NOT EVEN CLOSE, NOT EVEN A LITTLE BIT: The Giants look to win the series in today's finale after splitting the first two games of this three-game set at Seattle...SF is trying to win its first road series since June 16-18 at Atlanta, and its sixth road series overall.

- ▶ Last night's loss prevented SF's first four-game winning streak of the season with 98 games played...according to *Stats, LLC*, the Giants' 98 games to start this season without a four-game winning streak is the longest drought in franchise history over a single season (previous high was a 96-game stretch without a four-game winning streak to start the 2006 season).
- ▶ The Giants are 42-56 (.429), which is tied for the fifth-lowest winning percentage in MLB in 2026, and third-lowest in the NL ahead of the Mets (41-58, .414) and Rockies (40-60, .400).
- ▶ The Giants' 56 losses through the team's first 98 games are their most since losing 61 of 98 to start the 2017 season.
- ▶ SF is 7-4 in rubber games in 2026.

YOU CAN'T JUST BUY ME A GUITAR EVERY TIME YOU SCREW UP, YOU KNOW?: **LHP Robbie Ray** is set to close out the series against his former team...Ray pitched two seasons with Seattle (2022-2023) before being traded to SF prior to 2024...he is 2-1 with a 3.23 ERA (14er, 39.0ip), 40 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in seven career starts vs. the Mariners.

- ▶ The lefty went 8-6 with a 3.38 ERA (40er, 106.2ip), 90 strikeouts and a 1.27 WHIP in 19 games (18 starts) in the first half.
- ▶ Ray is 4-0 with a 1.08 ERA (4er, 33.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 0.99 WHIP in his last five outings (four starts).
- ▶ Giants starters have thrown at least 6.0 innings in each of the last four games, which is the longest streak for SF starters since April 17-20, 2025...SF's last five-game streak of starters throwing 6.0+ innings in each game was August 12-17, 2022.

YOU'RE NOT AS MEAN AS YOU THINK YOU ARE, YOU KNOW THAT?: SF had its four-game winning streak vs. the Mariners snapped last night.

- ▶ Since the start of the 2024 season, six of the eight games between Seattle and SF were decided by one run with three going to extra innings...SF is 5-3 in that span vs. Seattle.
- ▶ SF is 9-14 (.391) in interleague games this season, which is the fourth-lowest interleague winning percentage in MLB, and lowest in the NL.
- ▶ Seattle starter Logan Gilbert's most-used pitch is his four-seamer (39.3% usage rate)...the Giants' .259 batting average vs. four-seamers is ninth-best in MLB.
- ▶ **IF Rafael Devers** has a career .317 (59x186) batting average vs. SEA, which is the best among all active players with at least 150 career plate appearances vs. SEA (*Stats, LLC*).

THAT'S FOR MAKING MY DATE BLEED!: The Giants have three players with 17+ homers 98 games into the season in **IF Willy Adames** (17), **IF Rafael Devers** (20) and **IF Casey Schmitt** (19)...the last time three Giants had 17+ homers through 98 team games in the same season was **Will Clark** (17), **Kevin Mitchell** (19) and **Matt Williams** (19) in 1991.

- ▶ Devers now has 20+ homers in each of his last eight seasons in which it was a full MLB season (excluding 2020)...his eight 20+ homer seasons since 2018 are tied for most in MLB over that span as shown in the chart to the right.
- ▶ His 20 homers are the most by an SF batter in the team's first 98 games since **Barry Bonds** (25 homers) in 2004.
- ▶ Since May 14, 130 of SF's 260 runs came via a home run...the 50% mark of runs scored via a homer is tied for fourth-most in MLB over that span.

I LEARNED FRENCH FOR YOU!: SF will hit the road postgame and head east to take on the Kansas City Royals for a three-game series...the Giants went 1-2 vs. the Royals at home last season in mid-May...in 2024 at KC, SF swept a three-game series over the Royals.

- ▶ Following the series in KC, SF will return home, and enjoy a day off, before a 13-day stretch without an off day (next one is August 6)...in this 13-game span, SF will play six games at home (vs. LAA and MIL) and seven on the road (vs. SD and TEX).

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 10 against the Rockies at Oracle Park...threw 5.0 innings and allowed one earned run on four hits and six walks with four strikeouts in the Giants' 4-3 loss to the Rockies...Ray left with the game tied 1-1 and the Giants entered the 9th inning with a 2-1 lead, but could not hold on as Colorado scored three runs off **RHP Caleb Killan**... it snapped the Giants eight game win streak when Ray pitches and marked SF's first loss with him on the mound since May 18.

SOLID STRETCH: Over his last six outings, Ray has posted a 5-0 record with a 1.84 ERA (9er, 44.0ip), 31 strikeouts and a .171 opponents average against...he's been even better over his last five appearances, as he's held opponents to just four earned runs over 33.1 innings of work (0.99 ERA) and a 0.99 WHIP...this solid stretch came on the heels of a rough three games from May 13-24 where he posted a 0-2 record with an 11.08 ERA (16er, 13.0ip) and a .370 opponents average against.

LIMITING THE LONGBALL: Over his last seven games, Ray has allowed just two home runs over 44.0 innings (0.41 HR/9.0ip)...in his first 11 games, he allowed 13 homers over 58.2ip (1.99 HR/9.0ip).

WALK IT OUT: Has issued 52 walks over his 106.2 innings pitched this year, the third-most walks in the Majors and his 4.39 walks per 9.0 inning ratio is the highest in the Majors.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 87.9 mph last year to 86.0 mph this year...however, it's been better as of late with opponents going 2-for-19 in his last five games and 3-for-24 off him over his last seven contests with no extra base hits.

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: Ray's changeup has a +5 run value this season (his best of any pitch in his arsenal) compared to a -1 run value a season ago...this year, hitters have an xBA of .205 on the offering while hitting .202 off it overall...it's been his second-best put away pitch (17.7%) behind his knuckle curve (22.7%)...in his last six starts, hitters are 6-for-43 in at-bats that end with Ray's changeup.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: Is slated to face his former team for the eighth time in his career tonight...Ray is 2-1 with a 3.23 ERA (14er, 39.0ip) with 40 strikeouts in seven starts against the Mariners...he last faced them on April 5, 2025 at Oracle Park and worked 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on four hits with five walks in the Giants' 4-1 victory over Seattle...the lefty was traded to SF from Seattle in January 2024 in exchange for RHP Anthony DeSclafani, OF Mitch Haniger and cash...he went 12-12 with a 3.71 ERA with the Mariners in 2022 before undergoing Tommy John surgery after just one start in 2023.
