ryan Kreidler and James Outman each reached safely three times apiece...Outman set a season-high with three RBI and hit his third double of 2026...the offense also went 6-for-12 with runners in scoring position and left just five men on base.

**BORDER BATTLE, WINNER GETS MOLITOR:** The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the first of six games this season...Minnesota will travel to Wisconsin for three games at American Family Field from August 7-9.

☞ Twins went 2-4 against Milwaukee last season, going 2-1 at AFF from May 16-18 and 0-3 at Target Field from June 20-22.

☞ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 41 home runs in 30 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent...they have homered 24 times over their last 16 games vs. the Crew.

☞ Over his last 17 games vs. Milwaukee, Josh Bell is hitting .375 (21-for-56) with 12 RBI, a .643 slugging percentage and a 1.106 OPS.

☞ Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in seven-straight vs. the Brewers...over eight career games vs. Milwaukee, he is slashing .308/.400/.577 (.977 OPS).

**TAKE IT ON THE OTHERSIDE:** Twins have gone just 4-8 against National League opponents this season, going 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23), 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7) and 2-1 vs. Miami this week.

**JEFF'S KISS:** Over his last 15 games, since April 23, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 12 runs scored, 10 walks, a .429 on-base percentage, a .635 slugging percentage and a 1.063 OPS...since that date, his slugging percentage ranks fifth in the AL (min. 60 PA) and his OPS ranks sixth.

**KEEP AUSTIN WEIRD:** Austin Martin reached base safely three more times yesterday afternoon (2 hits, 1 walk)...he is one of 24 players in baseball to reach three times in a game at least 10 times...Martin is hitting .333 with a .454 on-base percentage on the season...among players with a minimum of 125 plate appearances, Martin's on-base percentage leads baseball, while his batting average ranks fourth, trailing Brandon Marsh (.340), Shea Langeliers (.340) and Otto Lopez (.339).

☞ He has posted a BB/K ratio of 1.22 (22 BB/18 K), third-best in baseball (min. 130 PA), trailing Luis Arraez (1.43) and Chase DeLauter (1.25).

**FAST BREAK:** Twins stole two more bases yesterday (Martin & Keaschall), giving them 11 over their last four games...Minnesota now has stolen 24 bases in its last 18 games, since April 25...in that span, they rank second in baseball in stolen bases, trailing Cleveland (29)...in those games, Minnesota is 24-for-27 in stolen base attempts.

**HEIST TEAM:** Twins have stolen multiple bags in four-straight (3, 4, 2, 2) for the first time since April 15-18, 2004...below are the club's all-time multiple stolen base streaks, since 1961...they have never done it in five-straight:

**CAUTION, WALKERS:** After drawing six walks last night, the Twins have drawn 173 walks on the season, fifth-most in the AL, trailing New York (200), Cleveland (190), Seattle (176) and Baltimore (174).

☞ Twins have a .325 on-base percentage on the season, ranking fifth-best in the AL, trailing Houston (.330), Tampa Bay (.330), New York (.330) and the Athletics (.328).

### THIS AND THAT:

☞ James Outman is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with an .868 OPS over his last 15 games...he began the season 0-for-his-first-18 through games of April 18.

☞ Ryan Kreidler has reached base safely in five-straight games for the Twins...over those five, he has posted a .556 on-base percentage.

☞ Brooks Lee has not committed an error in his last 31 games (112 total chances).

☞ Kody Clemens's five defensive runs saved are T-most among MLB first basemen this season, with BAL's Pete Alonso, per Fangraphs.

☞ Lee is hitting .311 (23-for-74) with an .822 OPS over his last 19 games.

☞ Twins defense has turned six double plays over its last seven games, since May 7...since that date, only two AL teams have turned as many (Cleveland - 8, Baltimore - 6).

☞ Twins bullpen has gone 2-1, 3.25 ERA (27.2 IP, 10 ER) with a .231 opponent batting average over their last six games.

☞ Twins starters finished the three-game series vs. Miami with a 2.84 ERA (19.0 IP, 6 ER) with a .191 opponent batting average.

☞ Royce Lewis has reached base in six-straight...his career-high is 11 (done twice, in 2023 and 2025) and his season-high is eight (April 1-9).

**PARTY AT MORNEAU'S HOUSE:** Kody Clemens is celebrating his 30th birthday today...Twins Hall of Famer and Twins.TV analyst Justin Morneau is celebrating his 45th birthday and former Twin Brian Dozier is celebrating his 39th birthday today...Morneau's four homers on his birthday are the most in Twins/Senators history...Clemens has played two major league games on his birthday, going 0-for-3 with two walks and three strikeouts.

