TODAY'S GAME: SF will try to claim a series victory to close out the unofficial first half this afternoon in its final game of the series with the Rockies...SF is 3-3 thus far on this homestand (1-2 vs. Toronto and 2-1 vs. Colorado).

- ▶ By winning yesterday's game 4-2, the Giants secured a split in this four-game set with the Rockies...SF has won each of its last seven home series against the Rockies dating to September 2022 and can make it eight home series wins with a win today.
- ▶ Sunday's at home have been kind to the Giants in 2026 with the club going 5-1 in their Sunday day games at home...the lone loss came in their first Sunday day game of the year versus the Mets.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Jason Foley (#64) has been returned from his rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day injured list...RHP Spencer Bivens was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame yesterday.

- ▶ Foley will be seeking his Giants debut after signing during the offseason...he last pitched in the Majors for the Tigers during the 2024 Postseason, making one relief appearance.
- ▶ The 30-year-old missed most of last season recovering from right shoulder surgery to repair his anterior capsule.

VS. THE ROCKIES: SF is 4-5 against the Rockies in 2026 with the five losses being the most in a single-season vs. Colorado since SF went 14-5 vs. the Rockies back in 2022...however, the Giants have won 20 of their last 22 home games against Colorado dating to July 8, 2023.

- ▶ Since 2021, the Giants are 35-7 (.833) against the Rockies here at Oracle Park...they've outscored Colorado 237-114 (+123 run diff) in that time.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Trevor McDonald gets the final start before the break in today's finale...the start will be his 13th of the season at the Major League level.

- ▶ McDonald took one on the chin last time out, allowing a career-high eight runs on a career-high 11 hits on Tuesday versus the Blue Jays in the Giants' 9-3 loss.
- ▶ Today's outing will be the second of his career versus the Rockies...he picked up his first career win against Colorado last year when he allowed three unearned runs over 7.0 innings while striking out 10 in a Giants win on September 26 here at Oracle Park.

ON THE EDGE: Both IF Rafael Devers and IF Casey Schmitt enter today with 19 homers and are trying to become the first Giant since Barry Bonds in 2004 (23 homers) to reach the 20-homer mark before the All-Star break.

KEY & DAKOTA: IF Gavin Kilen (*KEY-lin*), SF's #4 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and OF Dakota Jordan (#5) represent the Giants in today's Futures Game presented by Nike.

- ▶ Kilen, SF's first round pick out of Tennessee last year, is slashing .282/.350/.462 (.812 OPS) with 27 doubles, nine homers, 65 RBI and 49 runs in 78 games for High-A Eugene...he ranks among the Northwest League leaders in doubles (1st), RBI (2nd), extra-base hits (37, 2nd), hits (88, 4th), total bases (144, 4th) and average (8th).
- ▶ Jordan, taken in the fourth round of the 2024 draft, has also raked for Eugene, slashing .290/.346/.533 (.879 OPS) with 22 doubles, 18 homers, 66 RBI, 50 runs scored and 15 stolen bases...he leads the NWL in RBI, extra-base hits (41) and total bases (171), is tied for the league lead in homers and also ranks among the NWL leaders in SLG (.533, 2nd), hits (93, 2nd), average (.290, 6th), doubles (3rd) and runs (T-5th).

SPEAKING OF THE FUTURE....: The 2026 First-Year Player Draft concludes today with rounds 5-20 and begins at 8:30 a.m. PT.

- ▶ With their fourth-selection yesterday, SF selected local product RHP Jackson Flora out of UC Santa Barbara with the fourth overall pick...Flora grew up in nearby Plesanton and went to Foothill High School (the same school as former Giants IF Brandon Crawford).
- ▶ Flora was one of four pitchers taken by the Giants on Day 1...the lone non-pitcher was OF Peyton Bonds out of Rutgers in the third round...Peyton is the nephew of MLB's Home Run King and Giants Legend Barry Bonds...[click here](#) for the full release from yesterday.

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Stumbled in his last outing against the Blue Jays on Tuesday in SF's 9-3 loss at Oracle Park...he allowed a career-high eight runs on a career-high 11 hits while working just 2.1 innings... he became the third starter in team history to pitch 2.1 innings or fewer and allow 11 (or more) hits...the only other two times it happened were May 13, 1998 when **Mark Gardner** gave up 11 hits in 2.1 innings vs. Montreal and September 10, 1966 when **Gaylord Perry** also gave up 11 hits in 2.1 innings.

TOUGH RUN: Outside of his 6.0 innings of one-hit, scoreless ball versus Arizona on July 1, it's been a rough six weeks for McDonald since May 22...in nine starts since that day, McDonald has a 6.92 ERA (31er, 40.1ip), allowing 46 hits in those 40.1 innings while walking 17 and striking out 33...opponents are hitting .284 with a .767 OPS off him in this stretch...his 6.92 ERA since May 22 is the fifth-highest in the Majors (min. seven games started in that span) and fourth-highest in the NL...the A's Jeffrey Springs has the highest ERA in this span (8.86).

DIG IN: During this nine-game stretch, batters have slashed .324/.407/.392 (.799 OPS) off his sinker compared to .255/.300/.319 (.619 OPS) off the sinker in his first three outings...in his start on Tuesday vs. Toronto, Jays' hitters were 9-for-15 with eight singles off his sinker...the nine hits were the most hits vs. one pitcher's sinker by any team in a game this season (per *SIS*)...another bugaboo during his tough stretch has been walks...he's walked 17 batters in 40.1 innings, carrying a 10.1% walk rate in this time.

VS. COLORADO: Will face the Rockies today to close the unofficial first half...it's his second career outing and start against Colorado with his first coming last September where he picked up the first win of his Major League career...he allowed three unearned runs on four hits in 7.0 innings while striking out a career-best 10 batters in the Giants' 6-3 win here at Oracle Park.

EXTREME SPLITS: In his 12 starts at the MLB level this year, McDonald has limited right-handed hitters to a .202 average with a .515 OPS and just three extra-base hits allowed (all doubles)...lefties, however, have a .318 average with a .904 OPS off McDonald...lefties have eight doubles, a triple and five homers.

GROUNDDED: Entering this start he owns a 55.4% groundball rate, which sits in the 95th percentile among Major Leaguers...his 55.4% groundball rate is fifth-best in the Majors if you lower the innings threshold to 55.0...he trails WSH's Brad Lord (58.6%), PHI's Christopher Sánchez (57.6%), LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (57.2%) and STL's Andre Pallante (55.7%).

ORDER UP...: He's been most effective the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 19-for-98 (.194) with a .629 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .301 with a .758 OPS the second time through and .341 with an .872 OPS the third time through.

HERE AT HOME: Owns a 7.94 ERA (25er, 28.1ip) here at home with opposing hitters batting .299 with a .791 OPS off him...on the road, however, he owns a 3.19 ERA (11er, 31.0ip) with a .671 opponent's OPS.
