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BIRDLAND BITES: Today, Baltimore continues a 10-game, 11-day road trip through Texas (1-2), Minnesota (1-1, 1 to play), and Tampa Bay (4 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, dropping two of three to the Phillies before taking two of three from the Angels... The Orioles begin play today 2.0 games back of the final AL Wild Card spot.

👉 Last night, **Gunnar Henderson** snapped a career-high 18-game streak with one or zero hits, going 3-for-5 with a double, home run, two runs, and two RBI...It marked his fifth multi-extra-base hit game of the year, including the first since July 20 at Boston (3 2B).

👉 **Pete Alonso** is 7-for-11 (.636) with three home runs, six RBI, five runs, and three walks against one strikeout over his last three games after going 4-for-25 (.160) with one double, two RBI, zero runs, and one walk against nine strikeouts across his previous seven contests.

👉 **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** hit a 460 ft. home run, the furthest hit by an Oriole since Jordan Westburg (461 ft.) on July 5, 2025 at Atlanta off Aaron Bummer...He became the 10th Oriole (13th occurrence) in the Statcast era (since 2015) to hit a home run of at least 460 feet, led by Jonathan Schoop's 484 ft. blast on August 26, 2015 at Kansas City off Johnny Cueto.

👉 Alonso, Encarnacion-Strand, and Henderson each tallied three hits and one home run... It marked the second time this season Baltimore had at least three players accomplish the feat in the same game, joining April 24 vs. Boston (Basallo, Beavers, Henderson, Rutschman).

👉 In yesterday's win, Baltimore pitching limited Minnesota to a 1-for-11 (.091) clip with runners in scoring position.

SHANE IS DUE: Despite suffering the loss in his last outing on August 7 at Texas, **Shane Baz** tossed his first career complete game while striking out a season-high-tying nine batters (4x, last: 7/12 vs. KC).

👉 He has pitched to a 3.31 ERA (20 ER/54.1 IP) over his last nine starts since June 18, including six quality starts, but is 0-5 in those outings, with the O's going 1-8 in those games.

👉 Among all 66 MLB pitchers who have made at least nine starts since June 18, his 1.66 run support average during that period is the lowest in the majors, with the next closest pitcher being LAA's Reid Detmers (2.11).

SEESAW SERIES: The O's and Twins have alternated wins and losses as they close their season series today...Baltimore was swept by Minnesota in the 2025 season series (0-6) after the O's won 10 straight against the Twins from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024.

👉 Last night, Baltimore snapped a four-game losing skid at Target Field.

👉 The Birds hit one long ball and scored five combined runs in three games at Target Field last season after hitting seven long balls and plating 22 runs in 2024...The O's did not go deep on Monday, but hit three long balls in yesterday's win.

ACTION JACKSON: In 23 games following the All-Star break, **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .306/.393/.403 (22-for-72) with four doubles, six RBI, 11 runs, 11 walks, and two steals.

👉 During the 23-game stretch, Holliday is slashing .412/.512/.588 (14-for-34) with three doubles and one home run off fastballs (4-seam, sinker, cutter)...Prior to the All-Star break, he slashed .206/.351/.381 (13-for-63) with two doubles and three home runs off such offerings.

👉 Over his last 10 road games since July 22 (G1), he is 17-for-38 (.447) with three doubles, one home run, and four RBI.

👉 His 1.037 OPS with two outs is fourth highest in the AL and seventh highest in the majors (min. 60 PA).

BREAKING POINT: Oriole hitters have been thrown breaking pitches 31.6 percent of the time, the fifth-highest mark in the majors behind the Cubs (33.0%), Phillies (32.9%), Astros (32.2%), and Reds (31.7%)...The Birds are hitting .199 on such offerings, the second-lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Reds (.192), while their .340 slugging percentage is fourth lowest in MLB.

👉 **Coby Mayo** has been thrown breaking balls 41.4 percent of the time, the highest mark in MLB (min. 500 breaking pitches thrown), ahead of both CHC's Dansby Swanson and PHI's Kyle Schwarber (both 40.5%).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 111 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Tigers (45 G).

👉 Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 111-game stretch is the second-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954) trailing a 112-game run in 1995.