- ☞ Is 1-1 with a 3.18 ERA (22.2 IP, 8 ER), six walks, 25 strikeouts and a .179 (14-for-78) BAA in four career starts against Milwaukee.
- ☞ In his last start on May 9 at Cleveland, Ryan did not factor into the decision despite making a quality start, firing 6.0 innings of one-run, two-hit ball, with three walks and five strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ryan made his ninth start of the season on May 9 at Cleveland opposite right-hander Tanner Bibee...made his fourth quality start of the season but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on two hits through 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts, as the Twins defeated the Guardians 2-1 in 11 innings...fired a season-high 107 pitches, his most since throwing 110 pitches on July 6, 2024 vs. Houston.

- ☞ The outing was Joe's fourth quality start in his last six outings dating back to April 11 at Toronto, his first time recording four quality starts in a six-start span since doing so from July 1-August 1, 2025.
- ☞ Despite the stellar outing, Ryan did not receive the win, extending his winless streak vs. Cleveland to eight consecutive starts since May 7, 2023.
- ☞ His only blemish came on a fourth-inning single from Kyle Manzardo that drove in Cleveland's lone run.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan made his eighth start of the season on May 3 vs. Toronto opposite right-hander Trey Yesavage...struck out Yohendrick Piñango to begin the game, then walked Kazuma Okamoto...was removed from the game after just nine pitches with right elbow soreness.

- ☞ The outing marked the shortest of his career, with his previous low being 2.0 innings pitched on August 7, 2024 at Chicago-NL and on September 6, 2025 at Kansas City.
- ☞ The last time the Twins had a starter go 0.1 innings was when Steven Okert served as an opener on July 24, 2024 vs. Philadelphia; the last true starter to go 0.1 innings was Matt Shoemaker on June 24, 2021 at Kansas City.

**RY-VALRY WEEKEND:** This will mark Ryan's fifth career start against the Brew Crew...he is 1-1 with a 3.18 ERA (22.2 IP, 8 ER), six walks, 25 strikeouts, a 0.88 WHIP and a .179 (14-for-78) BAA...Ryan faced Milwaukee twice in 2025 and combined to go 1-1 with a 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP, 3 ER), including a scoreless, two-hit effort across 6.0 innings pitched on May 16, 2025 to help the Twins defeat the Brewers 3-0 at American Family Field.

- ☞ Ryan has faced 11 hitters on the Brewers' active roster; those hitters have combined for a .203 (14-for-69) BAA with four doubles, no home runs, five walks and 21 strikeouts.
- ☞ This start will break a tie with San Francisco for the most starts by Ryan against a National League opponent.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** Ryan is set to make his 35th start vs. a National League opponent, the most Interleague starts in Twins history since the beginning of Interleague Play in 1997...below are some more of his numbers against the National League, compared to other pitchers in Twins history since 1997:

- ☞ Ryan is 11-14, 4.53 ERA (180.2 IP, 91 ER) with 42 walks, 204 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .240 (168-for-699) BAA in 34 career starts against the National League.
- ☞ In 2026, Ryan is 0-1 with a 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks and 11 strikeouts in two starts in Interleague contests.
- ☞ In Joe's first 14 Interleague starts, the Twins owned an 8-6 record, but have gone just 5-15 since, including losses in four straight dating back to September 13, 2025 vs. Arizona.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 61 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.93 ERA (336.2 IP, 147 ER), 77 walks and 354 strikeouts, compared to 27-19 with a 3.61 ERA (349.1 IP, 140 ER), 84 walks and 410 strikeouts in 63 home appearances (62 starts).

- ☞ Excluding his most recent home start on May 3 vs. Toronto in which he was removed from the game after just 0.1 innings pitched due to right elbow soreness, Ryan has recorded a quality start in back-to-back outings; the Twins lost both contests and gave Joe a combined two runs of support.
- ☞ The Twins offense has provided Joe with one-or-fewer runs of support in six of his last 10 home starts dating back to July 26, 2025 vs. Washington; he was tagged with the loss in five of those six games.
- ☞ Since the start of the 2025 season, Ryan's 123 strikeouts at home are tied for eighth most in the American League.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, lefties are slashing .219/.279/.385 (21-for-96) with seven doubles, three home runs, five walks and 24 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .179/.260/.254 (12-for-67) with five doubles, eight walks and 21 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .216/.276/.386 (274-for-1,267) with 88 walks and 317 strikeouts (3.60 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.273/.414 (293-for-1,303) with 73 walks and 447 strikeouts (6.12 K/BB).

- ☞ Ryan's 6.12 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

- ☞ Ryan's curveball ranks fourth among major league pitchers with a .074 (2-for-27) BAA and is sixth with a 48.3 strikeout percentage (min. 25 plate appearances).
- ☞ His four-seamer has a 24.5% whiff percentage, which ranks ninth among all pitchers in Major League Baseball (min. 300 pitches).

- In 2026, was invited to participate in the World Baseball Classic as a member of Team USA.
- In 2025, made first career MLB All-Star Game appearance, throwing a 10-pitch perfect fourth inning with two strikeouts (SD Manny Machado and CHC Kyle Tucker).
- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive year in the Twins' season-opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
