**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 21**

1999 - In a record-setting 10-3 win over the Cubs at Wrigley Field, **Jeff Bagwell** goes 3x5 with 3 HR and 6 RBI. Not only does Bagwell tie the franchise record for HR in a game, he also passes Jimmy Wynn to become the club's all-time career HR leader. Bagwell would have another 3-HR game later that season, also in Chicago on June 9, 1999, homering 3 times at Comiskey Park vs. the ChiSox. He end his career with 449 HR, which still stands as the franchise record.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros and Guardians will play the 2nd game of this 3-game set tonight at Progressive Field...**RHP Ryan Weiss** (0-2) will start for the Astros vs. Guardians **LHP Parker Messick** (3-0).

VS. THE LAND: Tonight is the 2nd game of six scheduled meetings vs. the Guardians in 2026... after this 3-game set at Progressive Field, the two clubs will play a 3-game series at Daikin Park, June 19-21...the Astros were 2-4 vs. CLE last season, going 2-1 at Progressive and 0-3 at Daikin Park.

AT PROGRESSIVE: With last night's victory, the Astros are now 5-1 in their last 6 games at Progressive Field...they were 2-0 here in 2024 and 2-1 in 2025.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **RHP Ryan Weiss** will make his second start of the season tonight...Weiss began the 2026 season in the Astros bullpen, making 5 relief appearances before making his first career ML start on April 16 vs. COL (3.2 IP, 2 ER)...**About Ryan:** Weiss is back pitching in the United States in 2026 after spending the last two seasons in the KBO...he made 46 career starts in Korea for the Hanwha Eagles and posted a 3.16 ERA, a 1.07 WHIP and 305 strikeouts in 270.1 innings over those two seasons...the Astros signed him to a Major League deal in December.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros tallied 13 hits en route to a 9-2 win over the Guardians last night in the first game of this series...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (2-0) earned the win (5 IP, 2 ER)...**Isaac Paredes** had a big night, going 3x5 with 2 HR...**Christian Walker** (3x5, 2B, HR), **Carlos Correa** (3x5, 2 RBI) and **Brice Matthews** (1x3, 2B, BB, SB) also contributed on offense...**LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP), **RHP A.J. Blubaugh** (1 IP) and **RHP Jayden Murray** (2 IP) combined to keep CLE off the board for the final 4.0 innings.

EE-SOCK!: **Isaac Paredes** hit his 1st 2 HR of the 2026 season last night...it marked his 9th career multi-HR game and his 1st since June 25, 2025 at PIT (2 HR).

HOMECOMING KING: Close to 100 students from the nearby Clear Fork school district were at Progressive Field last night to support **RHP A.J. Blubaugh**...not only did Blubaugh graduate from Clear Fork High School, he also served as a substitute teacher for the district...Blubaugh, who is from Mansfield, OH, also had several family members and friends at the game last night.

UP FOR THE CHALLENGE: Since April 13, **C Yainer Diaz** has been successful in 9 of his last 10 ABS challenges...in that span, he has been successful twice in the same game 4 different times.

A PERFECT 10: **Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid start to the 2026 season as he leads the Majors with 10 HR, which matches the club record through a player's first 24 games of a season, joining **Lance Berkman** (2002).

ON THE LEADERBOARD: Alvarez currently leads the AL in WAR (1.6), RBI (21), XBH (17) and TB (65), and is 2nd in SLG (.756), OBP (.459) and OPS (1.215).

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have placed **OF Taylor Trammell** on the 10-day IL due to a left groin strain...to take his place on the active roster, the Astros selected **OF Daniel Johnson** (#31) to the Major League roster...to make room for Johnson on the 40-man roster, the Astros designated **RHP Christian Roa** for assignment.

MR. 2000: **2B Jose Altuve** needs to appear in one more game to reach 2,000 for his career, which will make him the 3rd Astros player to reach this milestone...Hall of Famers Craig Biggio (2,850) and Jeff Bagwell (2,150) also surpassed 2,000 career games (all for HOU)...only four active players have reached 2,000 career games: **Andrew McCutchen** (2,276), **Carlos Santana** (2,212), **Freddie Freeman** (2,199) and **Paul Goldschmidt** (2,082).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in most key offensive categories...last night marked the 6th game of the season where the Astros tallied 13 or more hits in a game:

QUICK ROADSTOP: The Astros will play just these three games in CLE on the current road trip before returning home for a weekend series vs. NYY... last night's Astros win snapped an 8-game road losing streak.