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

👉 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 463 walks.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.68 ERA in 69 games since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in MLB during that time behind the Tigers (3.11), Yankees (3.27), Red Sox (3.33), and Marlins (3.67)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

👉 The rotation has posted a 3.70 ERA since May 24, the fifth-best starter ERA in the AL... Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles have played in 77 games decided by three or fewer runs, tied for sixth most in the majors...Their 37-40 (.481) winning percentage in such affairs ranks 20th in MLB.

👉 Baltimore is 10-18 (.357) in one-run games, the third-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Giants (10-20, .333) and Mets (11-20, .355).

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 29 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (26)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least five pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (7).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962)

👉 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Christian Encarnacion-Strand**, **Tyler O'Neill**, and **Leody Taveras** are all tied for second with three pinch-hit RBI each.

👉 The team's 29 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1991 (30)...The team record is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 24th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on August 7 at Texas after throwing 8.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering three hits (1 HR) and one walk with a season-high-tying nine strikeouts (4x, last: 7/12 vs. KC)...Threw 93 pitches, 66 strikes.

- Marked his first career complete game...The 8.0 innings matched a career high, joining June 26, 2025 at Kansas City.
- Permitted his first home run since June 23 at Los Angeles-AL.
- His six starts of 7.0+ innings lead the club, ahead of **Kyle Bradish** (5).

TWINNING: Baz has made two career starts opposite Minnesota, going 0-1 with a 10.57 ERA (9 ER/7.2 IP).

- Faced the Twins earlier this season on March 29 at Camden Yards and did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits, zero walks, and one hit batter with four strikeouts across 5.1 innings.
- In 13 career starts against AL Central opponents, Baz is 2-6 with a 6.15 ERA (49 ER/71.2 IP).

ROUNDING INTO FORM: Over his last 14 starts since May 20, Baz has posted a 2.86 ERA (27 ER/85.0 IP) and a 1.20 WHIP after recording a 5.26 ERA (30 ER/51.1 IP) and a 1.52 WHIP across his first nine outings.

- Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 80.0+ innings since May 20, his 2.86 ERA ranks sixth in the AL and 10th in the majors.

HELP WANTED: Baz has received 10 runs of support over his last nine starts since June 18...Five of those runs came on July 20 at Boston... He has received zero runs of support in five of his outings during this period.

TIME FOR A TURN AROUND: Despite posting a 3.31 ERA (20 ER/54.1 IP) over his last nine starts since June 18, he is 0-5 in those outings, with the Orioles going 1-8 in his starts.

- The Birds have lost 17 of his 23 starts this season.
- Today, Baz looks for his first victory since June 12 vs. San Diego.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 29 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted 10 home runs over 164.2 innings (0.55 HR/9.0 IP)... Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

- He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 29 outings, the third-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind STL's Andre Pallante (36 G) and LAD's Kris Bubic (35 G).
- Baz is the only Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 23 starts with the team, surpassing the previous record held by Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).
- His 0.66 home runs per nine innings this season signal the lowest mark by an Orioles starter (min. 20 GS) since Kevin Gausman (0.56 HR/9.0 IP) in 2014.

KNUCKLE SANDWICH: After holding the opposition to a .184 (9-for-49) clip on his knuckle curveball in May, opponents hit .283 (15-for-53) against the offering in June and 13-for-37 (.351) off it in July.

- Through his first two starts of August, opponents are 4-for-11 (.364) with one double and five strikeouts off the pitch.

MAKE 'EM (UN)EARN IT: Baz has allowed 10 unearned runs, sixth most among MLB starters behind MIN's Joe Ryan/NYY's Will Warren (both 12) and WSH's Cade Cavalli/COL's Michael Lorenzen/NYM's Nolan McLean (all 11).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 39 doubles, ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (37)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

- He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 23 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.
- Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).
- His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

FIRST INNING STRUGGLES: Baz owns a 4.70 ERA (12 ER/23.0 IP) in the first inning while allowing nine walks and a .798 opponent OPS.

- He has, however, been scoreless in each of his last seven first innings after allowing two runs on June 23 at Los Angeles-AL and three runs on June 18 at Seattle.
- From innings 2-4, he has posted a 2.87 ERA (22 ER/69.0 IP) with 16 walks and a .654 opponent OPS.