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 24 different batting orders in their 24 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 750th career extra-base hit on Thursday (4/16 VS. COL) with his 461st career double...he also has 32 triples and 258 home runs, all coming as an Astro...only **Craig Biggio** (1,014) and **Jeff Bagwell** (969) have more extra-base hits than Altuve in franchise history.

BEHIND THE DISH: **C Christian Vázquez** is hitting .375 (12x32) with a .444 OBP and a 1.132 OPS...he has also tallied 10 RBI in just 10 games (8 starts) and has four catcher caught stealings on the season.

HARD TO HIT: Opponents are just 7x48 (.146) vs. **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**, who is just the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history... among AL relievers, Teng ranks T-2nd in innings (13.2) and T-8th in strikeouts (14)...Sunday was his 4th scoreless appearance of at least 2.0 innings this season, tied for the most among AL relievers.

WEISS IS RIGHT: is set to make his 2nd career MLB start in what will be his 7th career MLB appearance, all made this season with the Astros...his last appearance was his 1st Major League start on April 16 vs. COL, where he went 3.2 innings, giving up 2 runs on 3 hits with 4 walks and 3 strikeouts...tossed 76 pitches (45 strikes) in his outing...did not receive a decision in a 3-2 Astros loss.

LETS GET STARTED: Has a wealth of experience as a starter at the pro level prior to this season, including 30 starts in his breakout 2025 season with the Hanwha Eagles of the KBO, going 16-5 with a 2.87 ERA (57ER/178.2IP), a 1.02 WHIP and 10.4 SO/9IP...across 5 seasons in the affiliated minor leagues (2018-23), spent in the Diamondbacks and Royals systems, he made 47 starts among his 132 total appearances...while with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball in 2024, he averaged 14.4 SO/9IP (73SO/45.2IP) through his 9 appearances, all starts.

2026 AT A GLANCE: Was a member of the Astros Opening Day roster and made his MLB debut with his 1st appearance of the season on March 27 vs. LAA (1.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 SO)...picked up his 1st career strikeout vs. **OF Jorge Soler**...has been a go-to multi-inning reliever out of the Astros bullpen this season, logging 2.0+ innings in all but 1 of his appearances thus far...his 15 strikeouts in relief rank T-7th among AL relievers...in the AL, is 1 of 10 relievers with at least 4 appearances of 2.0+ innings; among those he's tied for 4 with are teammates **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** and **RHP AJ Blubaugh**.

ON THE ROAD: set to pitch in his fourth road outing, all previously coming in relief...excluding a relief appearance in Colorado, holds a 3.38 ERA (2ER/5.1IP) on the road with 6 strikeouts and 2 walks.

2025 BREAKOUT: In the KBO in 2025, he ranked 3rd in innings (178.2IP), 3rd in wins (16) and 4th in strikeouts (207)...those totals also constituted single-season career highs for his pro career.

ABOUT WEISS: Returned to the United States after 2 seasons in the KBO, signing a MLB deal with the Astros on Dec. 9, 2025...has been well-traveled in his professional career, spending his first five seasons (2018-23) at the affiliated minor league level in the Diamondbacks and Royals systems, followed by stints with the Fubon Guardians of the Chinese Professional Baseball League (2023), the High Point Rockers of the Atlantic League of Professional Baseball (2023-24) and the Hanwha Eagles of the KBO (2024-25)...was originally selected by the Diamondbacks in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft from Wright State University.

LAST APPEARANCE (4/17 vs. STL): Surrendered 3 runs on 2 hits with 1 walk on Fri. night vs. STL, allowing a 3-run homer to **IF Nolan Gorman** (16 pitches-8 strikes)...prior to Friday night, had recorded back-to-back scoreless outings (2.1 IP) for the 1st time this season .

VS. CLE: has posted a 0.77 ERA (1ER/11.2IP) and .175 opponent average with 18 strikeouts in 11 career appearances vs. CLE...is the 7th-lowest ERA among active relievers with at least 11.0 career innings vs. CLE.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With Fri. night's outing, he reached 337.0 career innings, matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...next on the all-time list is **RHP Xavier Hernandez** at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in K's (460) and 7th in apps. (326).

2025 SEASON: Was a workhorse out of the Astros 'pen in 2025, going 3-4-7 with a 2.28 ERA (18ER/71IP), a .196 opponent average (51x260), 1.15 WHIP and 13.31 SO/9IP in a team-leading 70 appearances...led AL relievers with 105 strikeouts.

MULTI-INNING MAN: A starter throughout his minor league career, has 6 multi-inning outings among his 10 appearances this season...among AL relievers, ranks 1st in innings pitched with 15.0 IP.

OPENING DAY FIRE: Made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season and pitched that day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball...tossed a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**, the hardest pitch thrown in his career.
